

Work from Home Status – Tallulah Campus

University View Academy is Louisiana's highest performing free, public K-12 online Charter School where students can excel using a rigorous state approved curriculum under the direction of certified teachers. In the 2018-2019 school year, University View Academy placed an online Charter School into a brick & mortar learning center that supplies students in Tallulah, Louisiana with transportation to the learning center, breakfast & lunch meal service at the learning center, as well as certified teachers and learning coaches to guide and support the online instruction at the learning center.

Behavioral Intervention Tiers

Tier I: Positive reinforcement of constructive classroom behaviors followed by progressive in-class intervention (e.g., verbal warning, temporary timeout, etc.)

Tier II: (Triggered by student behavior meriting placement in the Red: No Zone portion of the student conduct color chart or by behavior characterized as ODR.) In-school detention (TOR) followed by administrative contact with parents and collaborative development of student behavior management plan (e.g., alternate seating, differentiated instruction, environmental modifications in the classroom, etc.)

Tier III: (Triggered by multiple, same-week instances of student behavior meriting placement in the Red: No Zone portion of the student conduct color chart or by behavior which, by definition, is characterized as ODR.) At this point there will be a parent conference, followed by change to temporary work-from-home status and review their student behavior management plan. All student behavior management issues should be handled in-class except for students whose behavior falls under the Administrative Referral portion of the following table.

ODR or Administrative Referral

The following items are reasons for an Administrative Referral:

Assault, fighting or aggressive physical contact, chronic minor infractions, aggressive language, threats, truancy, vandalism, bullying, leaving class without permission, repeated cheating or plagiarism, possession of illegal substances, serious violations of our internet use policy, deliberate damage to school property are all cause to change a student at university view academy to temporary work-from-home status.

Temporary work-from-home status

Attending the learning center is a privilege that will temporarily be removed from students who receive administrative referrals. Children prosper when their parents take an active role in education. As learning coaches, parents will use a hands-on approach to be closely involved in daily classes and they work with teachers to keep the students on track. When access to the learning center is removed from the student, the parent must serve as the primary learning coach for a student at home until the temporary work-from-home status is complete.
