
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### 2. Earth Tones For the Win


### 4. Think Outside the Box



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
### 8. Go Big or Go Home


### 10. A World of Energy


### 11. Patriotism at Its Finest


### 13. Holiday Madness


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
### 16. For the Love of Landscapes



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
### 19. Play Around with Geometric Patterns

Themes can help drive a statement. This is especially true in the fashion industry, where trends and fads always come and go. Having a common theme adds creative structure and prevents a look or image from looking too disorganized. The <u>fashion template</u> below works because it incorporates an orange mod theme with the use of geometric shapes for added playfulness.



### 20. Monochromatic Masculinity

If you want to convey traditional masculinity or femininity, colors are the usual way of achieving this. For example, despite increasing pushback of outdated notions of gender stereotypes, a baby's gender is still assigned blue if it's a boy and pink if it's a girl. Bright, pastel colors are commonly associated with young girls or ladies. Darker, more solid tones are considered 'manly'. The barbershop template below reinforces these notions. The monochromatic design aptly captures the establishment's general <u>target market</u>.



### 21. Stick to a Color Palette

There are well-loved holidays and commemorative events that have become pillars of community life. Phrases like 'Memorial Day Weekend' or '<u>Labor Day</u> Weekend' are synonymous with celebration. The Pinterest pin below gets straight to the point with the striking combination of red, white, and blue. The addition of the American flag just brings it all together.



### 22. Make the Association

Not only does the template below make use of eye-catching imagery, it's also making the right associations. The idea of surfing on a beach brings to mind a number of things. The clever use of the wave in the template's design is one appropriate example. Most people will immediately make the connection between surfing and waves.



### 23. Color Blocking

For more impact, using sharp contrasting colors is a good tip. It's tasteful and attention-grabbing due to the stark difference in hues. As illustrated in the <a href="recipe template">recipe template</a> below, the deep color of the blue beautifully highlights the brightness of the orange shade.




### 24. Fifty Shades of Green

Green, of course, can be replaced by any color. Using varying shades from the same color family will not only make your pin more interesting, but will create more depth and dimension. Just make sure the colors are appropriate for the occasion. In the case of the <u>Saint Patrick's Day</u> template below, the dominance of green doesn't seem too overwhelming because of the different tones and shades.



### 25. Trivia Tidbits

If you're aiming for an awareness campaign or information drive, you want to pique the interest of the audience without giving everything away. Don't just settle for the basic details such as date and location. Adding a bit of trivia will make it more engaging. The World Water Day design below offers basic information but goes further by providing trivia at the top of the page.



### 26. Set the Mood

Lounges and bars have a certain mood that a lot of people find soothing and reassuring. Setting the mood has everything to do with the senses. It could be dimming the lights or playing the right music just to capture that perfect vibe. The <u>bar lounge</u> pin below is merely mimicking that lounge-like vibe with deep wine colors and golden accents.



### 27. In Fade We Trust

There are hundreds of effects and filters at your disposal. The fade effect is a popular and well-loved style. It simply takes a color and adds a level of mystery to it by playing with brightness and light. The fashion pin below captures the effect ingeniously. With just the right amount of detail and lines, the different shades blend seamlessly to achieve a <u>summer look</u>.



### 28. Go Deep

A deeper, richer color accentuates the elements in an image. The <u>boutique template</u> below works because the dark background allows the attention to naturally fall on the featured picture and bold text. The pin also does a good job of playing with layers to create more flattering dimensions.



### 29. Go Grid Go

The curious use of grid and geometric patterns make this creative Pinterest pin an impactful one. Light, easy colors coupled with sharp contrasts (the model's picture in the upper half) create a bold statement that will definitely drive your message home.



### 30. Very Vertical

The <u>Cyber Monday</u> Pinterest pin below uses not just a lot of sharp, vertical lines but adjusts the text to fit the theme as well. Vertical and portrait styles add height; and if used correctly with the right colors, they can create a vivid design. Further, the brightness of the orange sneakers gives it an added lift.




### 31. High Quality Imagery

A high quality photo can serve as a good backdrop. You don't need to add extra elements when you have an image that commands enough attention. The fashion sale Pinterest pin below uses a close up photo and keeps it simple with plain text and nothing else.



### 32. Engaging Tagline

Sometimes all it takes for a brand or service to take off is a single witty line. In the case of the elegant travel template below, the travel agency chooses to emphasize its tagline more than its company name.



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### 33. To Blur or Not to Blur

There are dozens of ways to make a photo captivating and unique. Refocusing the lens is one such way. The <u>event management template</u> below blurs the rest of the photo in order for the elegant dining ware to take centerstage.



### 34. Classic B&W

The classic pairing of black and white works well for almost anything. The fashion Pinterest template below does an impeccable job of not just using the contrasting colors in text and background; but in the featured picture too.



### 35. Experiment with Color

With the hundreds of filters and effects available on every <u>social media</u> platform, it's fairly easy to play with color. The fashion pin below takes a single color or shade and experiments with its brightness, contrast, sharpness, etc. The technique gives off an interesting vibe while still achieving a minimalist effect.
