


5. Travel Brochure Design

3. The Product or Service

Building up from the benefit to what you're selling is one way to market your product or service more effectively. It's a classic selling technique to market new products, and it is also efficient when it comes to brochures.

4. The Process

Once you have convinced your consumer to make a purchase, list additional details about your product or service, including the ordering process or the life cycle of the product you're selling. If the customer sees how much you've invested in a product or service, clients become more willing to buy your company's items.

5. The Testimonial

Another effective way to influence people into engaging your services or your product is by including previous customer's testimonials or reviews. Selecting unsolicited recommendations from the same point of view is a turning point for buying a product or service.

6. The Call To Action
