Lesson Plan Format

In order to prepare a complete and comprehensive lesson plan, it must have these components:

1. Title and Author

A lesson plan must have an official title. It should indicate the type of the lesson plan. For example, if it's a lesson plan for high school classes, you can name it "High School Lesson Plan." In addition to the title, you should put your name as the author on the cover page.

2. Executive Summary

The executive summary is a lesson plan's introductory section. It provides an overview of the lesson plan, including brief info about its purpose and desired outcomes. Around 4 to 5 sentences are enough to formulate a complete executive summary.

3. Objectives

It won't be a lesson plan without its objectives. So make sure to emphasize them. You can list them down in bullet form for better readability.

4. Timeline of Activities

You can use a table to create the timeline of activities. It must outline what activities the students will do within a day, week, or class period.
