Project Description

“Media For Peace” is a program that uses both a practical and theoretical approach to promote peacebuilding principles that are integral to good media practice. The proposed program will engage media representatives, TV videographers and social media influencers, using a carefully designed curriculum to impart the knowledge and skills required to challenge harmful media practices. The program will develop competencies in conflict sensitivity, gender sensitivity, Do No Harm (DNH), and Diversity, Equality and Inclusion (DEI), and will encourage critical thinking, constructive dialogue, diversity of thought, and innovative approaches to solving societal challenges; empowering program participants to take an active role in preventing violence, and encouraging positive counter narratives that promote inclusive dialogue, support peacebuilding efforts and foster social inclusion and cohesion.

Scope of Work

GPF is looking for companies/freelancers with previous experience in video production to produce 3 Public Service Announcement videos - 1 video will be filmed in a studio; 1 video will be filmed with a presenter and 1 video will be require actors and different locations - as per the following:

1. The video duration for each PSA is 3-5 min.
2. GFP will provide the approved scripts, presenter and GFP filmmaker will be the director of all videos.
3. The company/freelance will provide equipment, locations, crew, 7 professional actors, audio and video studios and will develop shooting schedule and logistics under the supervision of GFP Filmmaker.
4. The suggested filming days are 8 production days, and 10 post-production days.
5. The company/freelancer will film in 5 to 7 locations in Amman and should have access to greenscreen and audio studios.
6. Equipment used should be at the highest level and must have steady cam like DJI – Ronin MX, drone, and any of C100/300 / DSLR Canon 5D mark VI / Sony A7S II cameras.
7. Video outcome should be in 4K with excellent VFX, audio mastering and coloring.
8. Cost of transportation, food and logistics should be included in the offer.
9. Filming will take place in May and final outcomes should be delivered in early June 2021.

Company/Freelance Experience and Requirement

The consultancy firm/freelancer will be required to have;

1. At least 4 years of experience in video production.
2. Proven experience working and making films for NOG's/INGO's in Jordan.
3. Mastery of Adobe software; Adobe Premier and After effects.
4. Video samples showing the competence in the filed.

5. Experience in creating PSAs and Video campaigns is highly desired.
6. Excellent technical capacities and access to state of art filming equipment to ensure smooth and high-quality production.
