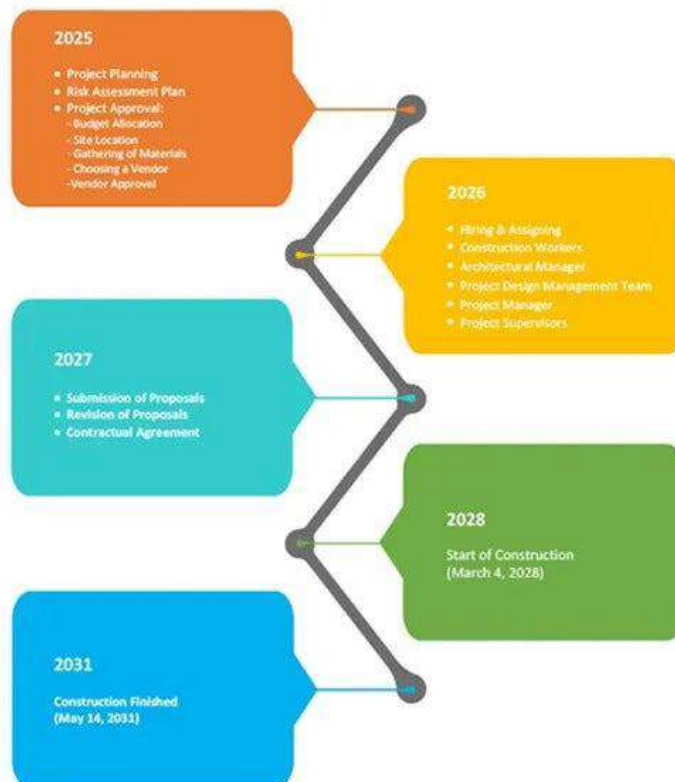
## Timeline Ideas and Examples

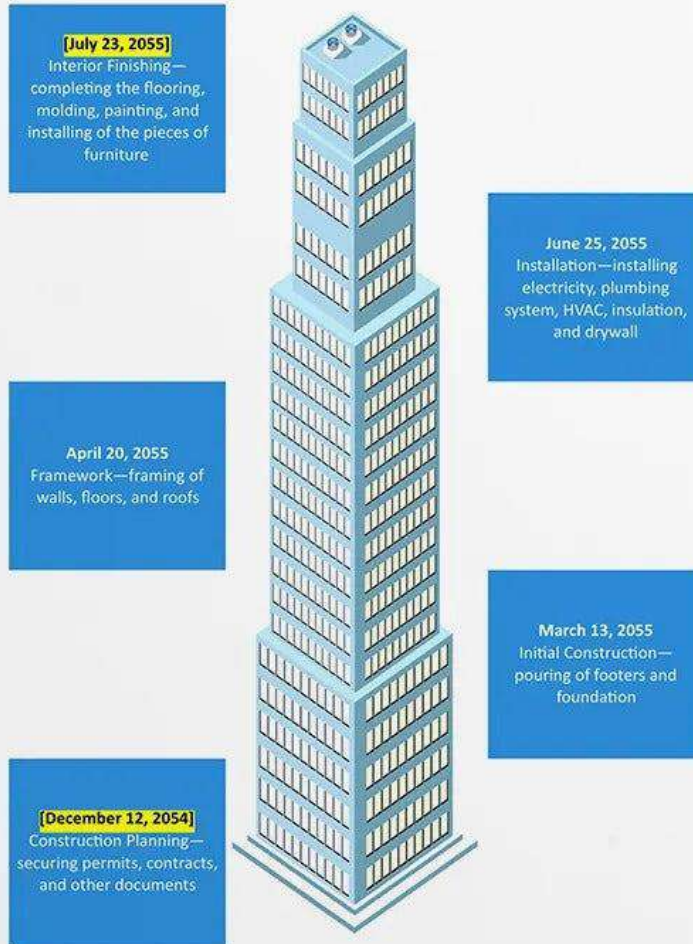

A basic timeline should have descriptions, specific dates and times for the description, some timelines may also include headers for the descriptions and various images or symbols.

### **How to build an infographic timeline?**
