


Bill of Sale

Bill of Sale Definition & Meaning

A bill of sale is a legal document that specifies the terms of a sale or transfer of property.

In other words, a bill of sale can be used as evidence in court that the seller has conveyed title to the goods listed and that the buyer has paid the seller the entire purchase price.

What Is A Bill of Sale?

In simple terms, a bill of sale is a piece of paper that can be used as proof of a sale. Much like when you go shopping in a big store and buy clothes, the store gives you a receipt or bill that lists all the clothes you bought and the price. A bill of sale is also essential for a business to keep track of its sales and income.



Date

Indicate the date of the purchase deal or the time when the acquisition or sale was completed.

Buyer and Seller's names and addresses

Complete the form with all of the pertinent information, including the names, addresses, and other contact information of both the buyer and the seller.

Details of the property being transferred

Include a description of the object being sold as well as its current condition in the listing.

The selling price or consideration

Include the money that was exchanged for the ownership of the things in your description.

Assurance

A guarantee that the asset in question is totally and entirely devoid of any claims or offsets.


Warranty

What's The Difference Between the Bill of Sale, Schedule, and Workplan?


A Bill of Sale is evidence that goods have been sold and ownership has been transferred from the seller to the purchaser for a specified price.
