


# **Financial Case Study**


## **Media Case Study**


## **B2B Case Study**


## **Event Case Study**

There are various types of events. These events require research and evaluation to know innovative methods and smart processes to achieve the event's objectives. For this reason, an event case study is advantageous to event managers.




# **Construction Case Study**





# **Analysis**


The analysis is the aspect consisting of the cause and effect relationship of the target. It provides insights, allowing readers to brainstorm and generate their perspectives regarding the case study.

A case study exists to solve particular problems. Problems are a critical part of the case study to exhibit the root and source of the issue, allowing researchers to find solutions.


