


How do I Upload a PNG to Adobe After Effects


Learn how to upload a PNG file to Adobe After Effects. It lets you make great visuals and one way to enhance it is by adding PNG files.



How do I Upload a PNG to Adobe After Effects


Uploading PNG files to Adobe after effects is pretty easy. Find out how with these easy steps.

- **Step 1: Open Adobe After Effects**




For you to get started on uploading a PNG file, first you need to open Adobe After Effects.

- **Step 2: Click File**




Next, move your cursor to the top of the screen where the toolbar is. Click on the 'File' option where a dropdown will open.

- **Step 3: Select Import and File**



Once the dropdown is shown, click on the 'Import' option and followed by the 'File' option.

- **Step 4: Choose PNG File**



This will open another window where you can find your PNG file. Click it and confirm to upload it to Adobe After Effects.
