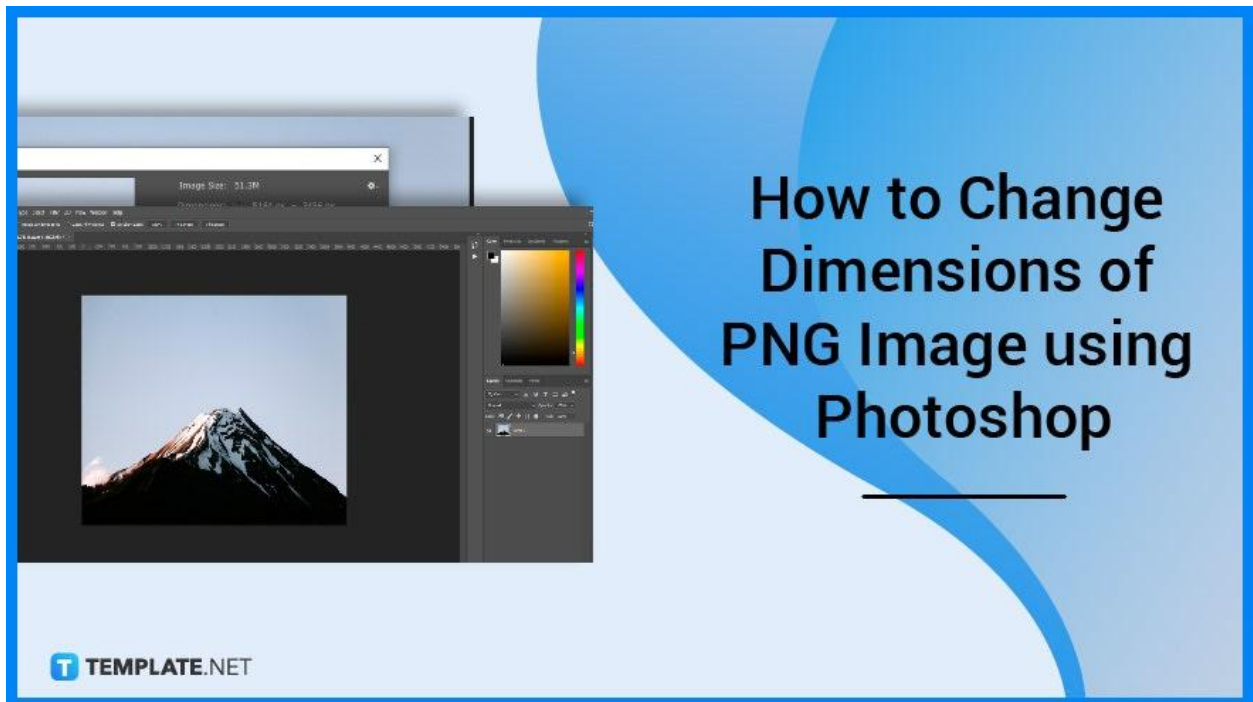


How to Change Dimensions of PNG Image using Photoshop

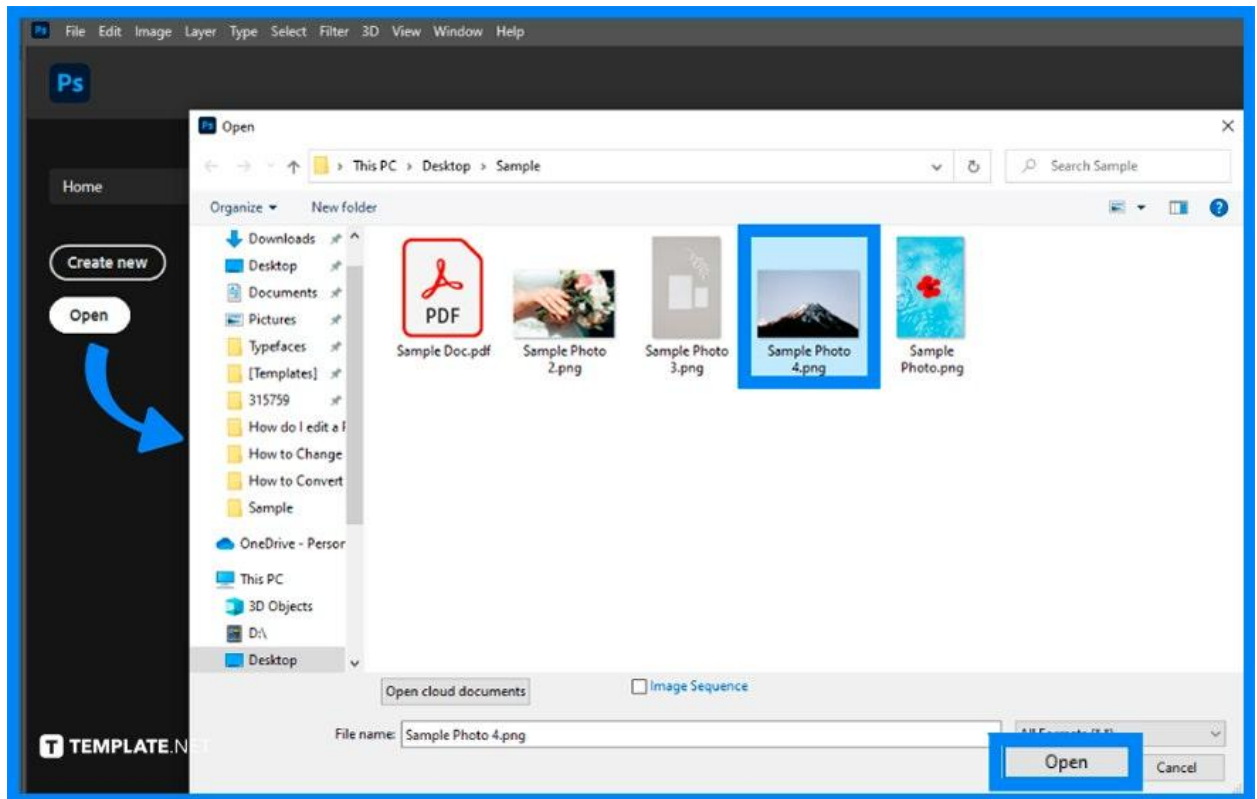
Learn how to change the dimensions of a PNG image using Photoshop. That way, you can resize the images you are working on with ease.



How to Change Dimensions of PNG Image using Photoshop

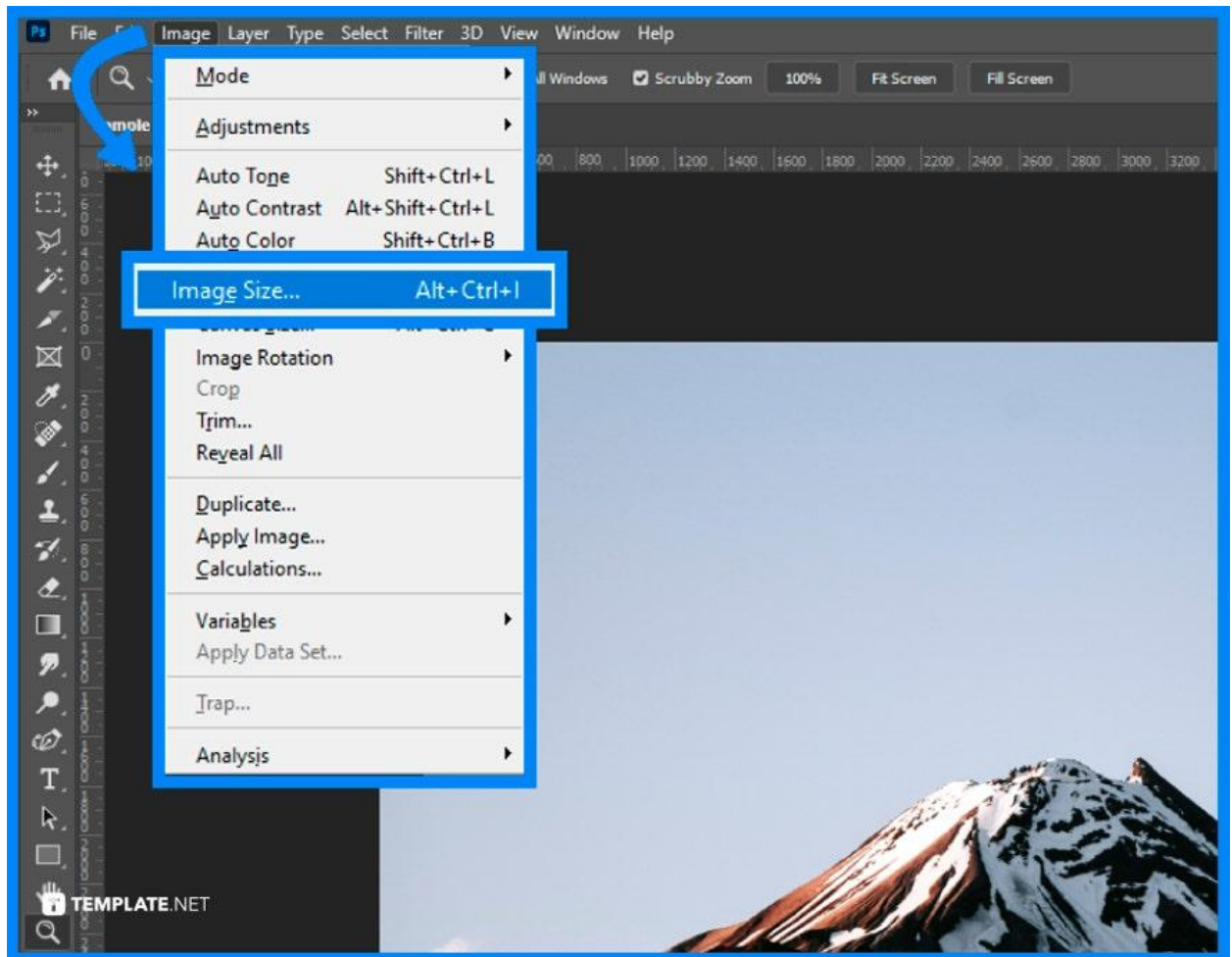
PNG images can be resized in a few minutes. Find out how to get it done with these easy steps.

- **Step 1: Open Photoshop and Select Image**



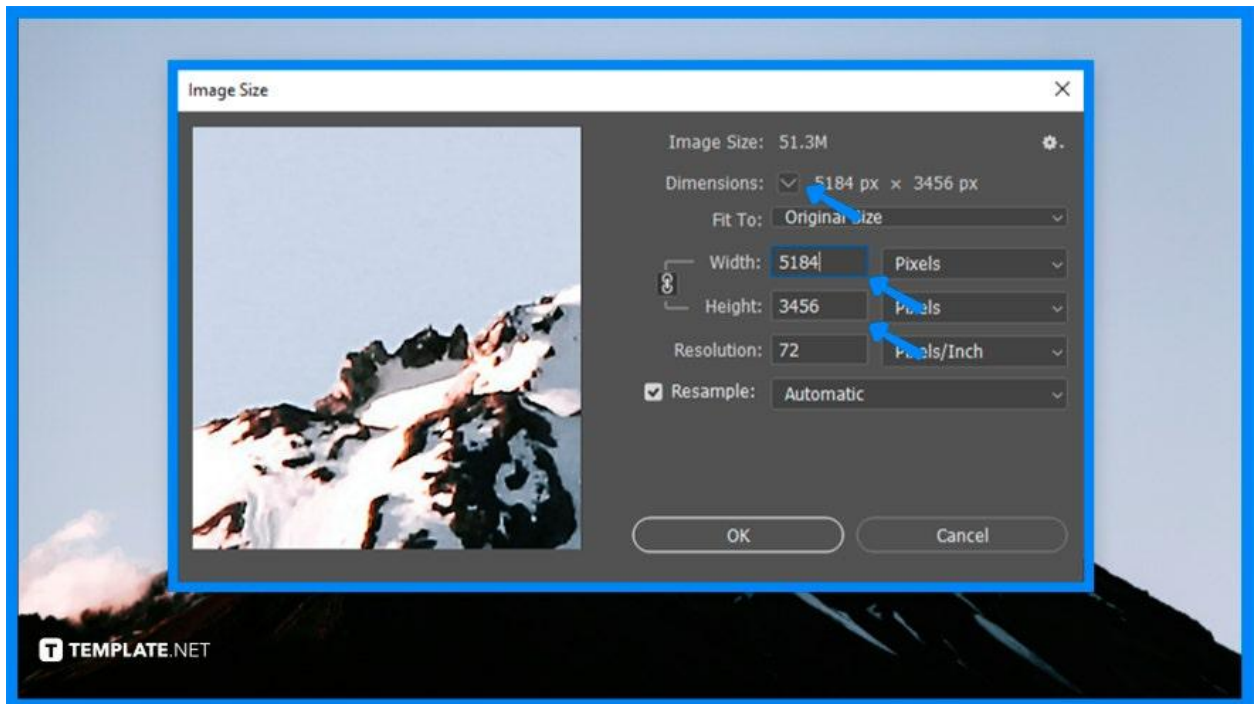
To get started, open Adobe Photoshop and insert the image whose dimensions you want to change. You can do so by clicking on the file, and then Open, followed by selecting the photo.

- **Step 2: Click Image and Image Size**



When the photo is in Photoshop, click on Image on the menu. This will show a dropdown where you can click on Image Size next.

- **Step 3: Enter Pixel Dimensions**



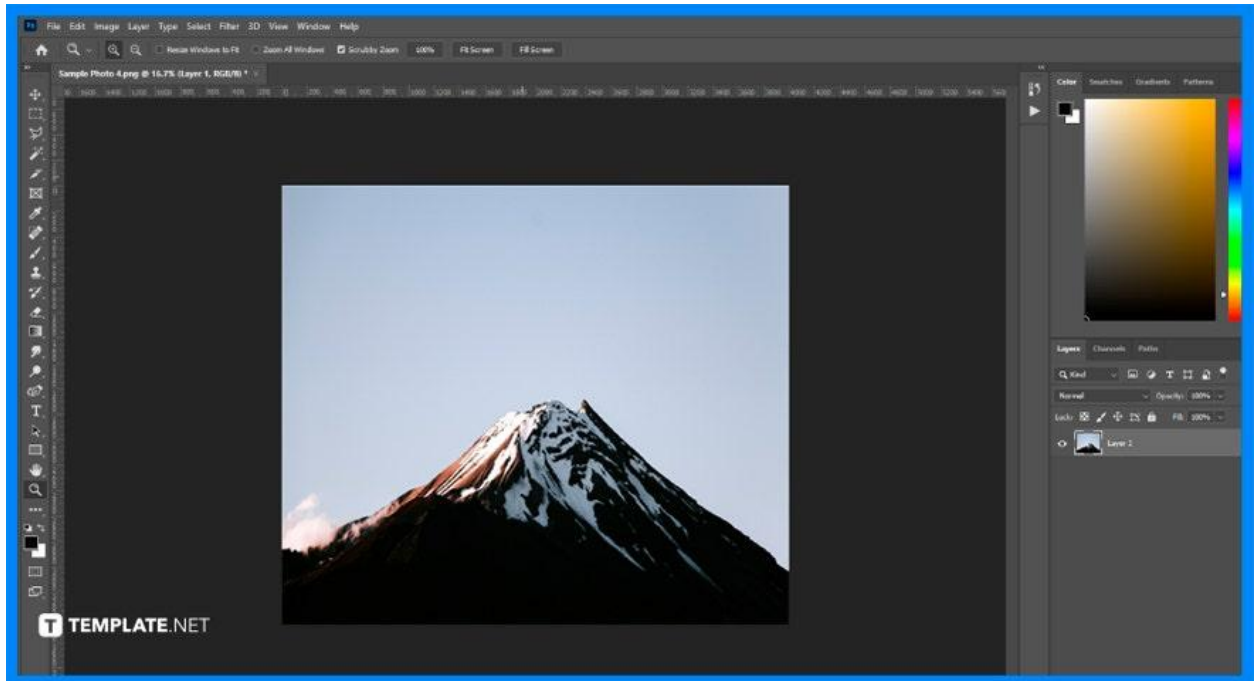
After clicking Image Size, a dialog box appears on the screen. From there, you can see right away where you can change the dimensions of your PNG image.

You can manually add the number to adjust the dimensions.

- **Step 4: Click OK**



After finalizing the sizes of your PNG image, you can click the OK button located at the top left of the window.

FAQs

What is the difference between cropping and changing dimensions?

Cropping refers to cutting out parts of an image while changing dimensions means resizing the whole image.

Can I change the dimensions of multiple objects in Photoshop?

No, you can only change one object's dimensions at a time in Photoshop.

What are the dimensions in Photoshop?

The dimensions presented in Photoshop are height which is the depth of an object and width which is the shorter distance between two points in an object.
