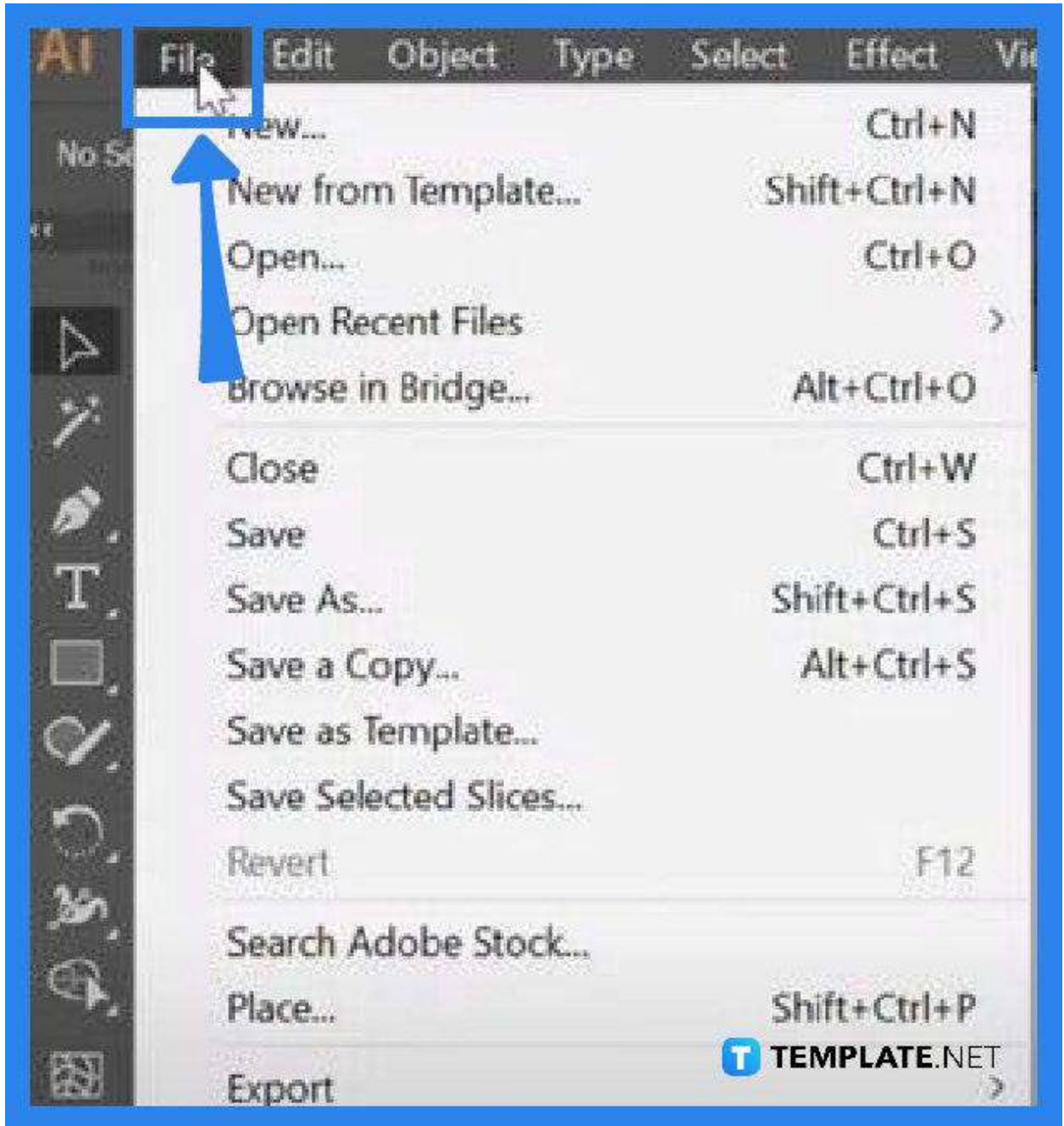

How to Edit SVG Document

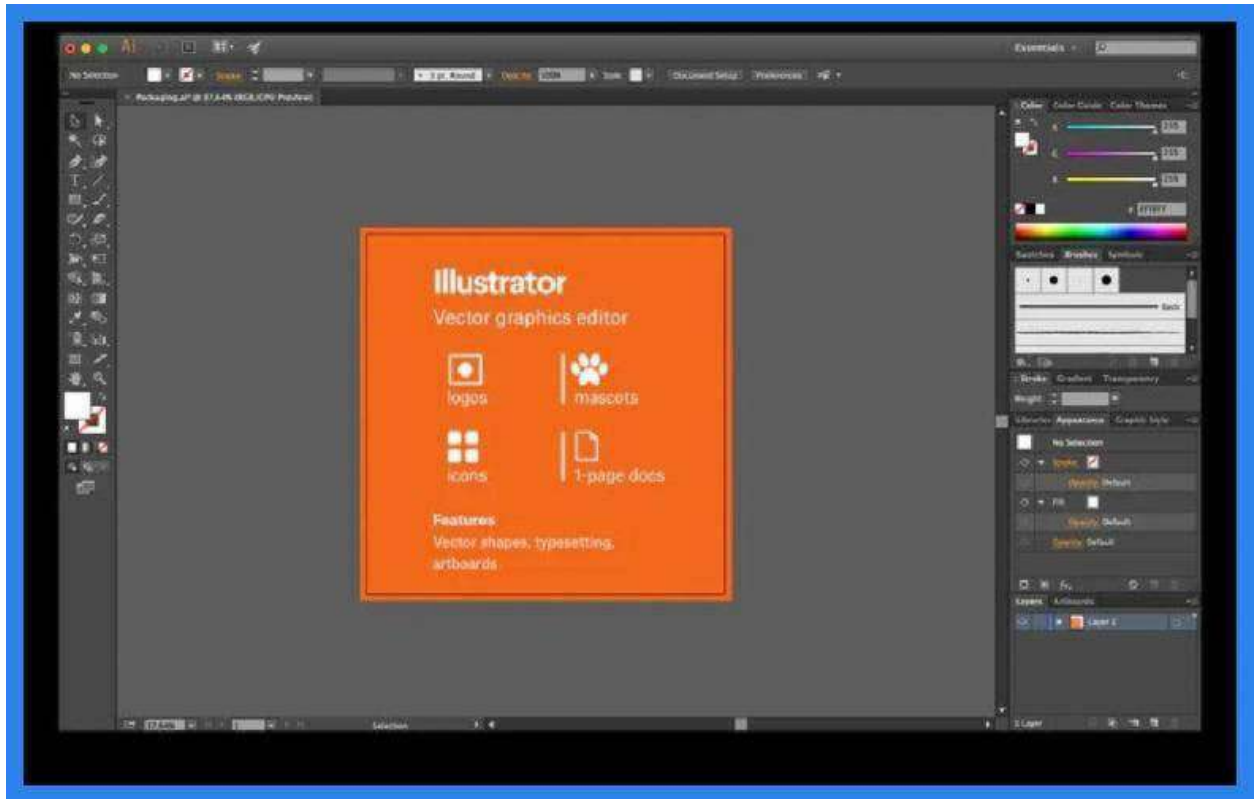
[Adobe Illustrator](#) makes graphic design easy and fun, especially when it comes to SVG. It has loads of incredible editing tools useful for graphic design beginners and with the help of the easy steps presented below, editing SVG documents will no longer be as complicated as you think.

- **Step 1: Place or Open Your SVG Document**



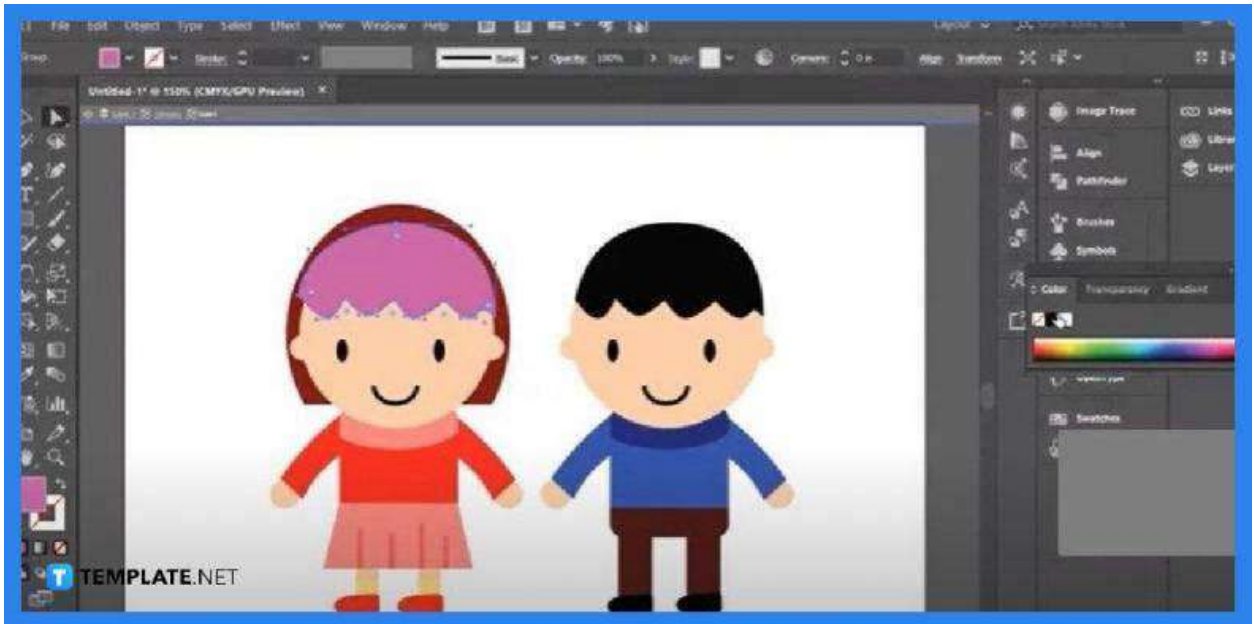
Bring up your SVG document to your Adobe Illustrator artboard. You can do this by going to “File” and clicking on “Place” from the drop-down menu. Alternatively, you can simply press the Shift + Ctrl + P keys on your keyboard to quickly execute it.

- **Step 2: Begin the Editing Process**



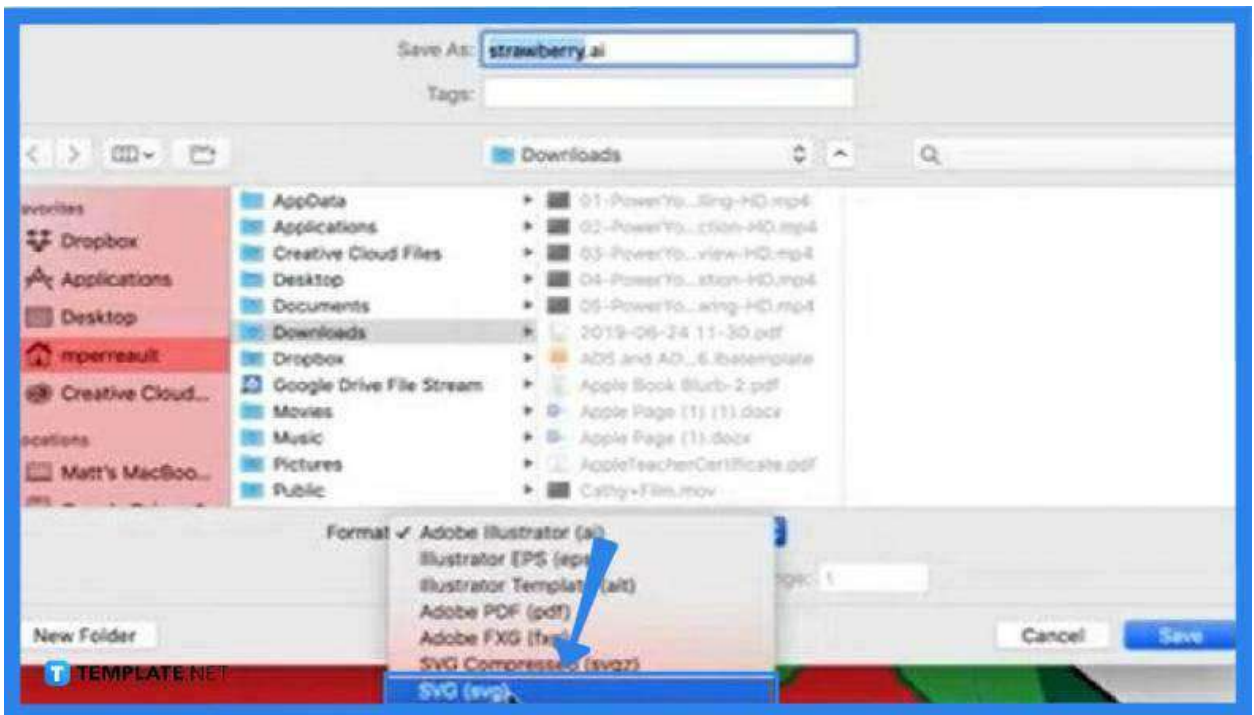
Now that you have the SVG image on your artboard, navigate the tools panel on the left, as well as the properties panel on the right, for the adjustments you need for the document. You may click on the “Object” tab at the taskbar on the top and head over to “Expand” to expand the image. This will make it easier for you to manipulate the file and execute the changes.

- **Step 3: Continue Editing**



Use the “Selection” tool on the left side pane to select areas you want to edit or optimize. Head over to the color panel on the right side to change the color of certain parts you think applies. Simply deselect it when done.

- **Step 4: Save the Edited SVG Document**



Now hit “File” and select “Save As” from the drop-down menu. By default, Adobe Illustrator will save your document in the AI file format. Click the “Format” box to bring down all the other file format options, and choose “SVG.”

Can SVG files be edited in Adobe?

Yes, but opt for Adobe Illustrator when editing an SVG file since this is a vector graphics editor as opposed to Photoshop which is just a raster graphics editor.
