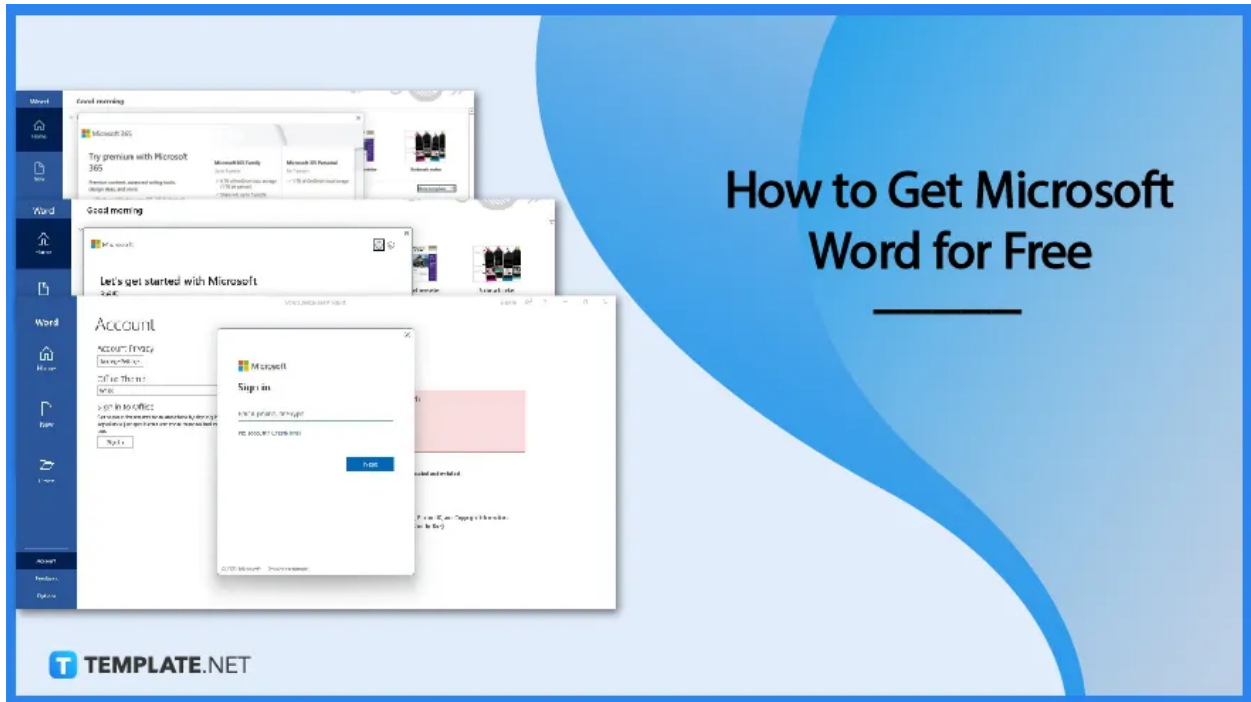


How to Get Microsoft Word for Free

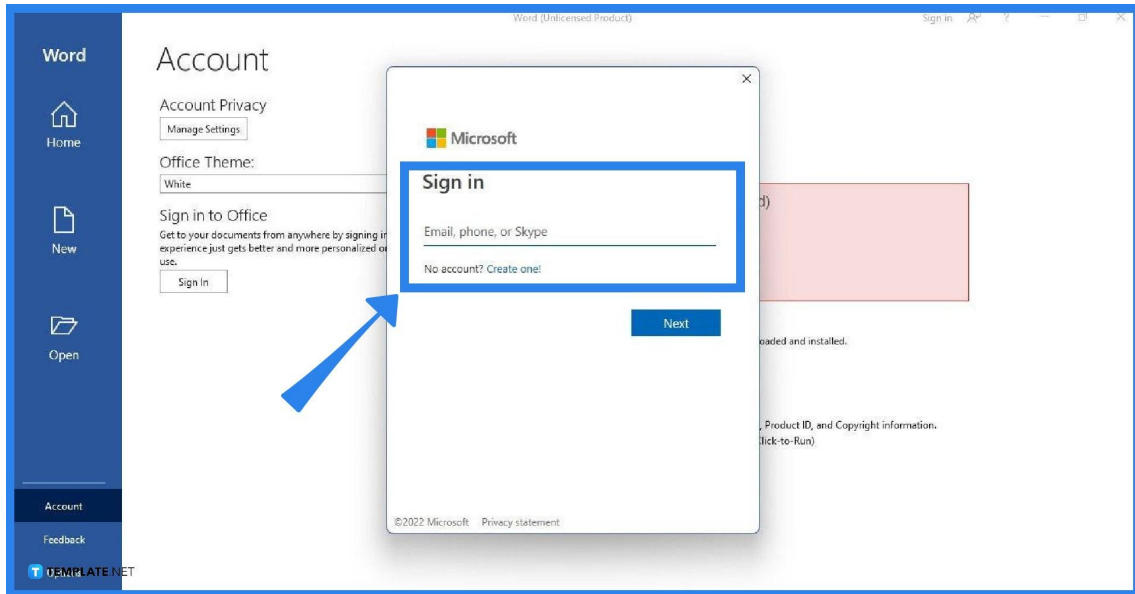
Microsoft Word requires payment if you want to have its full Edit access. Fortunately, there's a way to get it for free temporarily simply by following this guide.



How to Get Microsoft Word for Free

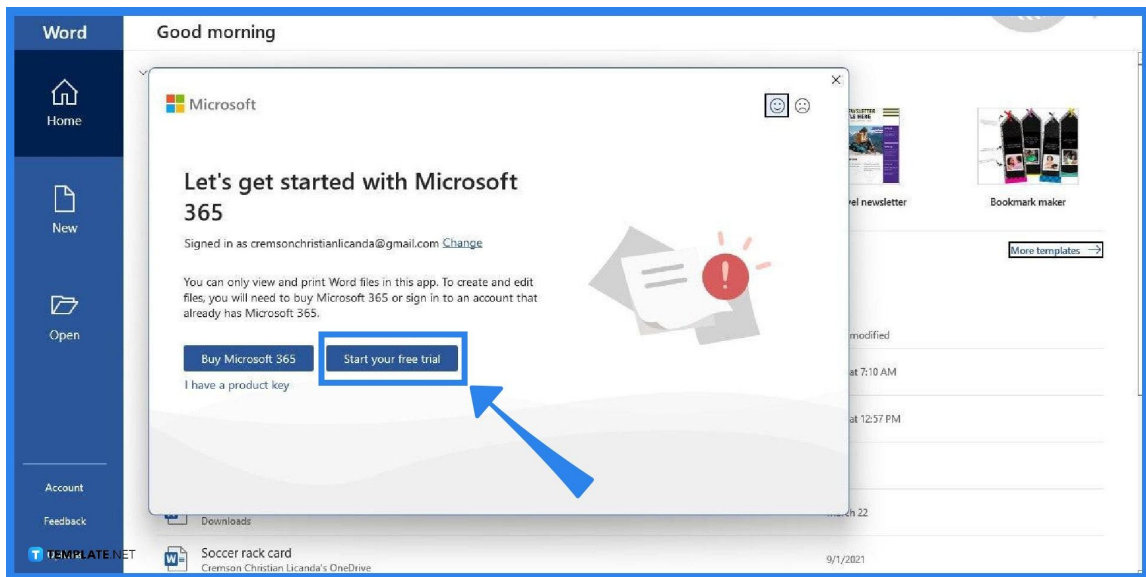
[Microsoft Word](#) is a great word processing software. Unfortunately, nothing comes for free if you wish to have full editing access. Don't worry, you can have temporary free access to its premium features; just follow these steps we've arranged below.

- **Step 1: Open MS Word and Sign In**



First, open the Microsoft Word app that is preinstalled on your Windows computer. Once you launched it, [sign in to Microsoft Word](#) using your Microsoft account. Click the Sign In button and simply enter your email address in the Sign In box.

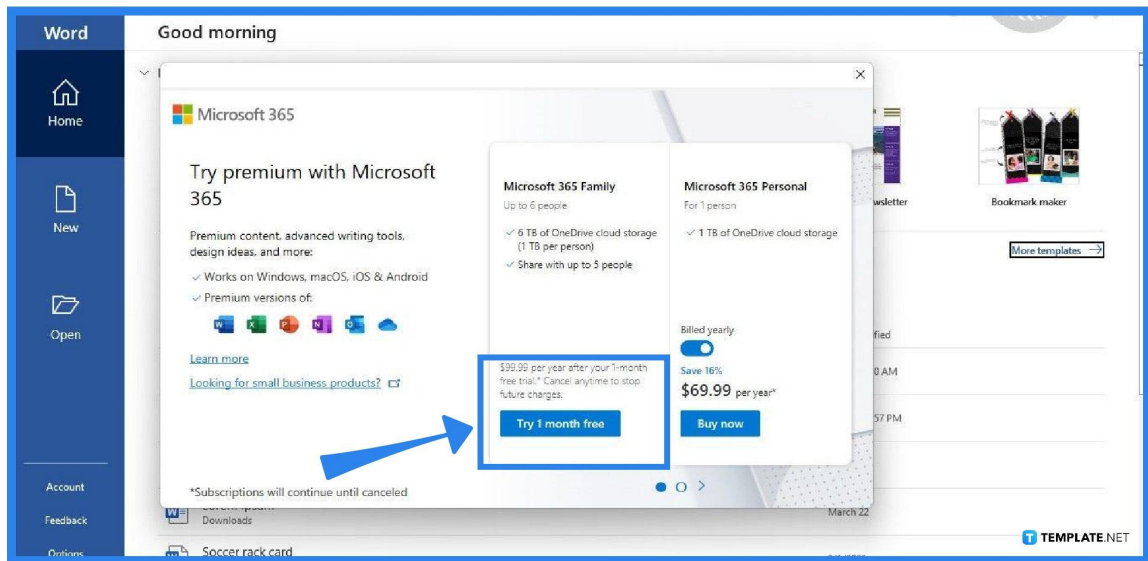
- **Step 2: Click Start Your Free Trial**



After you sign in, a panel will appear on your screen giving you the option to purchase a Microsoft 365 subscription or to start a free trial. If you want to access

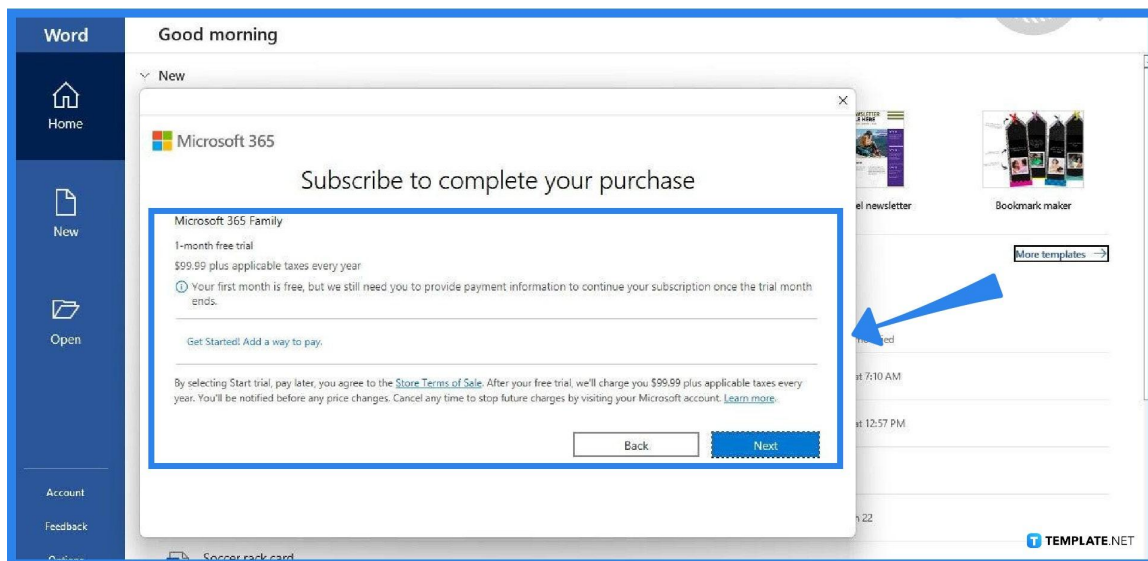
MS Word for free, select the Start Your Free Trial option.

- **Step 3: Click Try 1 Month Free**



After clicking the Start Your Free Trial button, you'll be brought to the Microsoft 365 purchase page. Click the Try 1 Month Free button under the Microsoft 365 Family section. It's the only available option to get a free trial of Microsoft Word and other Microsoft Office products.

- **Step 4: Add a Payment Method**



Next, you need to add a payment method to complete your purchase and

subscription to the free trial. Microsoft requires that a payment method must be chosen. But don't worry, the first month is guaranteed to be free. Your credit/debit card will not be charged as long as the free trial is still valid.



Other than debit cards and credit cards, PayPal is also an accepted payment method by Microsoft.

- **Step 5: Start Working in Microsoft Word**

Once the payment method is settled and you've completed the purchase of the free trial, you can then start working on Microsoft Word. You can [create tables in Microsoft Word](#), [add borders in Microsoft Word](#), and do other document creation activities.



You can end your Microsoft 365 subscription once your free trial expires.

Yes, there's a version of Microsoft Word that is permanently free, which is a web version of Microsoft Word, accessible only at Office.com.

Does the MS Word free trial apply to the mobile version?
