
How to Save Adobe Illustrator/PSD as PNG


Learn how to save Adobe Illustrator/PSD as PNG files since they are a popular choice to save as images. It can help preserve your work in case the software crashes.



How to Save Adobe Illustrator/PSD as PNG


When working on an Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop file, you might want to save your work or render it as an image. Here is how you can save it as a PNG file with these easy steps.

• Step 1: Open Adobe Illustrator/Photoshop



To get started, open the file you wish to save in Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop.

Step 2: Click File



Whether it's Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop, move your cursor onto the top of the screen and click File. With the former, you can click Export next and with the latter software, click on Save As.

• Step 3: Choose PNG

A new window will appear for both software. From there, you can choose the PNG option and then confirm the choice. And that is how you save Adobe Illustrator/PSD as a PNG file.



Whichever software you are using, most of the choice options actually have PNG as a file option.



FAQs

Can I save multiple images in Adobe Illustrator as PNG files all at once?

No, you can only save one image at a time in Adobe Illustrator.

Can I save multiple images as PNG files in Adobe Photoshop at the same time?

No, you can't, you are only able to save one PNG image at a time in Adobe Photoshop.

Is there a shortcut to directly save an Illustrator/PSD file into PNG?

No, there is no known shortcut to directly save them as PNG files.
