


How to Spell Check In Photoshop

You may use Adobe Photoshop to modify the backdrop of a photograph, correct pixel manipulation, add, edit, and rearrange image sizes, and make your photoshoots more visually appealing. But it does not stop there, users of Adobe Photoshop can be assured that the text present within their images has been checked.




How to Spell Check In Photoshop

Editors and proficient users of the software may not have the luxury of time, especially if you are in a rush to meet the client's deadlines. You can at least be double sure of the content you are adding to your image.

- **Step 1: Open Adobe Photoshop**

You will first be opening the software on your computer, either access it through your Applications folder if you are an Apple User, or search and click on the desktop icon as a Windows user. Proceed to open the file you would want to check the spelling of your text.

- **Step 2: Open 'Check Spelling'**




Pick the text to be checked or, in the Layers panel, select a type layer to check all the text on that layer. Select 'Edit,' then 'Check Spelling.' Such as the example presented in the image, a sample text has been added. Since it is the correct spelling, the spell check will notify it to be complete.



Hidden layers of text cannot be checked on their spelling but a notification will alert you about that.

- **Step 3: Perform Spell Check**



After you have performed the spell check, a new window will inform you that the spell check is complete which signifies that no error was spotted. But when Photoshop recognizes a probable problem in the Not in Dictionary box, click 'Change' to replace the wrongly spelled word with the recommended repair.



A language specification can also be seen when the spell check has spotted the incorrect word.

FAQs

Does Photoshop have autocorrect text?

Yes, Photoshop does when you go to the 'Editor', click the 'Auto Correct' tool in the sidebar, where a succession of edit tiles with suggested settings show above the picture, and all you have to do is then select one of the 'Auto Correct' choices.

Does Photoshop have an auto fix?

There are a number of various auto adjustments Photoshop can perform, and each one provides a unique style; one that we recommend you try is 'Auto Tone'.

How do you edit already written text in Photoshop?

Select the type layer in the 'Layers' panel and the 'Horizontal' or 'Vertical Type tool' in the 'Tools' panel, then click the checkmark in the choices bar when you are done doing the necessary edit.

Why can't I edit type in Photoshop?

You are about to click inside the current text if there are no dotted lines so make sure that the layer you selected is the one you want to add a text to.

How do you reset the text tool in Photoshop?

To return the 'Options' bar to its default setting, right-click the tool icon in the 'Tool Preset Picker' and select 'Reset Tool' or 'Reset All Tools'.
