
Last Will and Testament Sizes

Last will and testaments are legal and notarized documents that clients or testators use in planning the distribution of their assets and properties, with the help of a lawyer or attorney. Last Will and Testament Sizes Standard

Letter (8.5 x 11)

The standard US Letter size paper follows the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) for paper sizes, adopting the ANSI Y14.1 standard. The US Letter size has dimensions of 8.5 x 11 inches, with the format almost identical to the ISO A4 format, functioning similarly in producing business and educational documents, like last will and testament, blank forms, cover letters, or consumer pamphlets.

Legal (8.5 x 14)

The Legal size paper has a measurement of 8.5 x 14 inches that many businesses, agencies, and institutions use for printing legal documents, including last will and testament, for court use, as many lawyers and attorneys recommend the paper size for clients. Businesses also utilize the Legal size paper for different purposes aside from legal documents by generating it as a brochure, leaflet, flyer, or price list.

A4 (8.3 x 11.7)

The A4 standard size paper has measurements of 8.3 x 11.7 inches, following the standards set by the International Organization for Standardization under ISO 216. The A series paper is the most common variation, with the A4 size recognized as the classic paper size for printers that many individuals and organizations use for standard documents. These include kit worksheets, deeds, one-page summaries, and final papers that can fit the average envelope size for delivering classified documents.


Last Will and Testament Sizes for Print


Last Will and Testament Sizes for Microsoft Word


Last Will and Testament Sizes for Apple Pages

Mac users can utilize Apple Pages on their branded Mac devices to develop last will and testament documents on various paper sizes, including the US Letter size measuring 8.5×11 inches or the A4 size of 8.3×11.7 inches that individuals write or accomplish in the presence of two witnesses. Aside from the standard sizes, Apple Pages allow users to select from other paper sizes, including the tabloid size with measurements of 11×17 inches, folio size measuring 8.5×13 inches, executive size of 7.25×10.5 inches, and A3 with measurements of 11.69×16.54 inches.



Last Will and Testament Sizes for Google Docs

Google Docs is a user-friendly word processor that an individual can use by logging into their Google Account. It has a set quantity of paper sizes that individuals can choose from, including the standard sizes of US Letter size and A4 size, but aside from these, there are also the tabloid, folio, legal, A5, A3, B4, etc. And the best thing about Google Docs is that it automatically saves the progress as the user writes the content.



Last Will and Testament Sizes FAQs

What is the font size of a last will and testament?

The font size for last will and testament documents follows the 12-point font size that lawyers and courts use for legal documents.

What is a good size for a last will and testament?

Last will and testaments are legal documents that must have the standard sizes of either the US Letter size of 8.5 x 11 inches or A4 of 8.3 x 11.7 inches.

How many pages should a last will and testament be?

The last will and testament document must be between the average four to five pages.

To reduce the document size of a last will and testament, the individual writing the document must only incorporate necessary information and remove unnecessary elements like charts or clipart images.
