
Project Scope

Project Scope Definition & Meaning

What Is a Project Scope?

responsibilities of each member and details how the completed work will be verified and approved. In other words, this document also provides a clear understanding of why the project was initiated and defines its key goals.

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


Event Project Scope

Defining a project scope also leads to a creation of a work breakdown structure, which breaks work down into smaller, more manageable required tasks.

It establishes control factors

Another key purpose of defining project scope is that it establishes control factors of the project. This is done through effective scope management, which can then be used to address elements that may result in small or big changes throughout the lifespan of a project. Establishing control factors also helps avoid problematic scenarios such as going over budget, the project going way behind the intended schedule, and so on.

Main Scope Statement

This part of the project scope defines the project requirements, sets the general goals for the project schedule and tasks, and identifies who will be involved.

Deliverables

This states what will be provided at the end of the project and when it will be provided.

Acceptance Criteria


This part describes the project metrics for success.

Exclusions

This part of the project scope clearly defines what should not be included in the project.

Constraints

This element of the project scope lists things that cannot be changed, also known as the project's hard limits.



Project scope is an important part of the project planning phase and generally involves determining and documenting a list of specific project goals, deliverables, tasks, costs, and deadlines.


Product scope is different from project scope since it defines the capabilities, characteristics, features, and functions of the deliverables at the end of the project that's being undertaken.
