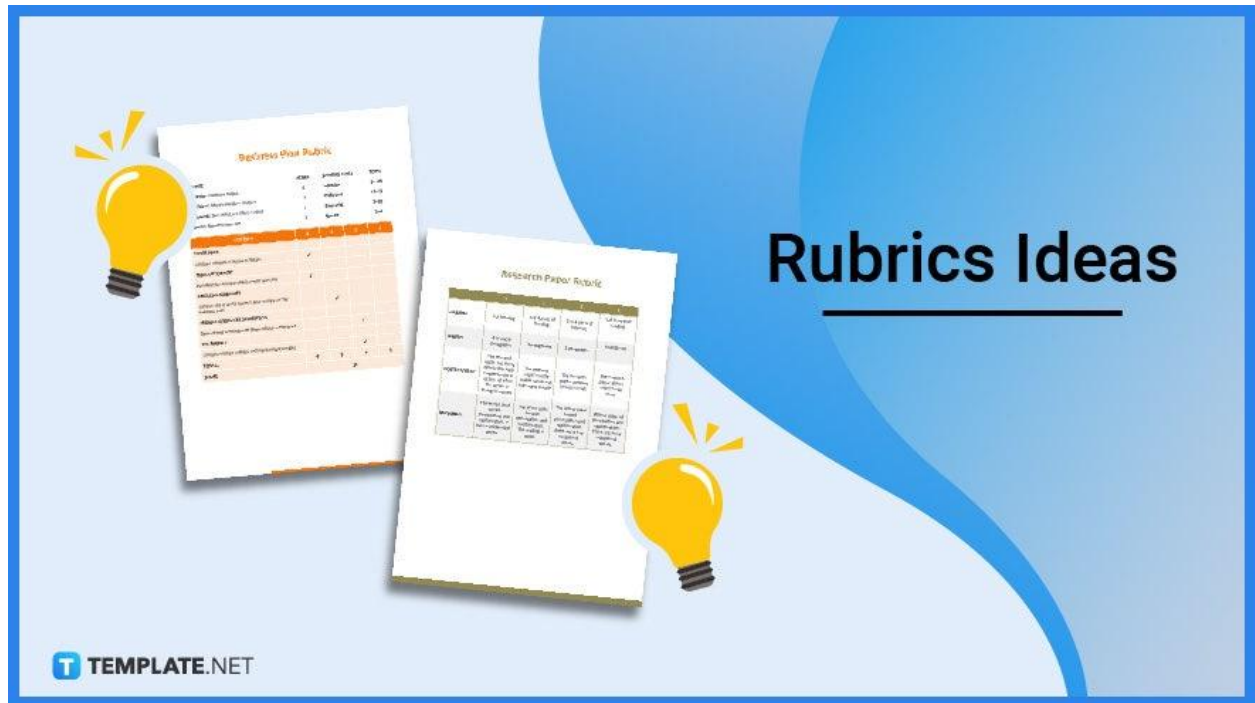


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Rubric Ideas and Examples

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

Checklist Rubric Ideas and Examples

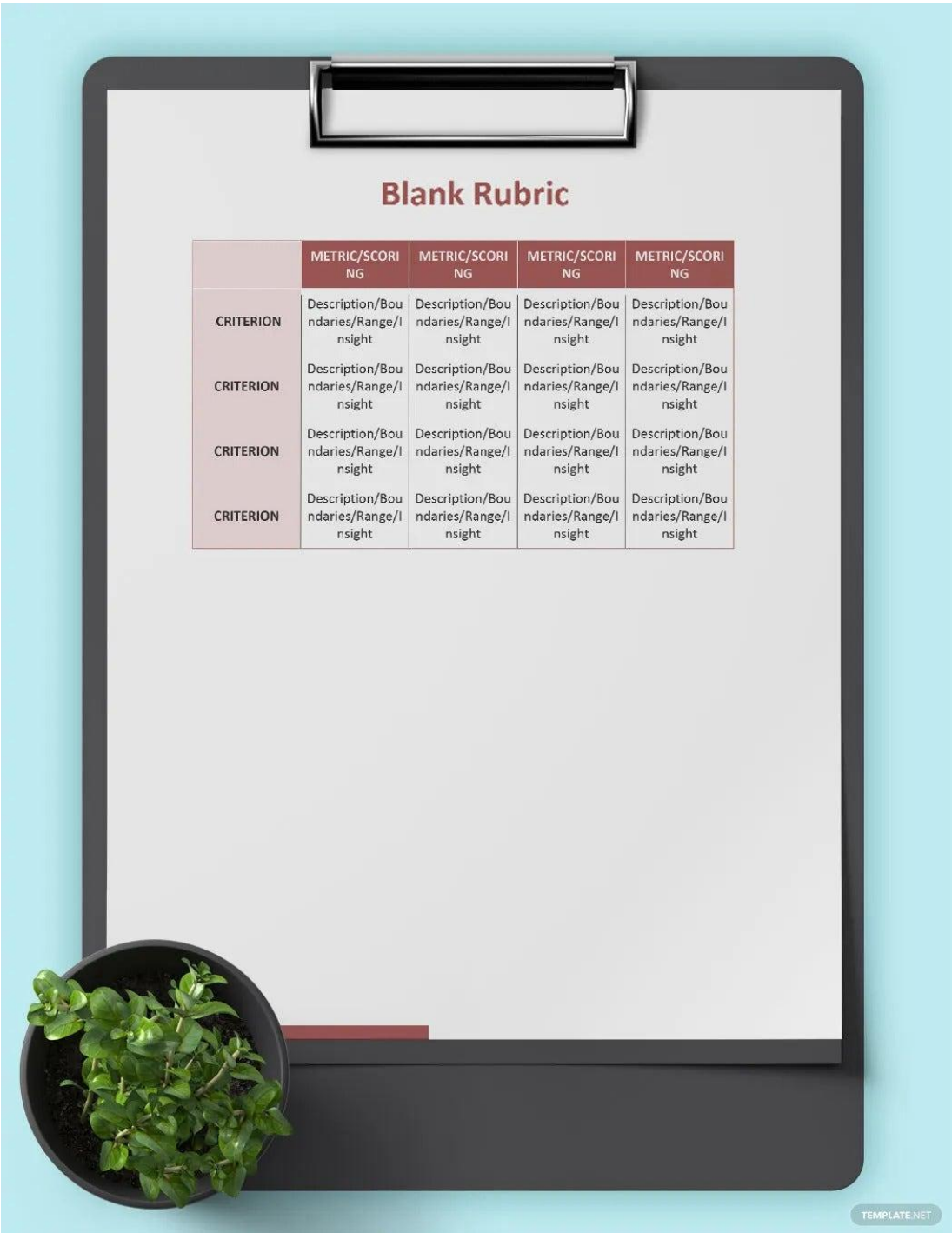
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Blank Rubric Ideas and Examples
