

Sprint sizes come in varying forms depending on the type of projects being involved. Whether it's for a project in the business, entertainment, or even food industry, the sizes of sprints will differ based on what sort of tasks need to be focused on.

Sprint Sizes Standard

Letter (8.5 × 11)

Most office documents are printed out in the US Letter size 8.5 × 11 inches and that includes sprint documents. Whether it is for scrum planning or for a sprint schedule, these sizes have the space for the details.

A4 (8.3 × 11.7)

A4 is a very recognizable paper size. coming in at 8.3 × 11.7 inches, it is used for a lot of daily and average printing from office reports to textbooks. This also includes almost every sprint document.

Sprint Sizes for Print

Whether it is for sprint meetings that discuss the scale of a project, or agile project management, having a document printed can help communicate the information across the team.

A4 (8.3 × 11.7 inches) - Useful for sprint documents involving business and corporate purposes. With its size, everything can be typed in an organized fashion.

Letter (8.5 × 11 inches) - another one of the two standard sizes. Sprint documents printed in this paper allow users to add more details regarding their sprint strategy.

Sprint Sizes for MS Word

Following the sizes of A4 and Letter, the recommended sizes for your sprint document when made through MS Word are 210 × 297 mm and 215.9 × 279.4 mm. With the size options in MS Word, you won't need to do any calculations on the size numbers.

Sprint Sizes for Apple Pages

Using Apple Pages, you are free to set up the size of your sprint document in any range you prefer. However, the recommended size is still A4 (8.3 × 11.7 inches) and Letter (8.5 × 11 inches).

Sprint Sizes for Google Docs

Whether the projects are a software system design or a series of performance outputs, the size for the sprint documents is the same as above when it is made with Google Docs. Just like Microsoft Word, the recommended sizes for sprint documents are 210 × 297 mm (A4) and 215.9 × 279.4 mm (Letter).

Sprint Sizes FAQs

What should be an ideal duration of a Sprint?

The ideal length of a Sprint should be a minimum of 2 weeks, which is enough time for a team/organization to accomplish a project.

What is the output of Sprint?

The output of a Sprint is the results of a project done in a block of time whether it be a product, goal, safety measures, or anything else of value.

What are Sprint deliverables?

Sprint deliverables are things of value that were made or used during a sprint, examples being modules, estimation charts, events, etc.

What is Sprint capacity?

A Sprint capacity refers to the maximum amount of production that is made by the employees based on the limitations.

How do I choose my Sprint size?

Choose your Sprint size based on the amount of content needed to be put on paper.

What is the maximum length a Sprint planning should be?

The maximum length of Sprint planning should be as long as eight hours.

How is Sprint velocity calculated?

To calculate Sprint velocity, add the sum of story points completed in a sprint and then divide by the number of Sprints.

How do you calculate Sprint backlog?

You can calculate a Sprint backlog by using a points system and reviewing the priorities of the project.

How many Sprints are in a Scrum?

It varies based on the project's scale but it is usually a few as two/three and as many as 10/20 Sprints.

How many people are in a Sprint design?

It is recommended that 4-7 people be involved in a Sprint.
