• Step 2: Adjust Preset and Mode



A dialog box will open after clicking "Image Trace." From there, you can manually adjust them based on your needs.

• Step 3: Click the Following Options

The next steps involve clicking on a lot of things. First, move your cursor up to the menu bar and click on "Object," "Image Trace," and "Expand."

• Step 4: Save As

Finally, move back up to the menu bar to click on "File" followed by "Save As." From there, you can choose to save the file as an Illustrator EPS file format and then click "Save."
