
# How do I Resize a Picture on Adobe InDesign




# How Do I Resize a Picture on Adobe InDesign

In Adobe InDesign, size matters, in this case, the right picture size may make or break your design. Below is a step-by-step process for resizing your content to fit the overall design.


# • Step 1: Open Adobe InDesign

The first thing that you have to do is to launch the Adobe InDesign software. This software application can be downloaded on almost all devices, for as long as, it is purchased through a package with all the Adobe software applications or as a single software application.




### • Step 2: Choose Selection Tool

Upon choosing the Selection Tool, the Content Grabber icon appears at the center of the frame.




#### • Step 3: Start Resizing the Picture

When the Content Grabber Icon is clicked, a brown frame surrounds the artwork, this appears the original size of the picture. To start resizing, hold the shift key and drag it on the corners of the image to resize accordingly.



#### • Step 4: Resize the Frame

Most often, images are inside a frame for a cleaner look and easier movement, hence you can also easily resize the frame by selecting the frame with the Selection Tool, and then selecting AutoFit in the Frame Fitting section.



# • Step 5: Finalize Design

After resizing the images, relocating the elements, and completing the design. Make sure to save your design.
