
How Do I See Word Count in Adobe InDesign

Learn how to see the word count in Adobe InDesign. That way writers and designers will know if their content is enough or not in terms of words.




How Do I See Word Count in Adobe InDesign

Checking the word count in Adobe InDesign takes a few seconds. Here are three steps on how to do it.


• Step 1: Open a document with text in Adobe InDesign

To get started, open a text document at Adobe InDesign.



Step 2: Click on 'Window' and 'Info'

Next, move the cursor to the menu bar and click on 'Window'. A dropdown will appear, to which you must click on 'Info'. This will open a small dialogue box where you can see the word count.



Step 3: Select the paragraph

Next, click on the textbox icon and select the paragraph you wish to do a word count on. The dialog box will immediately show the word count. And that is how you see the word count in Adobe InDesign.





The dialog box also shows details like how many Lines, Characters, and Paragraphs are present in the highlighted text.
