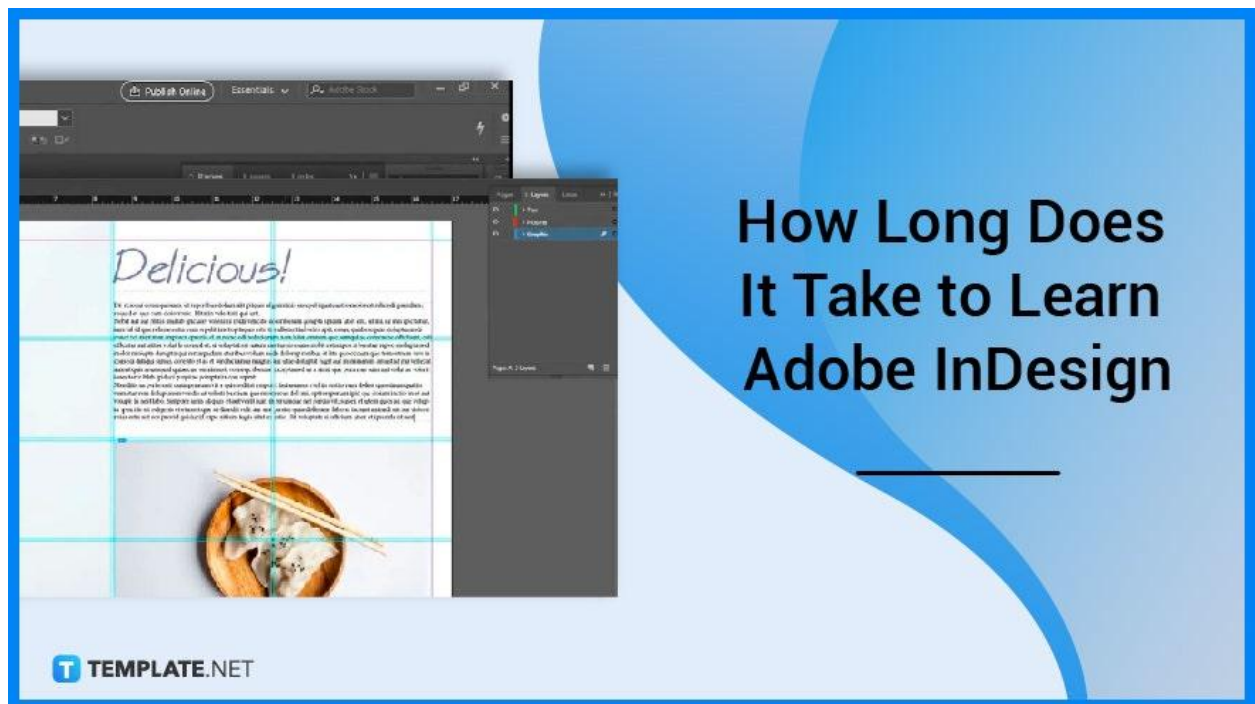


How Long Does It Take to Learn Adobe InDesign

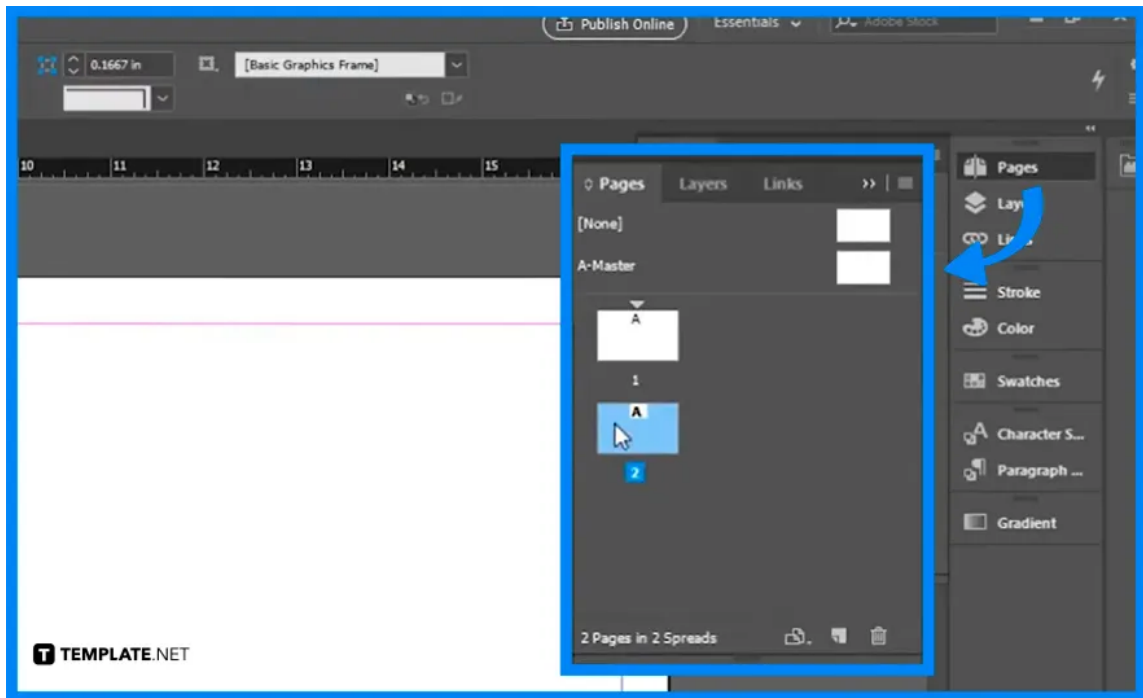

How Long Does It Take to Learn Adobe InDesign

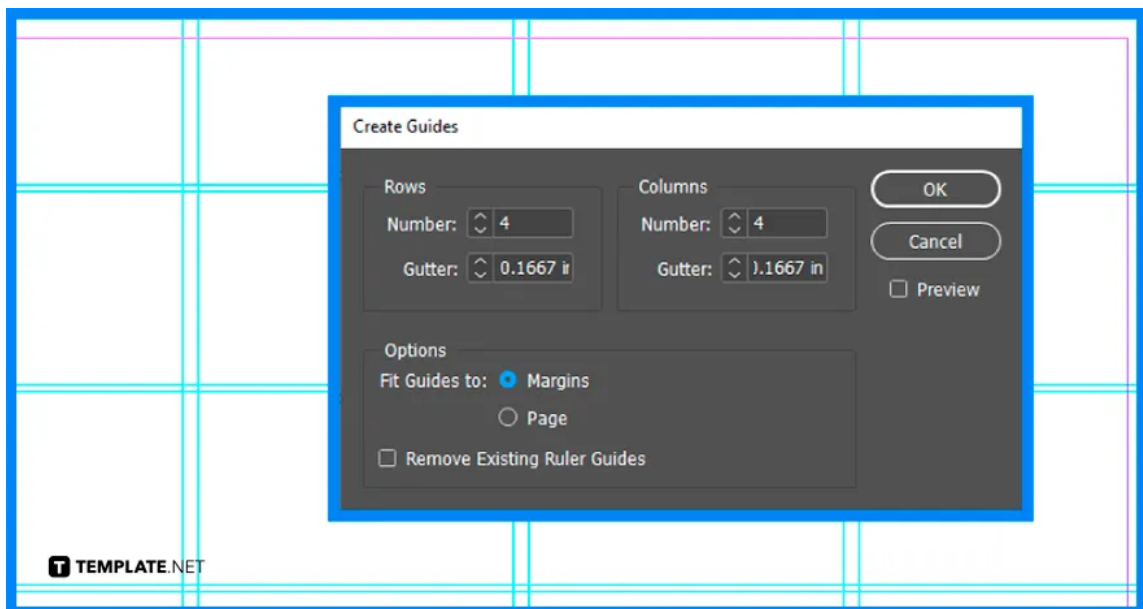
Some people learn Adobe InDesign in just one day, so if you want to learn using this software, watching some online tutorials or taking a course for 1-2 days can help you acquire the necessary skills in InDesign. Below are some basic steps you need to remember when learning how to use Adobe InDesign for your page layout design and publishing work.

- **Step 1: Open the Layers Panel**



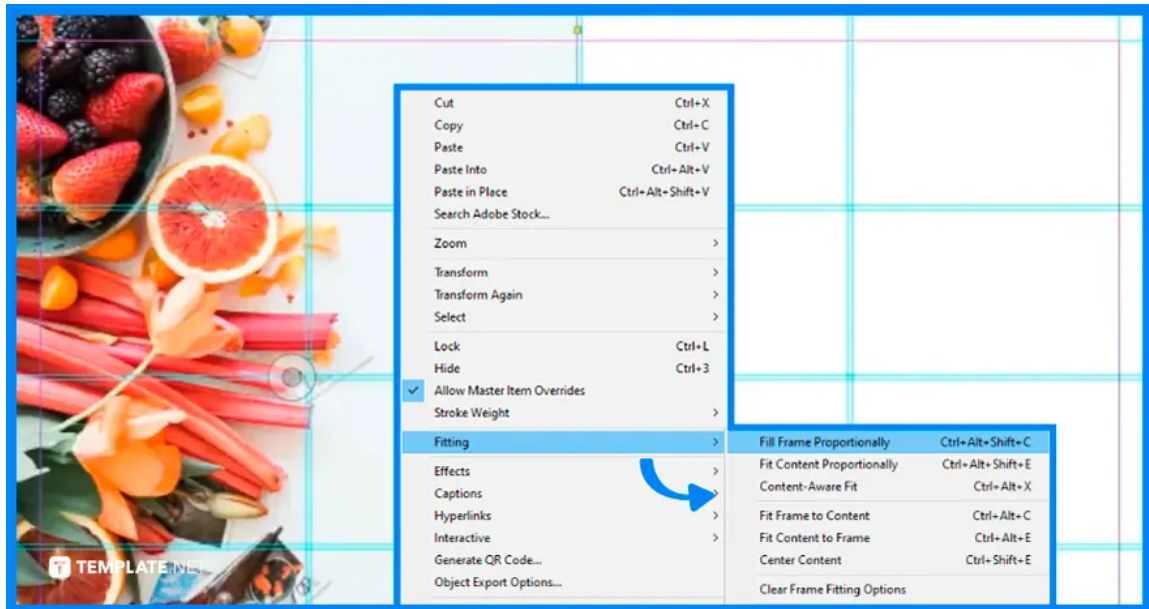
Go to Adobe InDesign. Then, open the Layers panel and you will see that it includes Pages, Layers, and Links that you can use while working on your document or publication layout.

- **Step 2: Go to Layout > Create Guides**



Search for the Layout menu and select Create Guides option. In the Create Guides dialog box, enter the number of rows and columns you need in your document.

- **Step 3: Place an Image and Fill It into the Frame Proportionally**



Place an image that you will use for the background of your document. Then, right-click and select Fitting > Fill Frame Proportionally (Ctrl+Alt+Shift+C).

- **Step 4: Add Text and Other Elements**



Add text to your document using the Type tool. You may also add another image to supplement your content.
