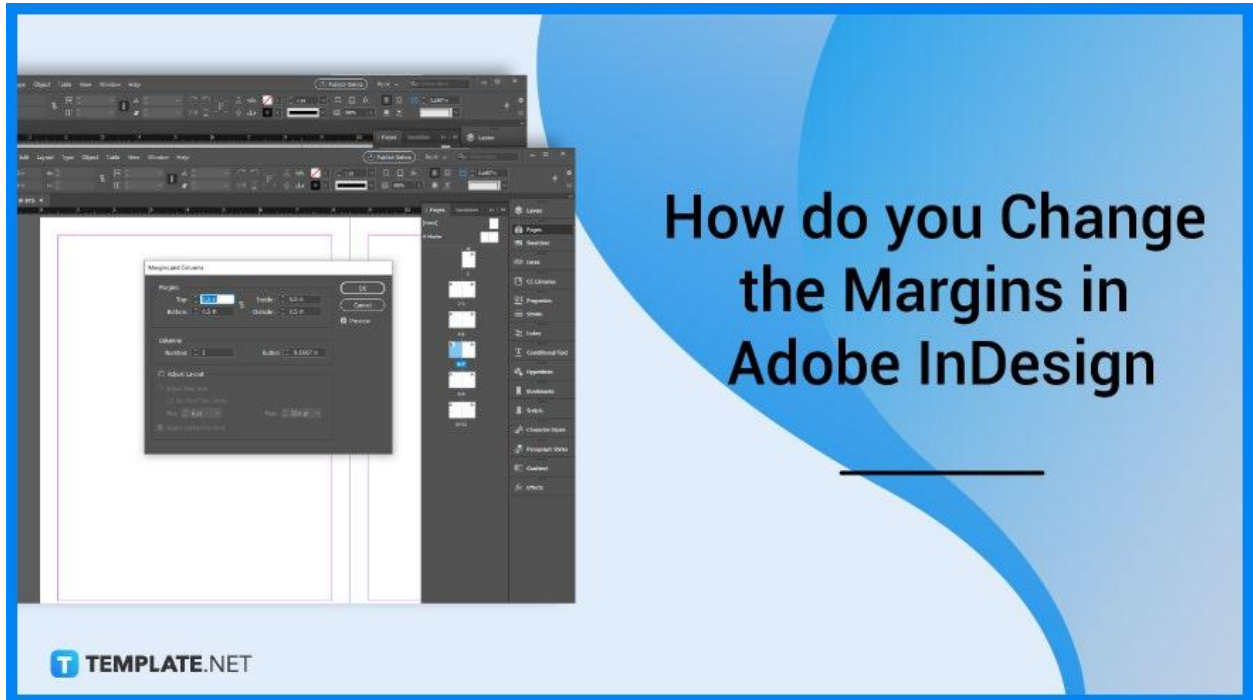


# How do you Change the Margins in Adobe InDesign

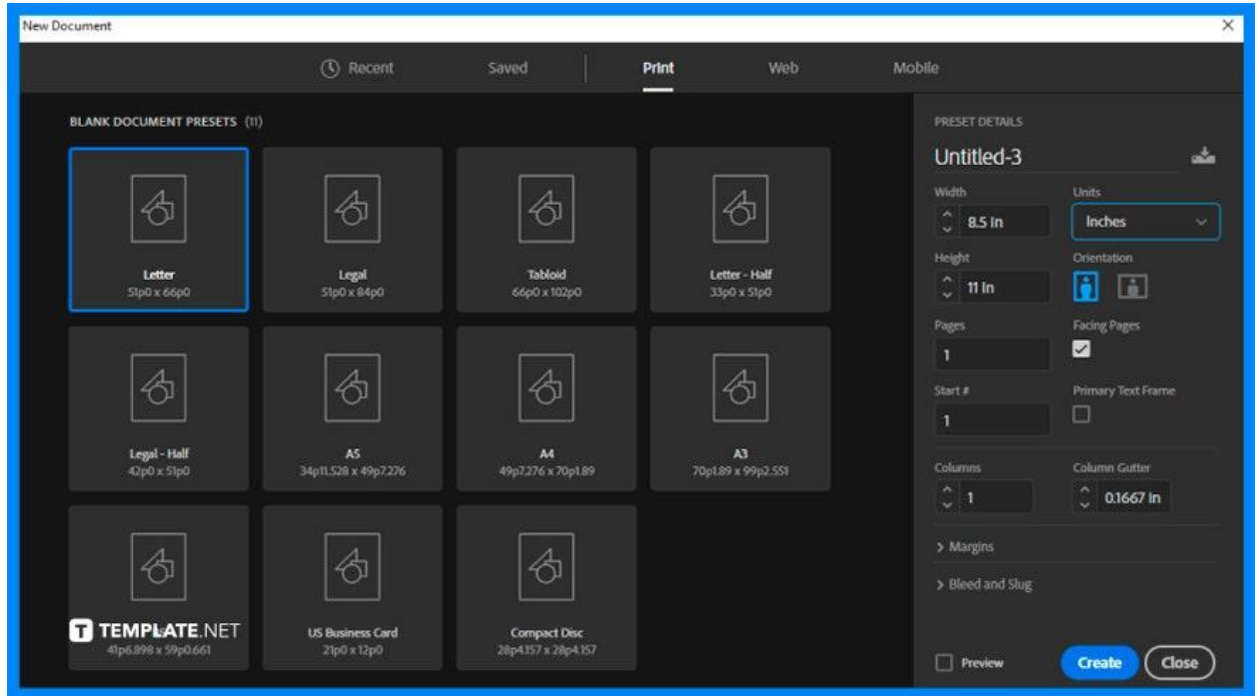


## How do you Change the Margins in Adobe InDesign

Margins are little details that make a whole lot of difference. Here is a step-by-step process to change the margins on your Adobe InDesign.

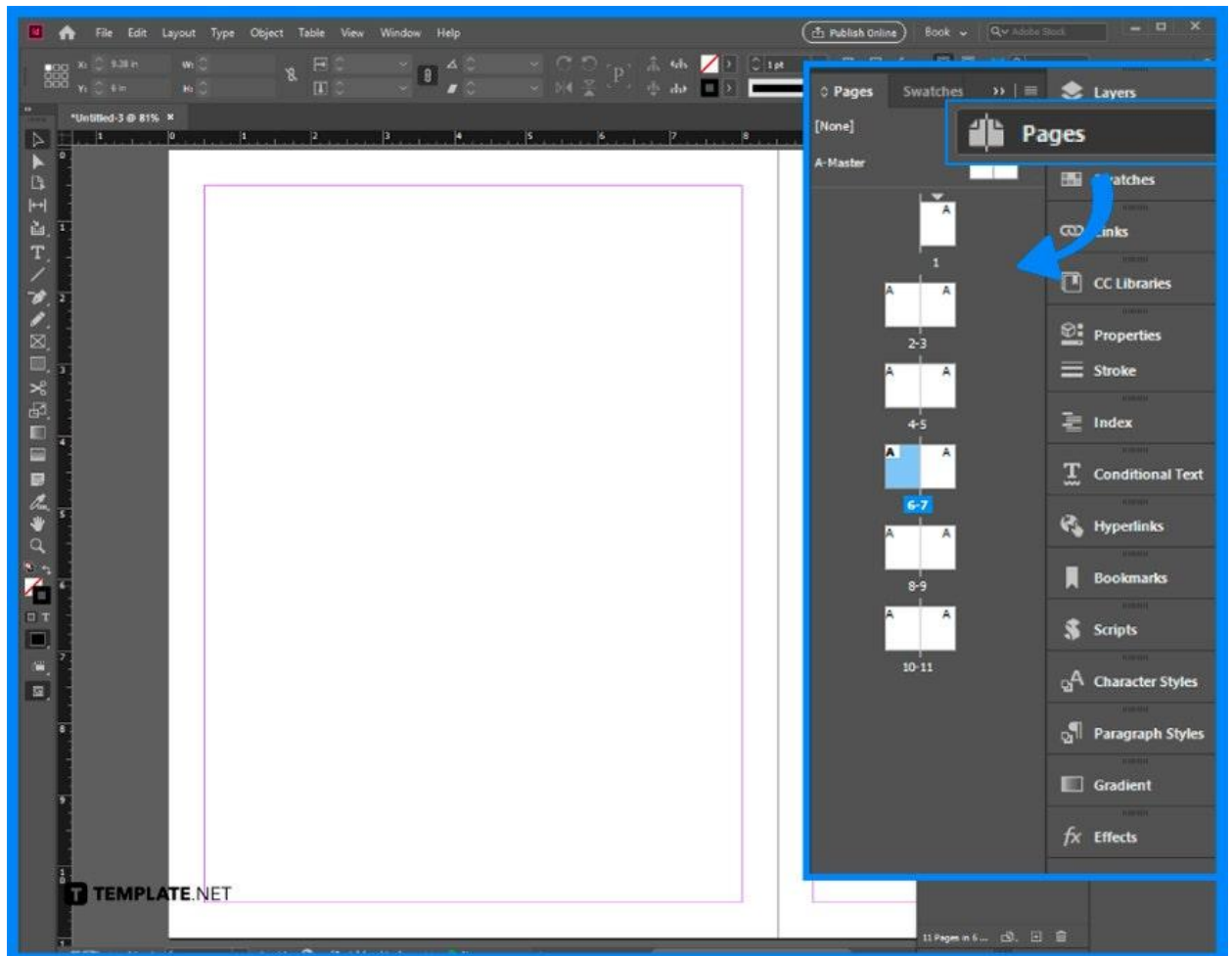
- **Step 1: Open Adobe InDesign**

Start by opening Adobe InDesign, and launch your design. The Adobe InDesign software can be purchased as a package with all other Adobe applications or as a single software application.



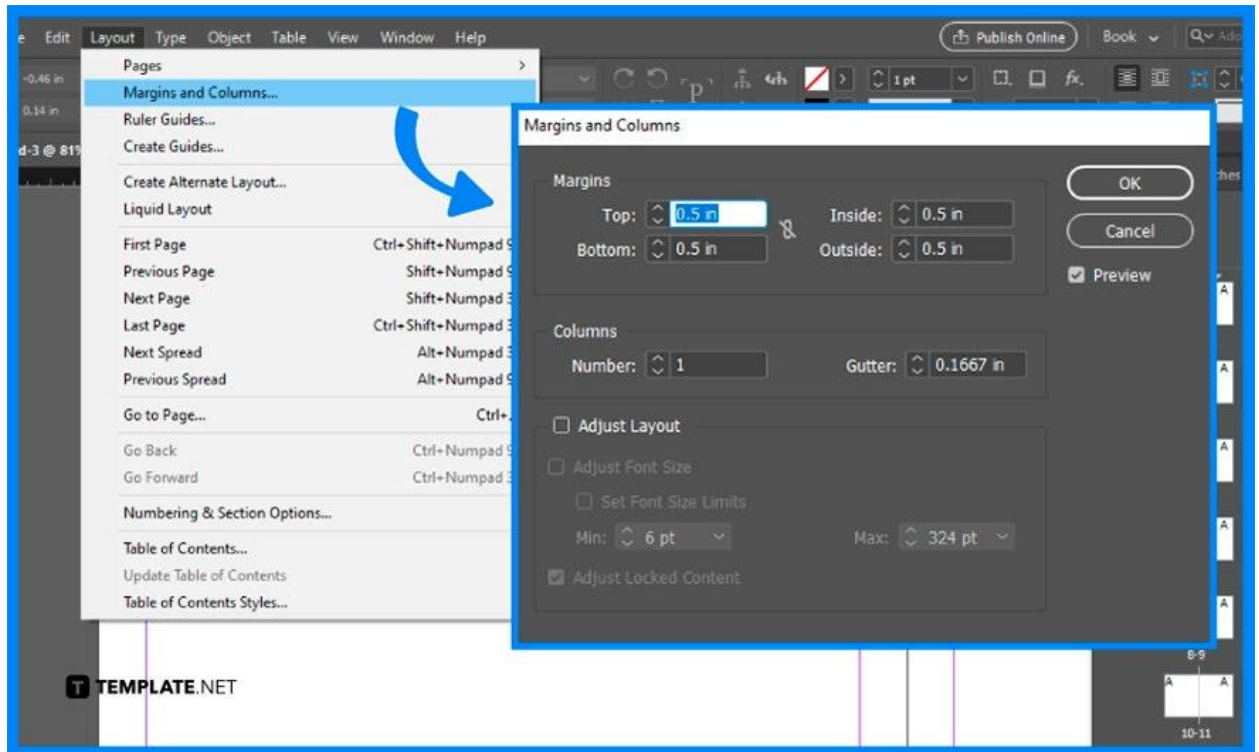
- **Step 2: Go to Pages Panel**

Select Window, then Pages to open the Pages Panel, and select the thumbnails for the pages you wish to change the margins at.



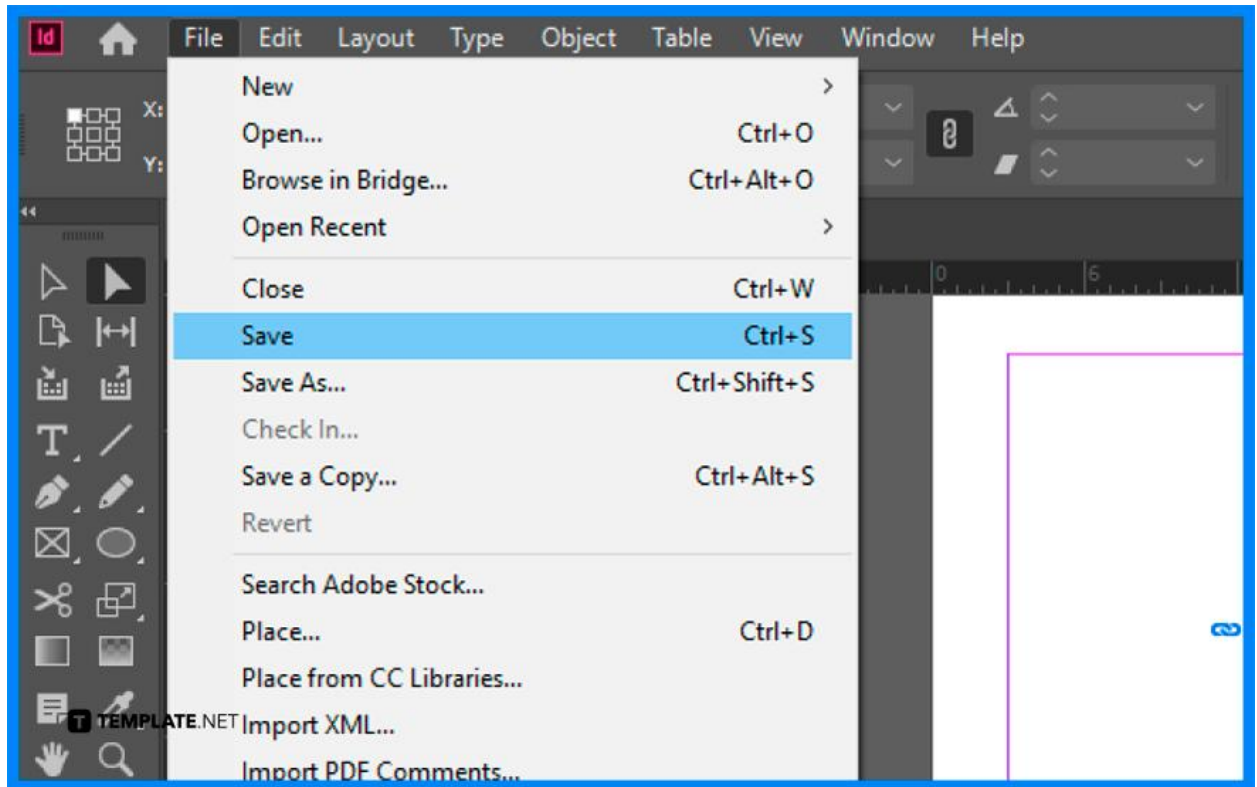
- **Step 3: Go to Margins and Columns**

Choose Layout, and then go to Margins and Columns. From there, enter the values for the Top, Bottom, Left, and Right Margins, as well as the number of columns and the gutter.



- **Step 4: Save Design**

If you are already happy with the margins, do not forget to save your design.
