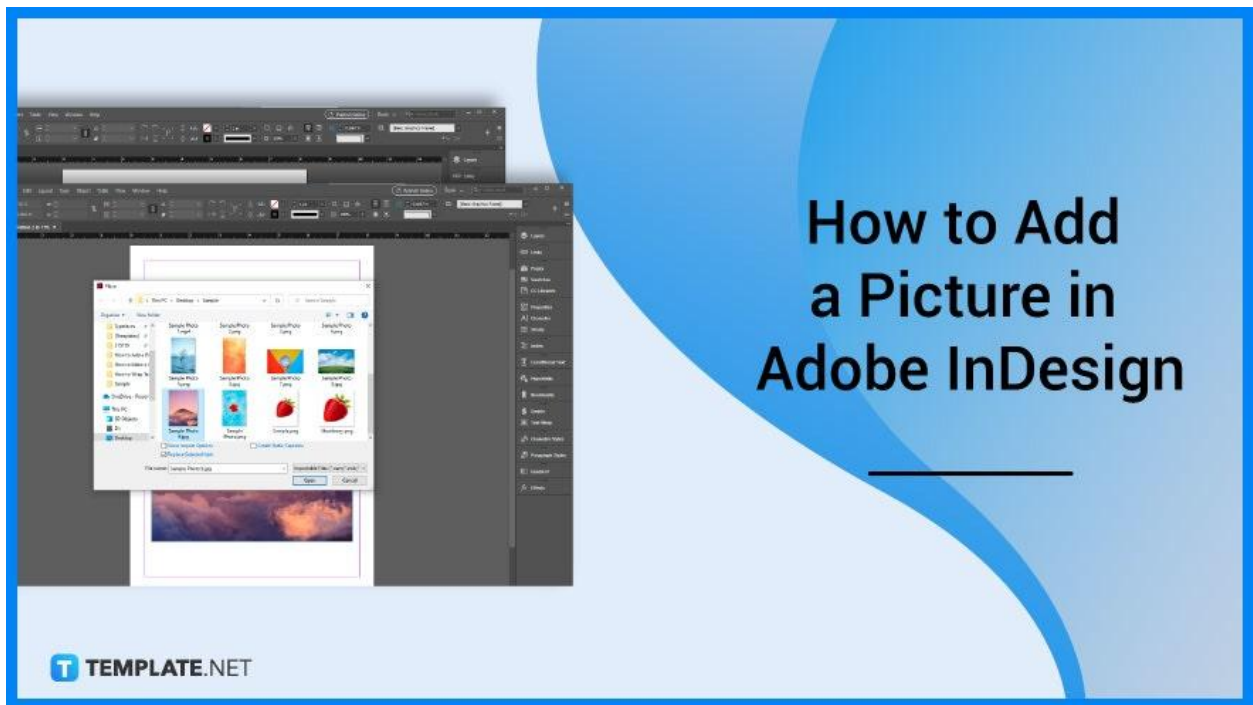


How to Add a Picture in Adobe InDesign

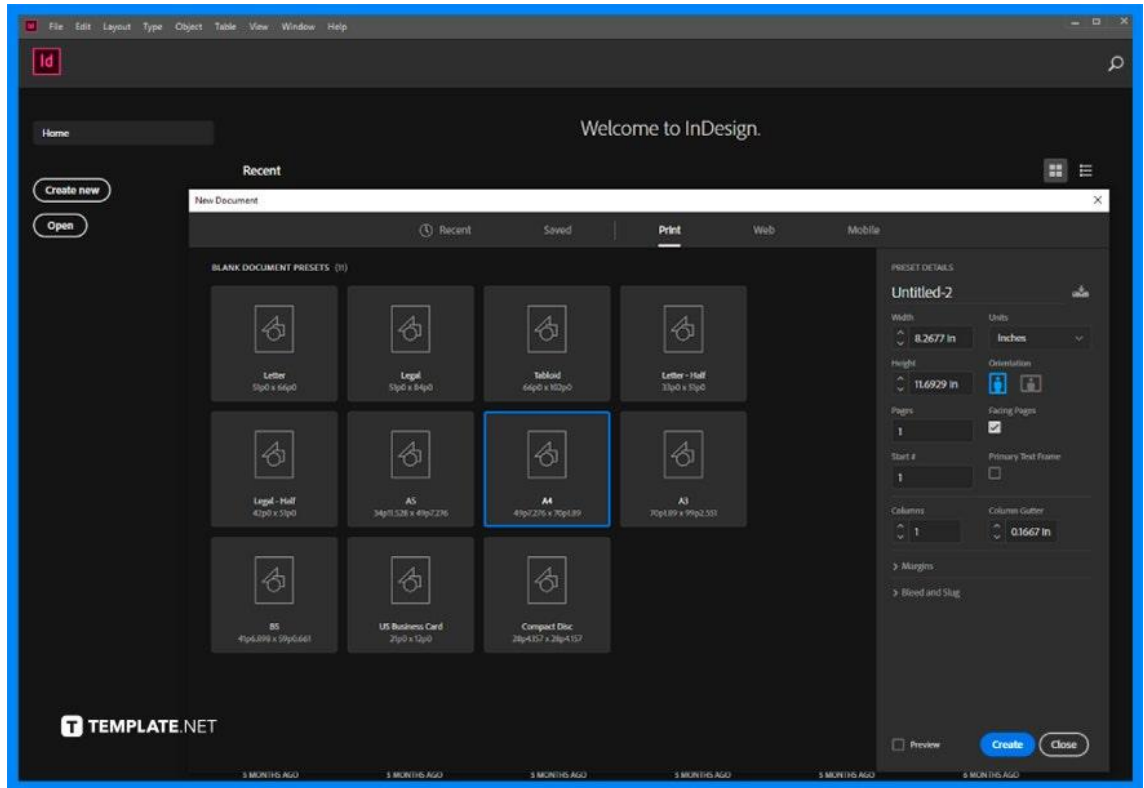


How to Add a Picture in Adobe InDesign

Pictures provide extra quality and substance in an output. Below is a step-by-step process of adding a picture in Adobe InDesign.

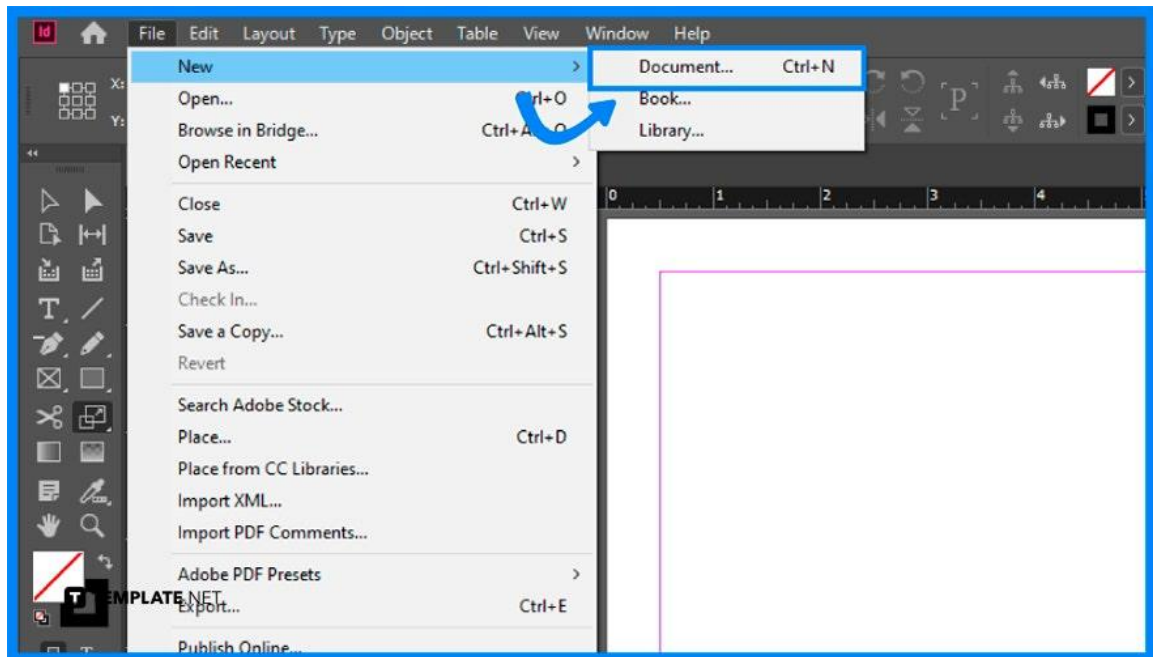
- **Step 1: Open InDesign**

To start the process, make sure to have genuine Adobe InDesign software by purchasing a single package with other Adobe software applications or buying Adobe InDesign software alone. Then, open your Adobe InDesign software.



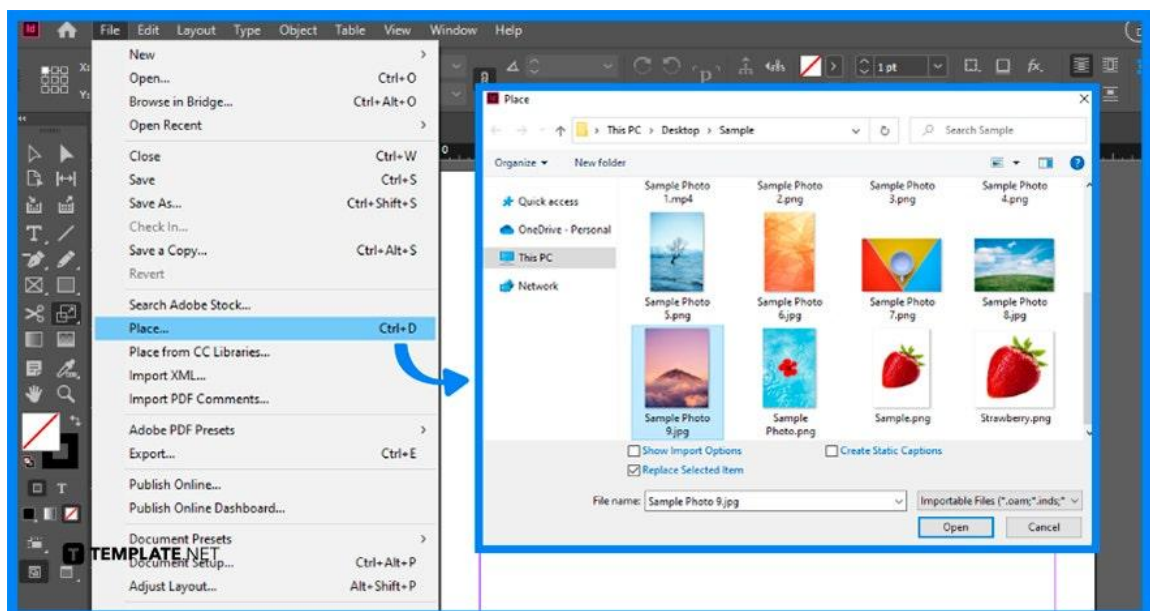
- **Step 2: Select the Document**

Open the document that you will be working with. Go to “File” then open from the Control Panel. If you do n have a document yet, go to “File” then select “New Document” and decide the settings for your new document.



- **Step 3: Choose the Picture**

Click "File" then select "Place" in the control panel. Navigate to the picture file you would like to import, and select the picture by double-clicking the file name.



- **Step 4: Control the Picture**

Format your picture by adjusting the size, dragging them to the perfect location, and enhancing some aspects of the image. To adjust the size of your picture, select the tool and click one of the handles (small squares) located on the frame. To adjust the location, select the image and then move and drag the cursor to the perfect location.

- **Step 5: Repeat and Save**

Continue repeating the process by going from Steps 1 to 4, and then if done, make sure to save.
