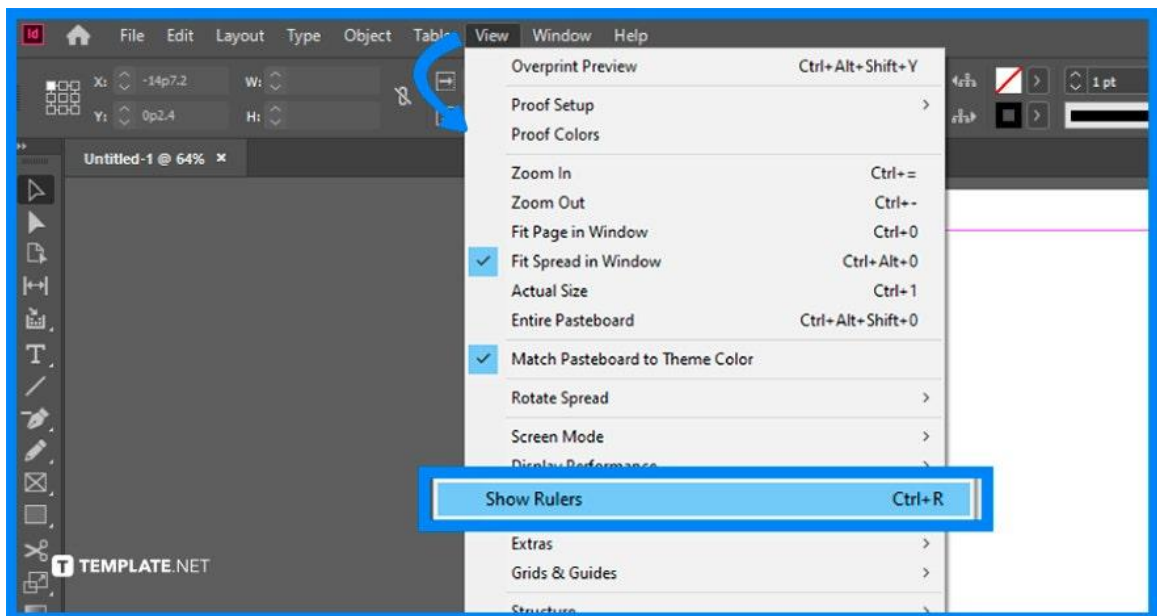


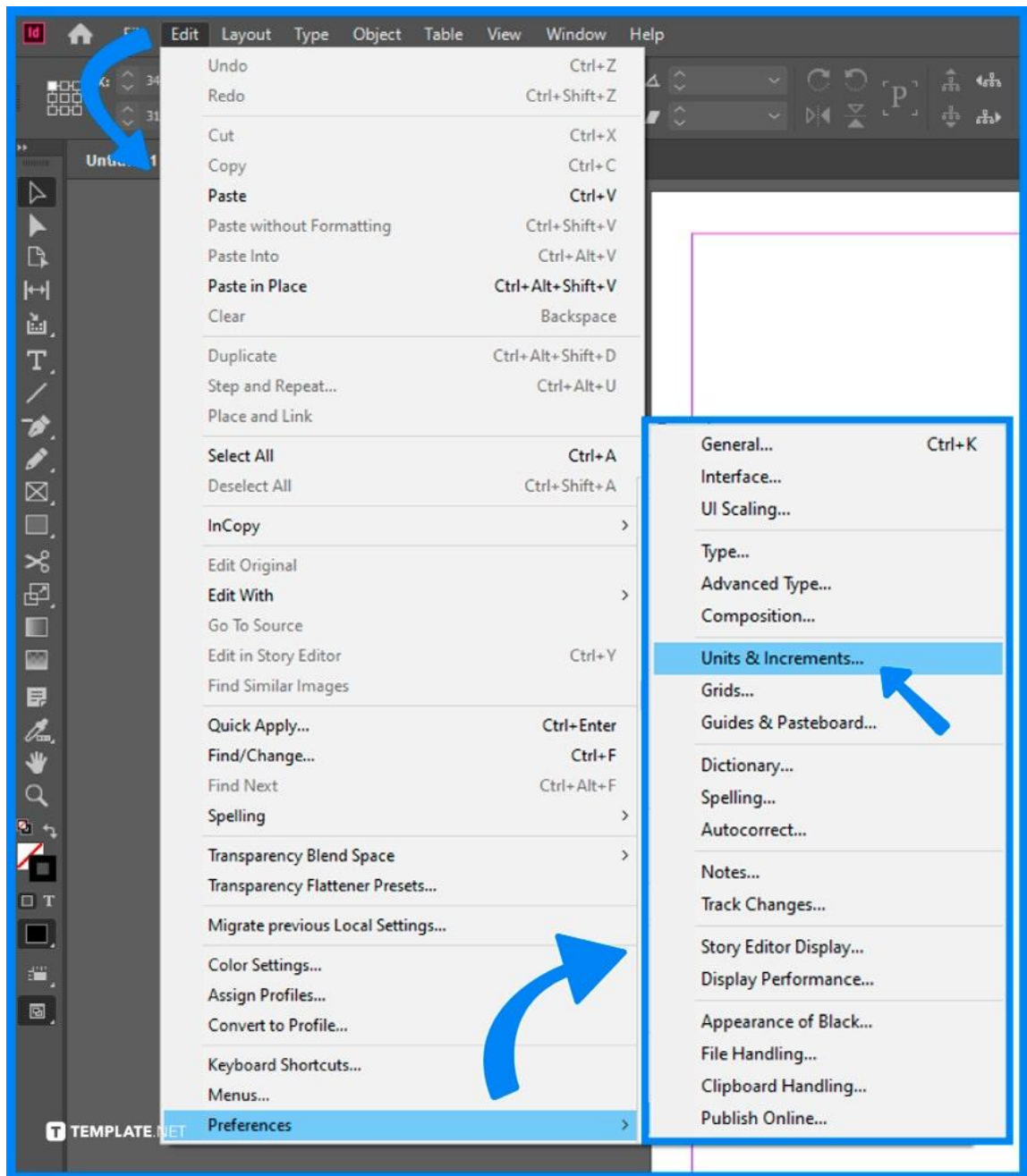
- **Step 2: Click View**

Navigate your cursor to the upper left side of your interface then click “View” then select “Show Rulers” if ever the rulers are not shown in the workspace.



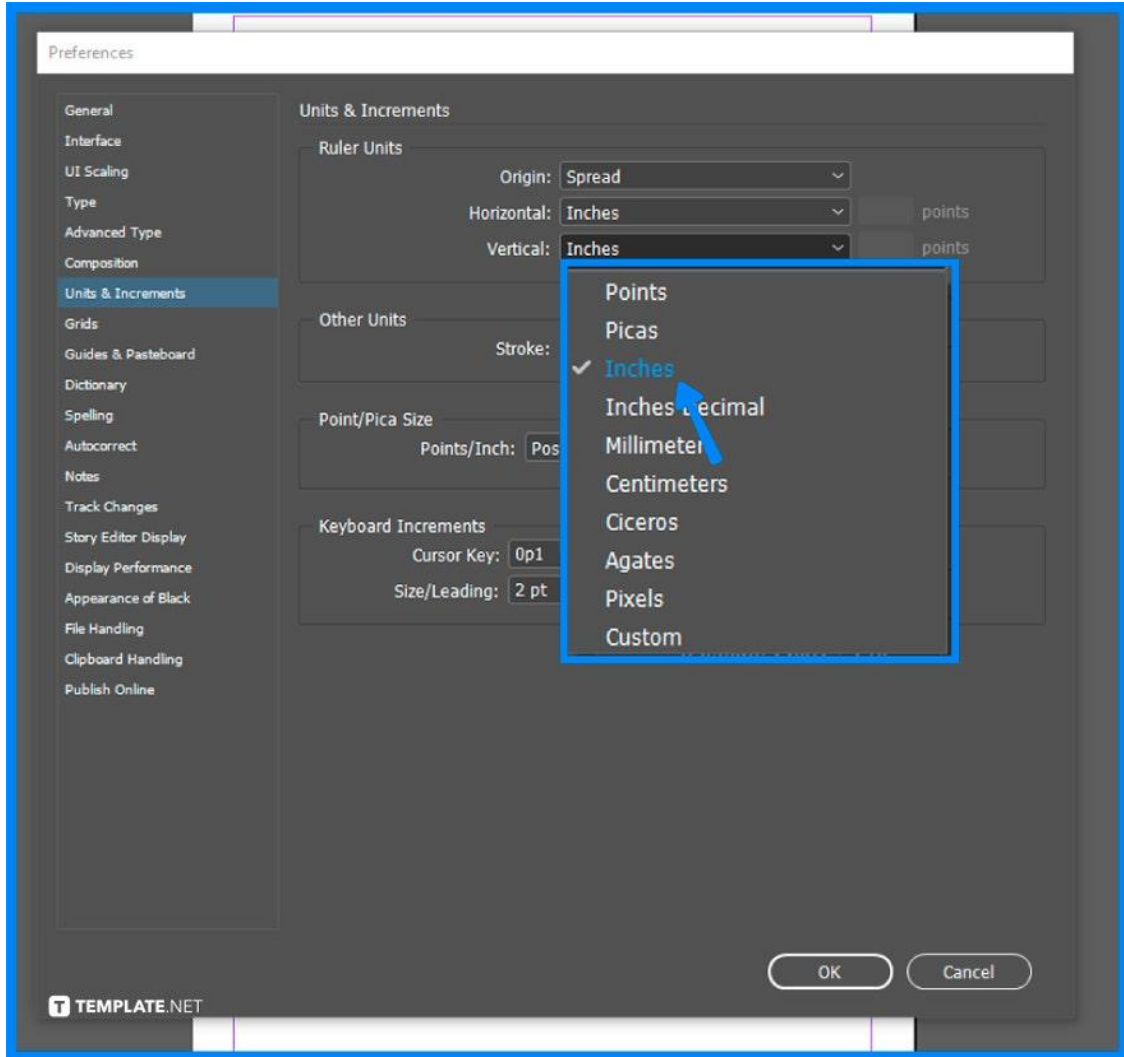
- **Step 3: Go to Edit**

After enabling rulers, go to the Edit menu, then to “Preferences” and then to “Units & Increments”.



- **Step 4: Select Inches**

Select the “Inches” from the Horizontal and Vertical drop-down menus to change both rulers. If you wish to change just one side then you may do so by simply clicking the part where you want inches to be used.



- **Step 5: Click OK**

To start using the unit of measurement in inches, click Ok.
