
# How to Convert PDF to Adobe InDesign




### How to Convert PDF to Adobe InDesign

In the step-by-step process below, you will be acquainted with how to efficiently convert PDF files to Adobe InDesign for easier editing and improvement of your document or graphic design file.


#### Step 1: Secure an Adobe InDesign


# • Step 2: Open a New Document

Open Adobe InDesign, create a new .indd document and ensure the number of pages is the same as your PDF.




#### Step 3: Convert as PDF

In the top-left corner of your Adobe InDesign interface, click on "File" then "Place", a dialog window pops up then choose "Show Import Options", and select the PDF you want to import.




#### Step 4: Click OK

Finally, click "OK" to try the converted file.



#### Step 5: Use Online Converter

The second way to convert PDF to Adobe InDesign is to use online conversion tools. There are various ways to use these tools, but the common way includes installing the PDF to the online software, selecting Adobe InDesign or .INDD, waiting for the conversion process, and downloading the converted file.
