
How to Create a Hyperlink in Adobe InDesign

Find out how to create a hyperlink in Adobe InDesign. That way you can create works that have helpful links to online resources when you need to.




How to Create a Hyperlink in Adobe InDesign

To get started, launch Adobe InDesign and then type the words for your hyperlink. Then follow these three steps.


Step 1: Highlight Anchor Text and click on 'Window'

Highlight the anchor text where you want to put your hyperlink. After that move your cursor to the menu bar and click 'Window'.



Step 2: Click 'Interactive' and 'Hyperlinks'

A dropdown will appear and from there click on 'Interactive' and 'Hyperlinks'. A panel where appear where you can add the link to a site, email, etc.






To add more hyperlinks, just click on the New button at the bottom of the panel.



Step 3: Specify the Link and Character Style

Lastly, you can adjust the specifics of your hyperlink by choosing where it links to in the dialog box. Finalize what style your hyperlink should look like and then click the OK button and you are all set!
