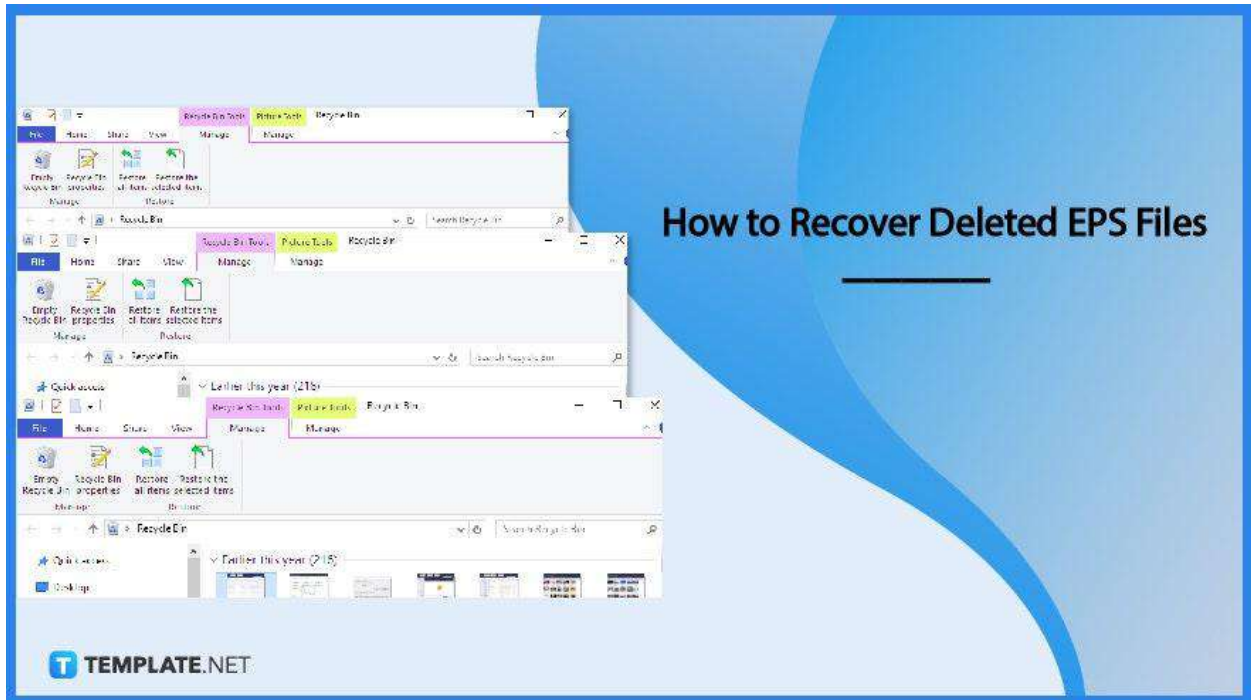


How to Recover Deleted EPS Files

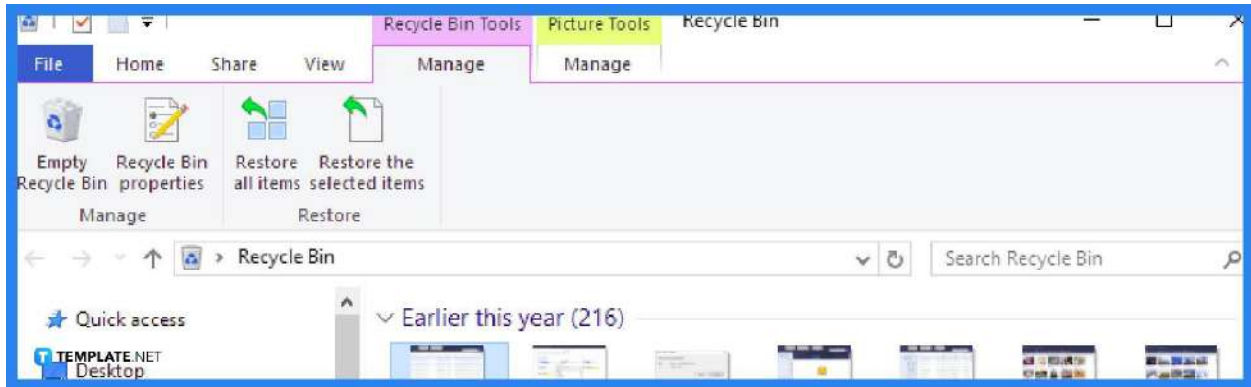
Learn how to Recover Deleted EPS Files. so you can avoid the trouble of having to make those EPS files all over again.



How to Recover Deleted EPS Files

Recovering deleted EPS files takes only a few minutes. Here's how you can recover them specifically in the latest Operating Systems personal computers.

- **Step 1: Open the Recycle Bin**
The Recycle Bin is present in almost all computer systems. It usually appears like a Trash Bin icon, but a simple search on your device can also show you where it is.
- **Step 2: Select EPS files**



Find the EPS files present within the Recycle Bin. You can click on one or more by holding the Shift button.

- **Step 3: Restore file(s)**



Just in case they get deleted again somehow, it's a great idea to save backups of those EPS files.

Once you have chosen the file(s), right-click with your mouse and click on the “Restore” option shown in the dropdown. and that is how you recover deleted EPS files.

FAQs

Can I recover more than one EPS file from the Recycle Bin?

Yes, you can recover as many deleted EPS files as you wish from the Recycle Bin.

How can I prevent further losses of the EPS files?

To prevent further losses, it is recommended that you keep backups of the EPS files be it online or on another device even, for a quick recovery.

Some examples of programs you can use for EPS files include Adobe Illustrator, Adobe Acrobat, and Adobe Photoshop.
