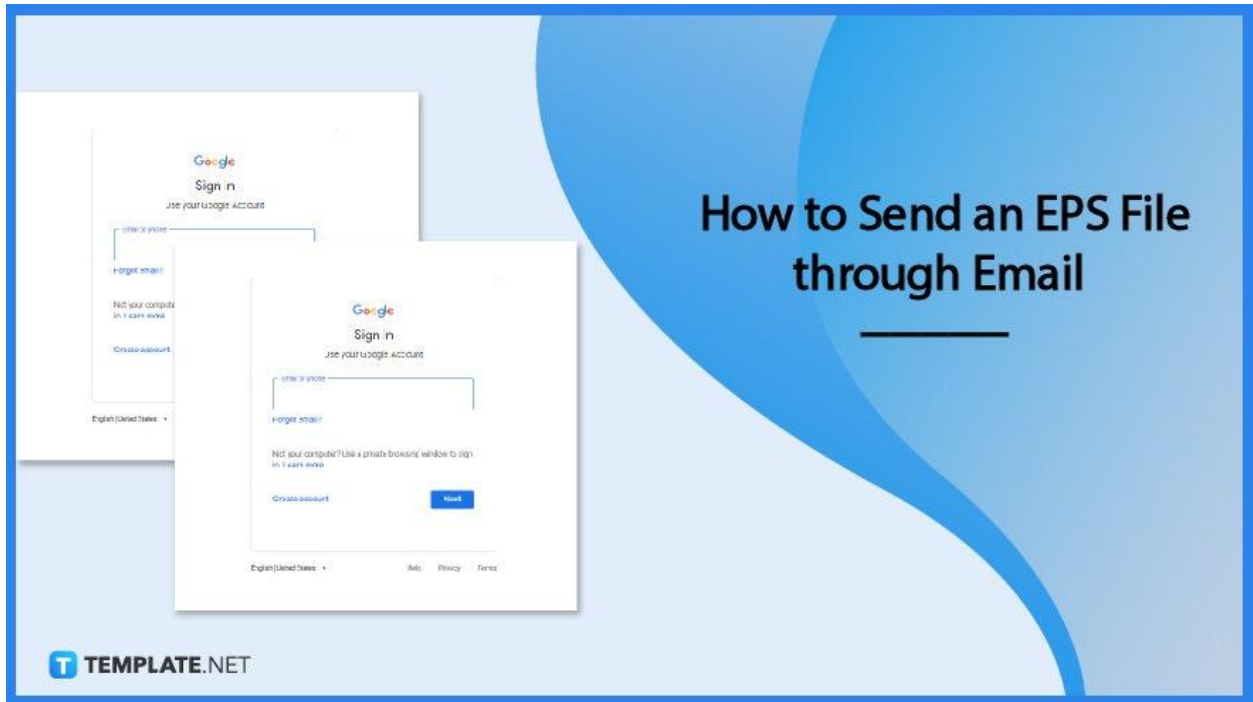


How to Send an EPS File Through Email

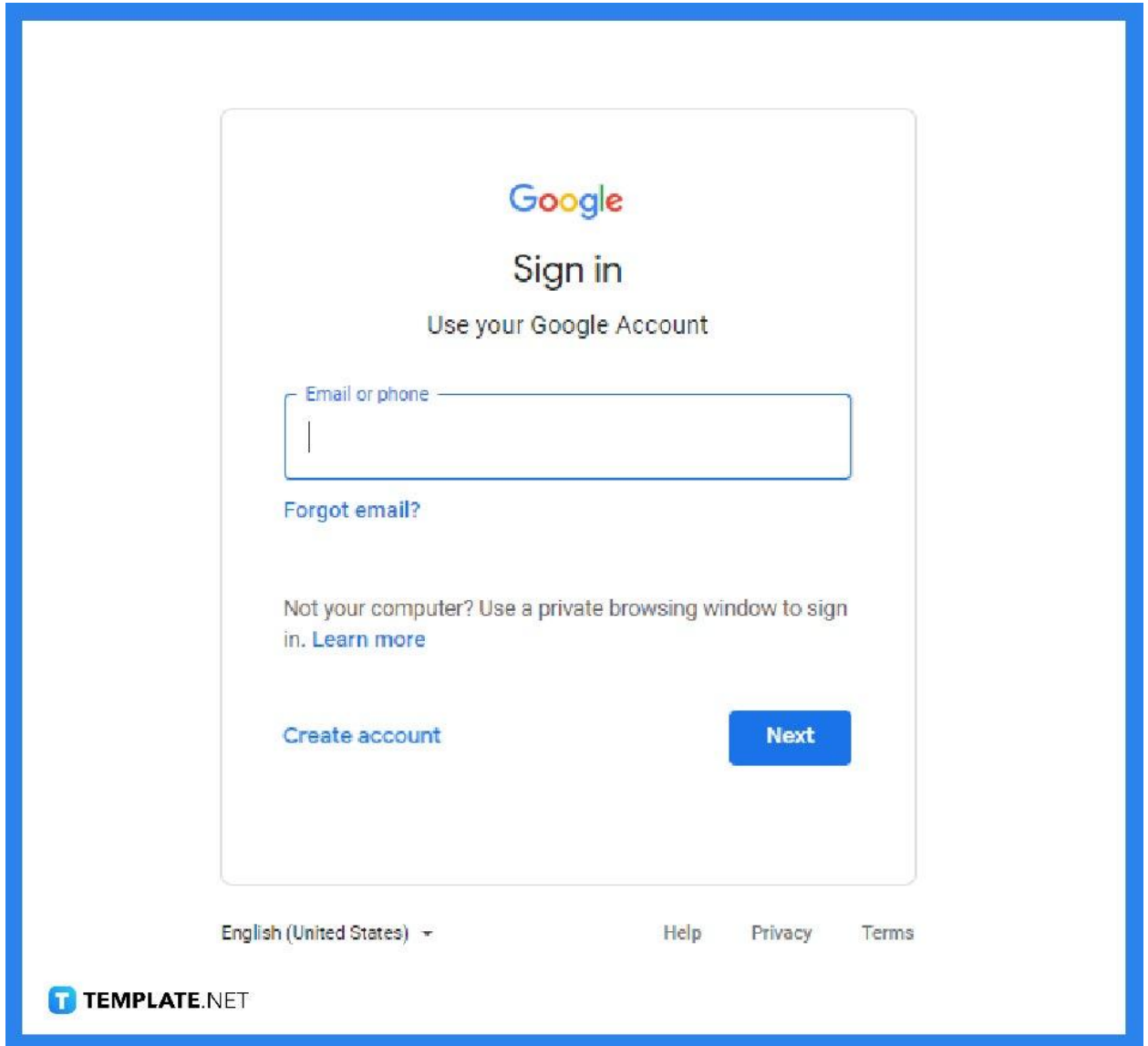


How to Send an EPS File Through Email

EPS is among the heavy file formats out there. However, you can still send it through email by following these steps.

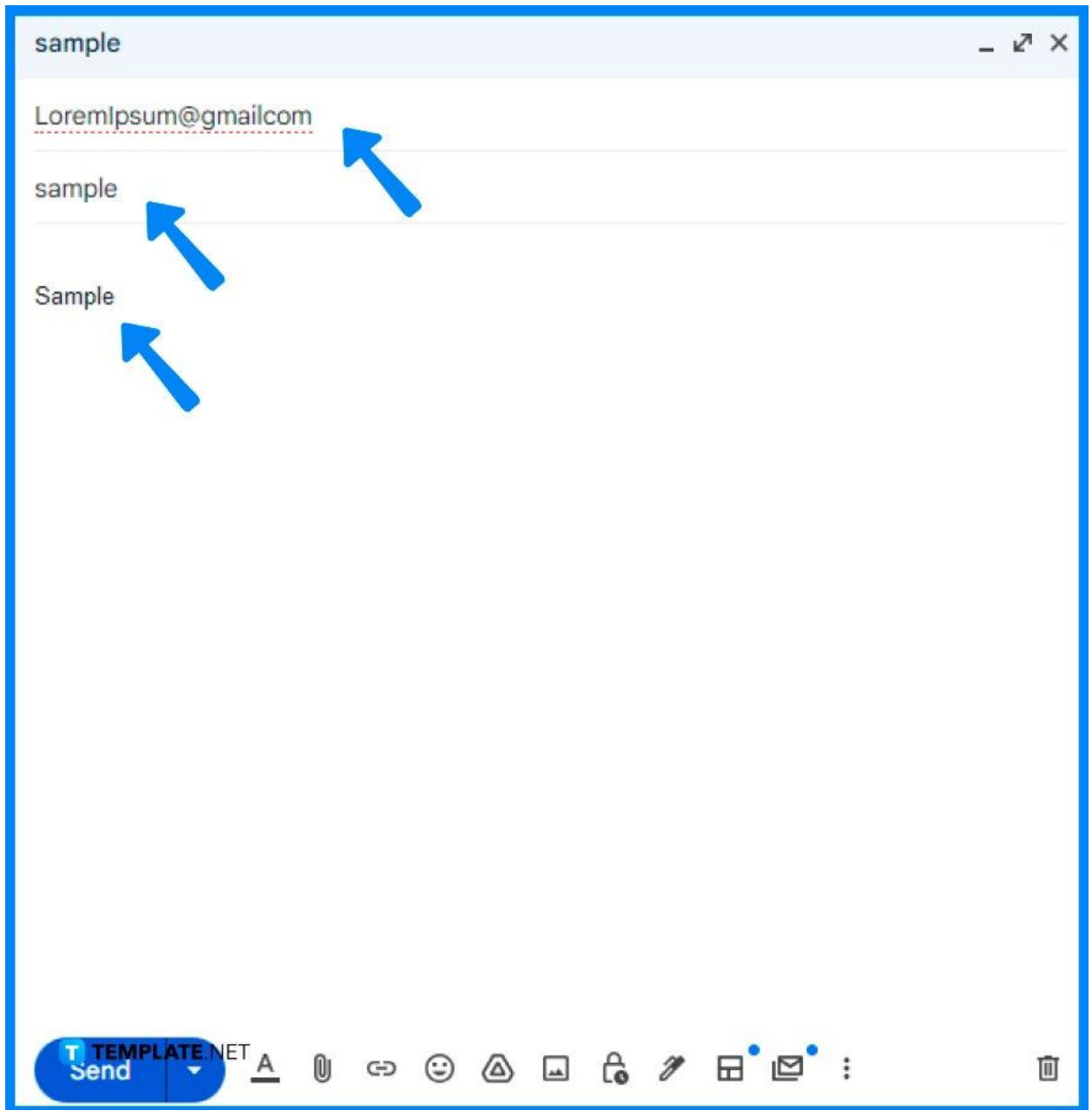
- **Step 1: Open your Email**

To start, open the email software of your choice. Most email platforms carry the EPS file format; however, others have the tendency to destroy or corrupt the file during the cleaning or sending process.



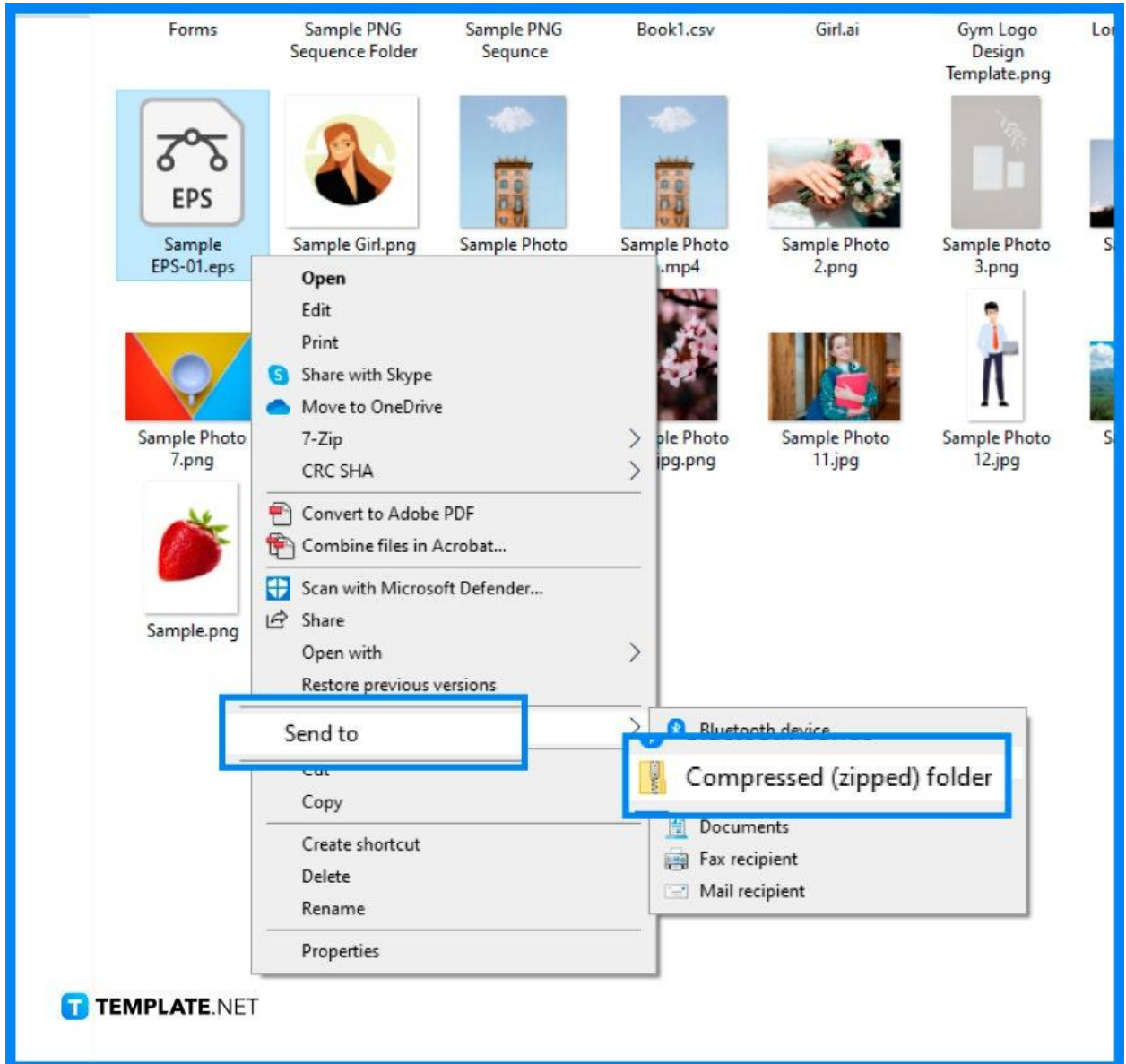
- **Step 2: Type in Email Details**

Supply the recipient of the email, subject, and body of the email. These details help the recipient understand the email, and how to act upon receiving the mail.



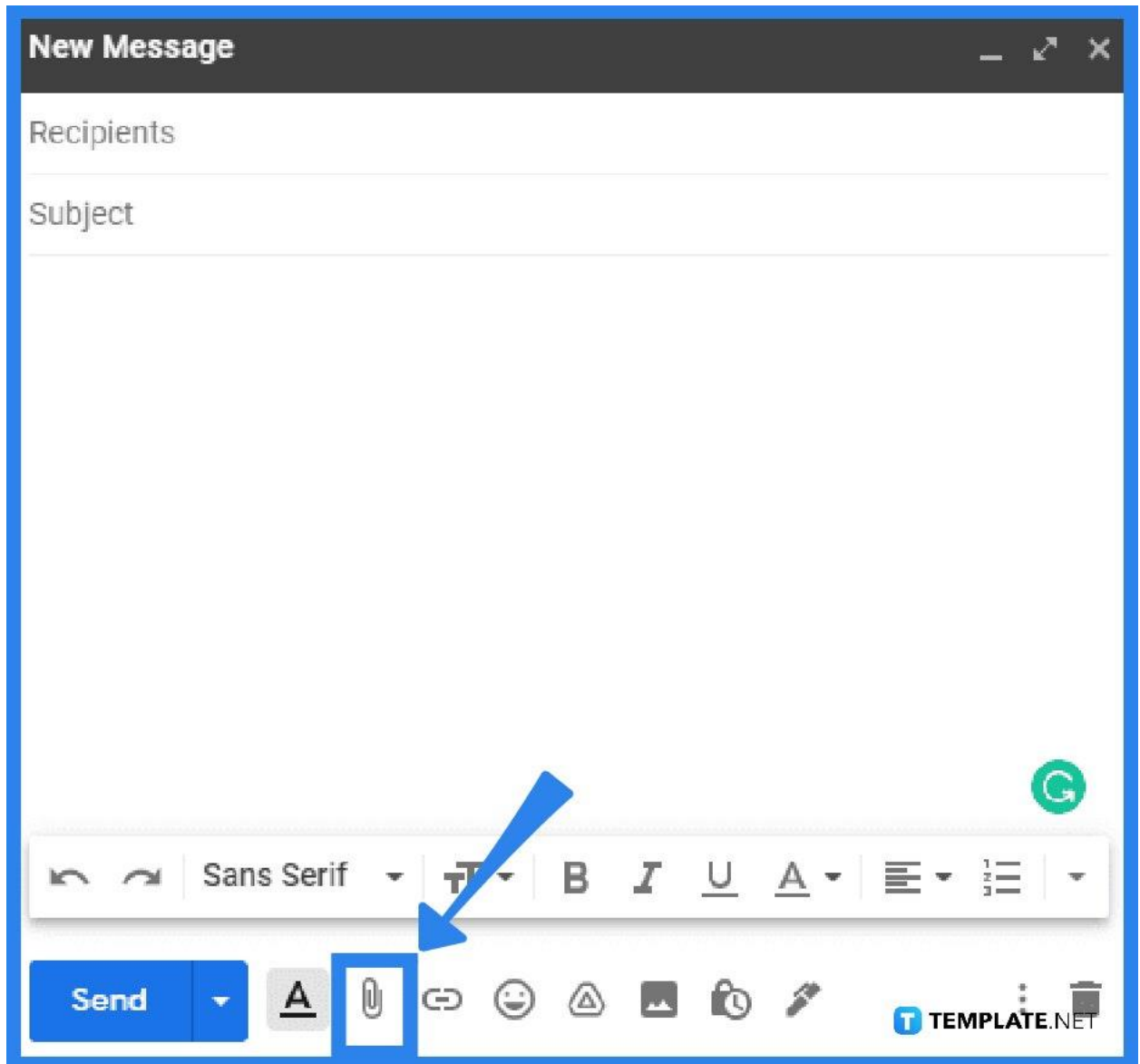
- **Step 3: Choose File Format**

Saving the file in EPS is the common way to handle large-scale images, but the best way is to compress the file by saving it as a zip file or PDF file. Doing so will prevent the file from corrupting or any form of unsuccessful sending.



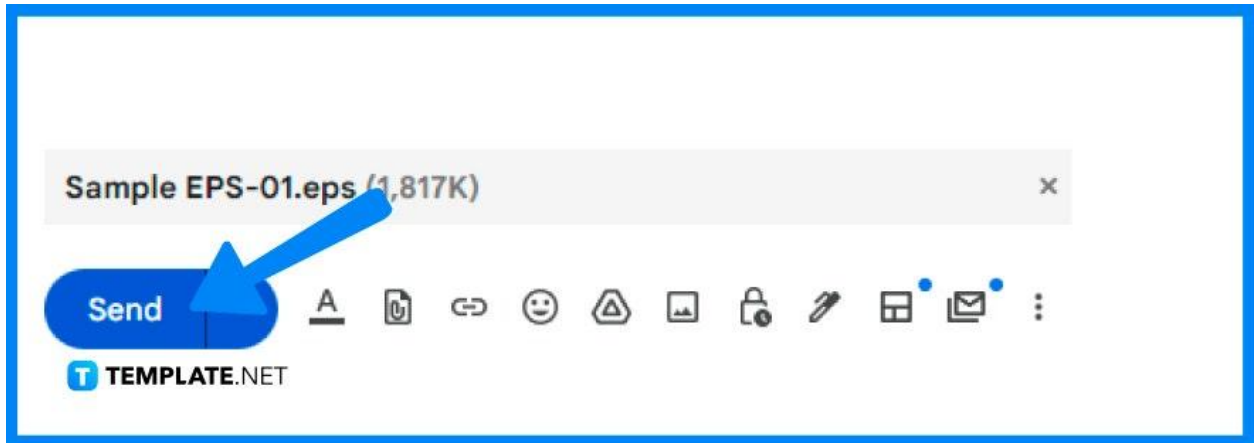
- **Step 4: Attach File**

Click the paper clip symbol or attachment symbol on your screen, and attach the .eps file or the compressed zip file.



- **Step 5: Send**

After completing the steps above, hit Send. The sending might take a little while because of the heavy attached files but will surely send.
