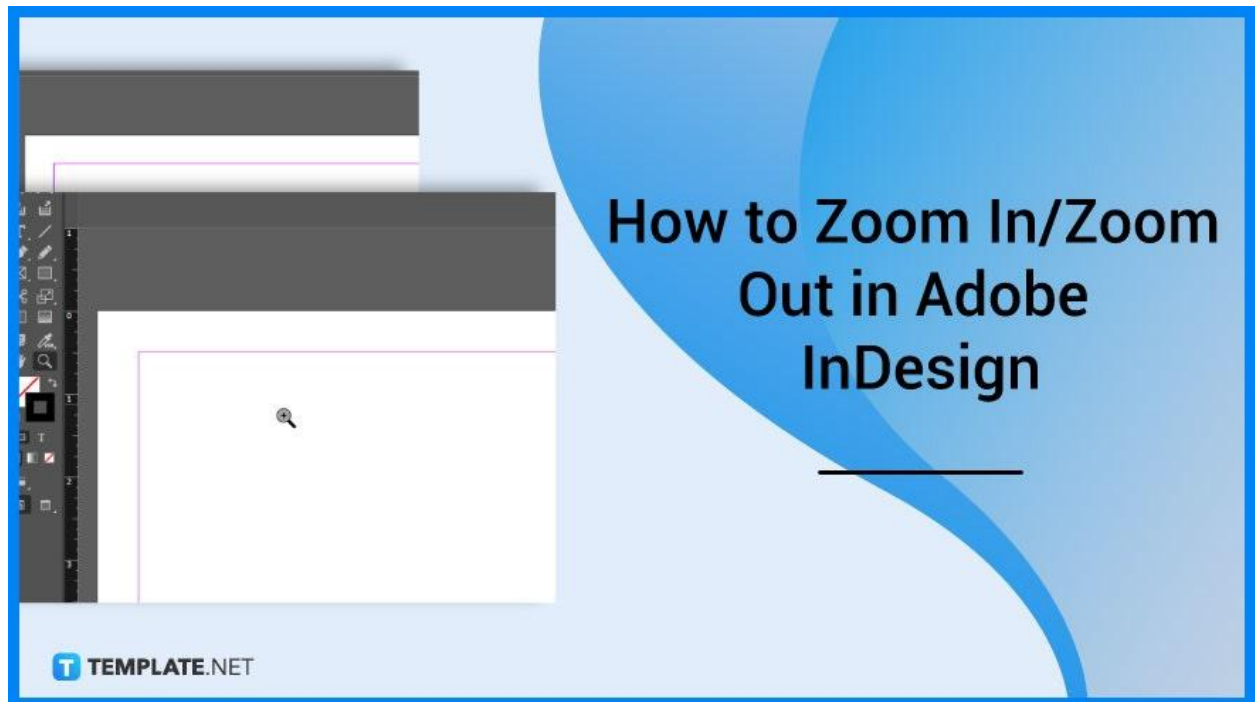


# How to Zoom In/Zoom Out in Adobe InDesign

Discover how to zoom in/zoom out in Adobe InDesign. That way you'll know what to do when you want to focus on a particular spot or look at the whole picture.

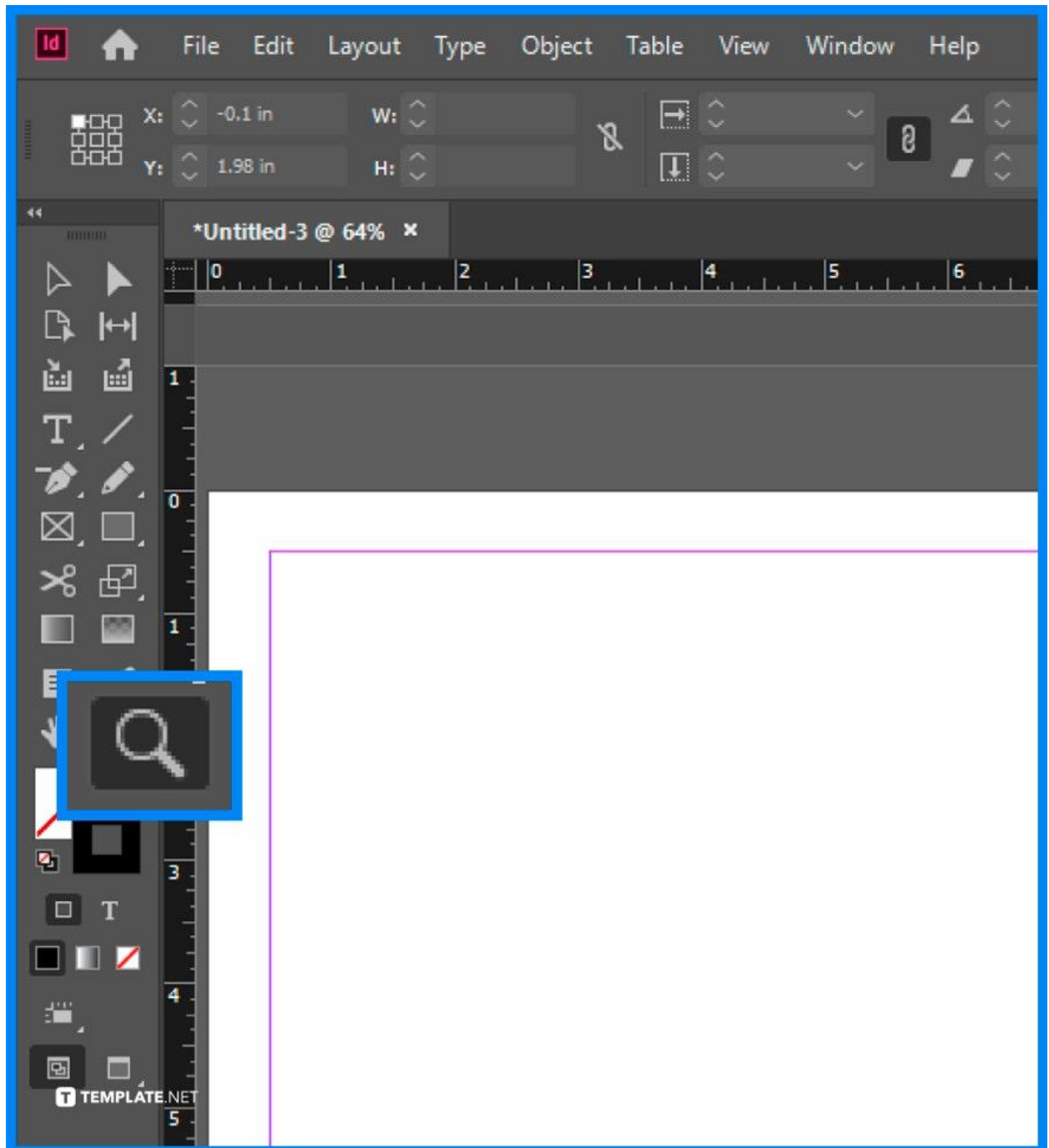


## How to Zoom In/Zoom Out in Adobe InDesign

To get started, open your Adobe InDesign file. Then follow these three steps.

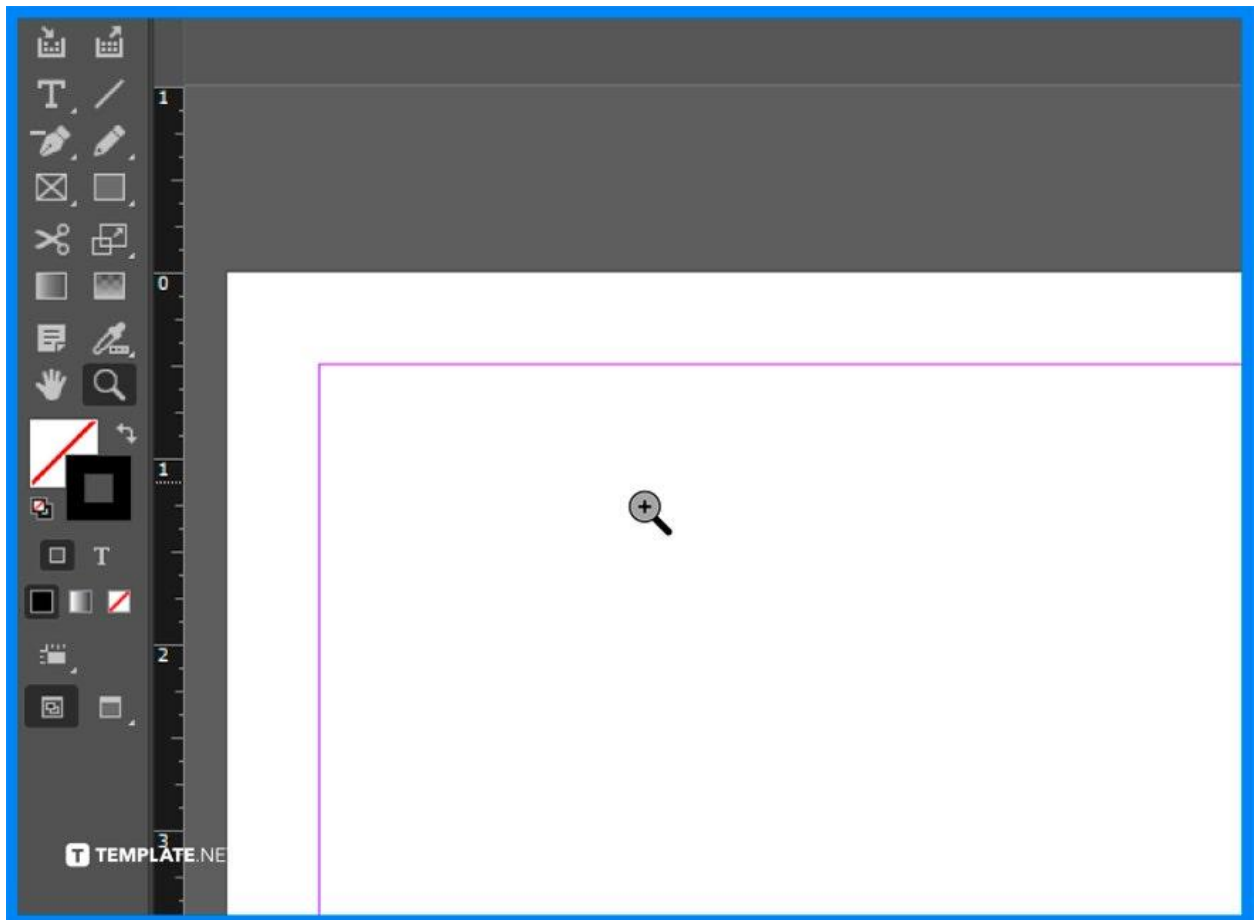
- **Step 1: Select the Zoom Tool**

Move your cursor to the toolbar and select the Zoom Tool. It appears like a magnifying glass icon.



- **Step 2: Zoom In**

When clicking the Zoom Tool, your cursor appears like a magnifying glass with a plus sign. This is because you can zoom in as a default.



To Zoom In on a specific spot, just simply click on that specific spot on the screen where you want to zoom in.

- **Step 3: Zoom Out**

To zoom out, you can switch it by clicking on the ALT button. The cursor will look like a magnifying glass with a minus sign. And that is how you zoom in and out in Adobe InDesign.

## **FAQs**

### **How do I zoom in on a specific part of an image?**

When in the zoom-in mode, just click at the spot where you want to zoom in on an image.

### **What is the difference between zooming in and panning?**

Zooming in is magnifying a specific spot in an image and panning is moving a part of an image to the center of the screen.

### **How far can I zoom out of an image?**

You can zoom out as far as how you have set your image to be displayed in Adobe InDesign.
