Letter Size


A Letter paper or page size is commonly used for home, academic, or business documents. It has a size measurement of 8.5 × 11 inches or 215.9 × 279.4 mm. Because of its length and width, it can accommodate different types of rosters especially if you need to incorporate tables and calendars into the document.

A4 Size

A little smaller in size is an A4 paper/page size that is also used to create all sorts of documents. Its size dimensions are 8.3 × 11.7 inches or 210 × 297 mm. This type of paper size is commonly used in European and Asian countries.


Roster Sizes for Print

Printing hard copies is still widely practiced by organizations especially if there is a need to physically distribute these documents to relevant parties as a formal way of communication. So, if there is a need to print out a roster for your team then you have the option to choose between a Letter $(8.5 \times 11 \text{ inches})$ or A4 $(8.3 \times 11.7 \text{ inches})$ paper size. However, if you want to make all those adjustments with the margins then as an alternative you can customize the margins or choose other types of paper.




Roster Sizes for MS Word

MS Word is a commercial word processor that has been commonly used since it was first released. This is because its features are easy to use and are adaptable for all sorts of reports and documents. MS Word default paper is in Letter format (8.5×11 inches) yet you can always customize the paper size and its orientation by clicking on the page set up and from there choose your designated paper size.




Roster Sizes for Apple Pages

Since Apple products are quite popular and have a large number of users, it has its very own word processor called Apple Pages which can be used to create and edit documents. Its default paper size is set to Letter (8.5 × 11 inches) but if need to change it then you have the option to do so. What you need to do is simply go to page setup, click on the paper size pop-up menu, and then manage custom sizes to choose your preferred paper size.




Roster Sizes for Google Docs

Although google docs may have more or less similar features to Word and Pages, one thing great about this application is that users can access their work anytime and anywhere. Not only that you can save your work online as well. So if you need to create a roster using Google Docs, you can use a Letter (8.5 × 11 inches) or A4 (8.3 × 11.7 inches) size which is quite compatible for this type of document. Or again, to choose a different kind of paper size go to page setup and from there select your preferred paper size, orientation, and page color.



Roster Sizes for Excel

Using a Microsoft Excel application also works best for rosters because of its spreadsheet format. Rosters are usually organized using tables complete with columns and rows to fill in the names and other details. That being said, Excel's default paper size is in Letter format $(8.5 \times 11 \text{ inches})$ and in portrait orientation which prints up and down on the long side of the page.
