
# **Affidavit of Identity Sizes**

An affidavit of identity size may have less gravity than its content but the document's size still needs to be considered, especially for formal physical copies. For digital copies, the paper size should be taken into consideration as well since it is a contributing factor to the overall appearance of the affidavit.



## **Affidavit of Identity Standard**

Unlike a non-formal document or form, which has a variety of sizes to choose from, a legal and formal document or form such as an affidavit has fewer options. The following are standard sizes used for creating or printing an affidavit of identity:

#### Letter

A US letter-sized document measures 8.5 inches wide and 11 inches long (215.9 × 279.4 mm) and is the most common paper size used for formal documents in the US and the rest of the world, especially if the content requires a short blank page. The affidavit of identity, sometimes confused with statutory declaration due to content similarity, is an example of a legal document printed in this paper size. Although, Letter is used for non-formal documents like a casual report or a request form.

### Legal


A longer paper size, Legal ( $8.5 \times 14$  inches), is used for documents that typically have a larger amount of word counts like regulations, bylaws, or narrative reports. Despite the shorter content compared to the previous documents, affidavits of identity may be created using this paper size. After all, an affidavit of identification includes statements supporting identity claims that can be lengthy, especially when paired with relevant pieces of evidence.

#### **A4**

Another option from the standard paper sizes for affidavits of identity is A4 (210 × 297 mm) which is narrower than the previous two. Northern American systems' standardization of this paper size has mathematical inclinations that make reducing and enlarging a document for printing easier. And because the aforementioned system is followed by the rest o the world, A4 has gained more popularity that made it has been considered for formal writings or printings.


# **Affidavit of Identity Sizes for Print**

Because an affidavit of identity is a legal document, there are only a few options to choose from for printing. These options vary between Letter, Legal, and A4.




# **Affidavit of Identity Sizes for Microsoft Word**


# **Affidavit of Identity Sizes for Apple Pages**

Proof of an affidavit may refer to a written statement signed by the witnesses and notarized by a notary public.

## How long the affidavit of support is valid?

The affidavit of support, no matter the purpose, is only valid until the person, whom the affidavit cites to be under the responsibility of the affiant, no longer fits the described statement in the document.

#### Can an affidavit be handwritten?

Apparently, affidavits can be handwritten or typed.

## How to resize the size of an affidavit of identity?

In terms of paper size, the legal document can be resized by selecting the whole document on your device and going to Page settings to change the paper size to your liking.

## What is the formal affidavit style?

According to LegalTemplates' Gold Tetsola, the formal style of an affidavit includes a title and caption, introduction to the affiant, sworn confirmation that presented facts are true, relevant pieces of evidence, and a notarized signature.

## How is household size calculated for affidavit of support?

The official website of the US Bureau of Consular Affairs states that to calculate the household size for an affidavit of support, these must be considered: spouse, any child (by birth, marriage, adoption), anyone dependent on the sponsor's tax return, principal visa applicant, applicants planning to immigrate within six months, other people in the US whom the sponsor is supporting, and non-dependent siblings, parent, or adult children residing in the sponsor's household.
