


# Arbor Day

Arbor Day is a secular holiday on which groups and individuals are urged to participate in tree planting. Such a celebration is now observed in numerous nations.



## Arbor Day Definition and Meaning

Arbor Day is a day set aside each year for the public planting of trees in the USA, Australia, and other countries.

Arbor Day encourages people to plant trees in the forest, on their farm, or in their own yard or garden to take care of them and our Mother Earth.

## When Is Arbor Day?

Arbor Day is always celebrated on the last Friday in April. It is also observed in many other states, but national Arbor Day dates differ based on the climate and the appropriate planting season, which is spring.

## **Arbor Day History**

The history of Arbor Day was started by Julius Sterling Morton, a Nebraska editor who was Secretary of Agriculture under President Grover Cleveland. In addition, on January 4, 1872, Morton made the initial "Arbor Day" proposal during a State Board of Agriculture meeting. The 10th of April 1872 was chosen as the celebration date, and the counties and people who successfully planted the most trees on that particular day were given prizes. The official proclamation of Arbor Day was issued in 1874 by Nebraska's Governor, Robert W. Furnas, and the day was observed on April 10 that year.

# What's In Arbor Day?



Arbor Day is a significant day around the world when trees are planted with the intention of conservation and forestation.


## Facebook

1. Choose a [Free Arbor Day Facebook Post](#) template.





2. Add relevant and transparent clipart designs.




Add various clipart graphics and symbols to the design or illustration to make it stand out from the crowd. On the editor screen's left toolbar, click the Graphics icon to open the Graphics tool. To add the logo or clipart to the graphic, choose it.

3. Edit the template's background color.




You can edit the template's background color if you want. Just go to the Background tab and select "See all" under the Color option. Select the desired color from the presets that are shown.


#### 5. Save your Arbor Day Facebook post.


## Instagram

1. Pick a [Free Arbor Day Instagram Post](#) template.






3. Include an animated clipart or drawing.



You can also include graphics with a nature-friendly theme design, such as a sun, seedlings, or a recycle sign, and other images in the template. Select the Graphics button to


browse the many available designs and clipart. To add the illustration to the template, click on it and drag it over the desired area.


5. Save your Arbor Day Instagram post.


1. Select an [Arbor Day Youtube Video Thumbnail](#) post template.



For events and celebrations surrounding Arbor Day, pick from a variety of our Youtube post


templates. You can access our editor tool by selecting the template you want to modify and then clicking the “Edit This Template FREE” button. The template is editable as you please.

## 2. Incorporate a unique Arbor Day greeting.






4. Alter the background color of the post template.

## Arbor Day Facts

Follow this list of further information and facts about Arbor Day to learn more about this secular holiday.

- The word “arbor” in Latin means “tree”.
- On January 7, 1872, Julius Sterling Morton suggested to the board that Nebraskans take a day to plant trees in their neighborhood.
- The first Arbor Day was celebrated on April 10, 1874, with approximately 1 million trees planted.
- In a span of ten years, planting trees on Arbor Day became customary and schools from all throughout the USA started taking part.
- Arbor Day officially became a state holiday in Nebraska in 1885.
- America’s favorite tree was chosen in a 2004 National Arbor Day Foundation poll, and the mighty oak came out on top with 101,000 votes, making this tree currently the national tree of America.
- Along with tree planting, Arbor Day encourages rainforest preservation, recycling initiatives, and public awareness of the value of trees.

## **Arbor Day Ideas**


Many individuals and groups take the initiative to attend a planting event and project for various reasons, and the list of extra Arbor Day celebration activities that people can take part in is provided below.




