National Coming Out Day Definition & Meaning

National Coming Out Day is an annual event celebrated by the LGBT community to support those who'll finally reveal their identity and sexuality as gays, lesbians, bisexuals, and transgenders.

National Coming Out Day is a day to support those who'll be "coming out of the closet" and marks the anniversary of the 1987 Washington National March for Lesbian and Gay Rights.

When Is National Coming Out Day?

National Coming Out Day is celebrated every year on October 11. In 2022, this annual celebration falls on a Tuesday.

National Coming Out Day History

National Coming Out Day was first celebrated in 1988—the year it was inaugurated by Jean O'Leary and Robert Eichberg who are LGBT rights activists. It has always been celebrated to support and uplift the spirits of gays, lesbians, and bisexuals who'll reveal their true selves. It's also inspired by the Lesbian and Gay Rights March on Washington on October 11, 1987, and marks the anniversary of that said event. Every year since then, National Coming Out Day has been observed with a unique theme such as "Coming Out Still Matters" in 2013 and 2014.

National Coming Out Day Purpose, Importance

For good and meaningful reasons, National Coming Out Day is a festive occasion in the global LGBT community.

Support Those Coming Out

Coming out is not easy for those still hiding their real sexualities. But on National Coming Out Day, they can be confident to do so thanks to the full support of the LGBT community and other people who stand with LGBTs. As its name suggests, National

Coming Out Day encourages those still in hiding to "come out of the closet" and be free. It assures them that the public will accept them for who and what they are.

Welcome New Members of the LGBT Community

When an individual comes out, they're revealing themselves as part of the LGBT community. So on National Coming Out Day, they're welcomed with open arms. They're now free to engage with their romantic preferences, free to dress up however they like, and free to be themselves without having to hide anything. They can now participate in LGBT parades, events, and other gatherings.

Celebrate the Anniversary of the Washington National March

The National March for Lesbian and Gay Rights in 1987 was monumental in fighting for equality, diversity, and representation for the LGBTQ society. That march advocated equal human rights for gays and lesbians since they're rightful citizens. To this day, the effects of that campaign are felt and it empowered those in hiding to come out of the closet and raise the LGBTQ flag with pride. That's why the anniversary of the 1987 March is celebrated on National Coming Out Day.

What's on National Coming Out Day?

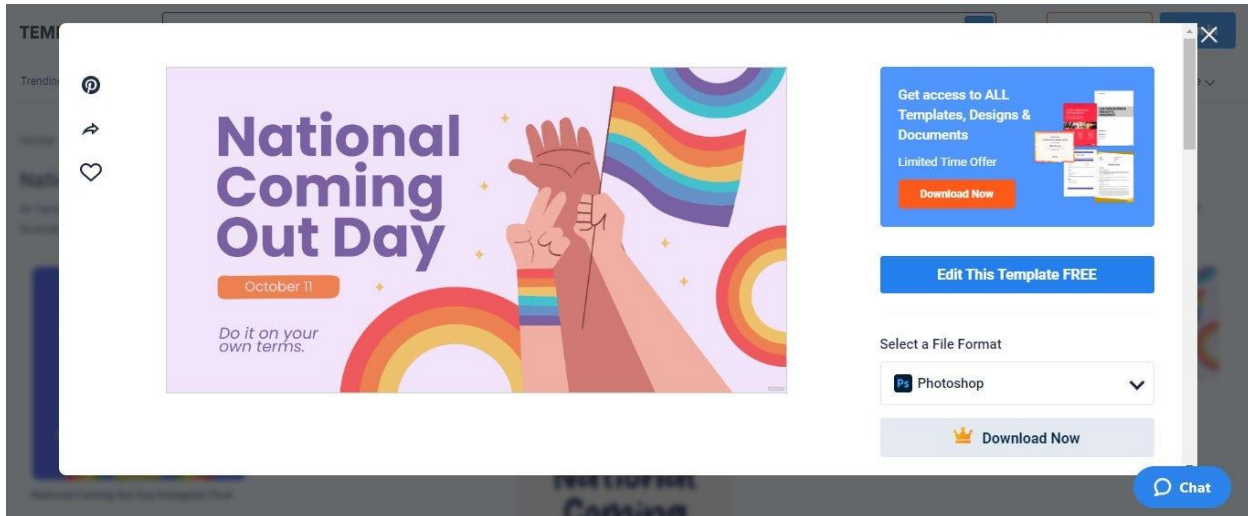

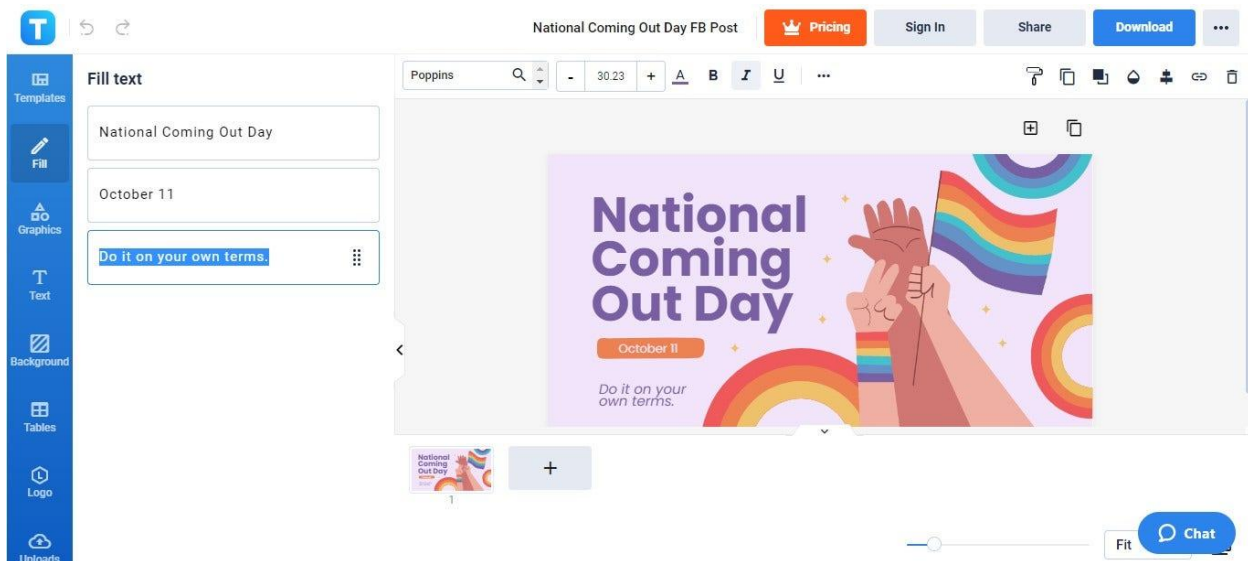

1. Use the [National Coming Out Day FB Post](#) Template.



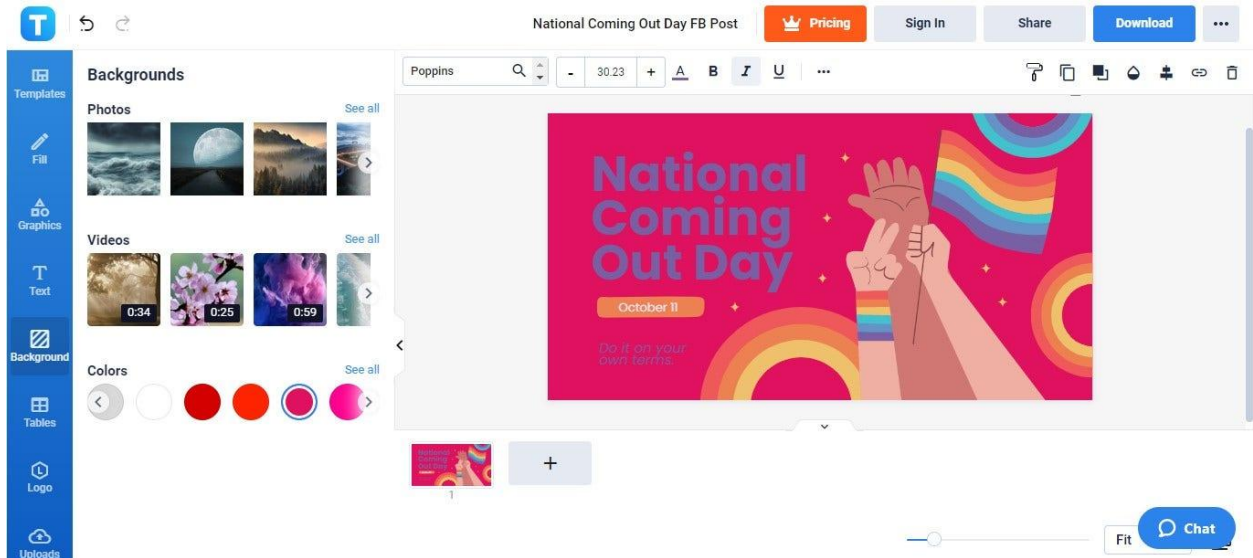

2. Type in your National Coming Out Day message.



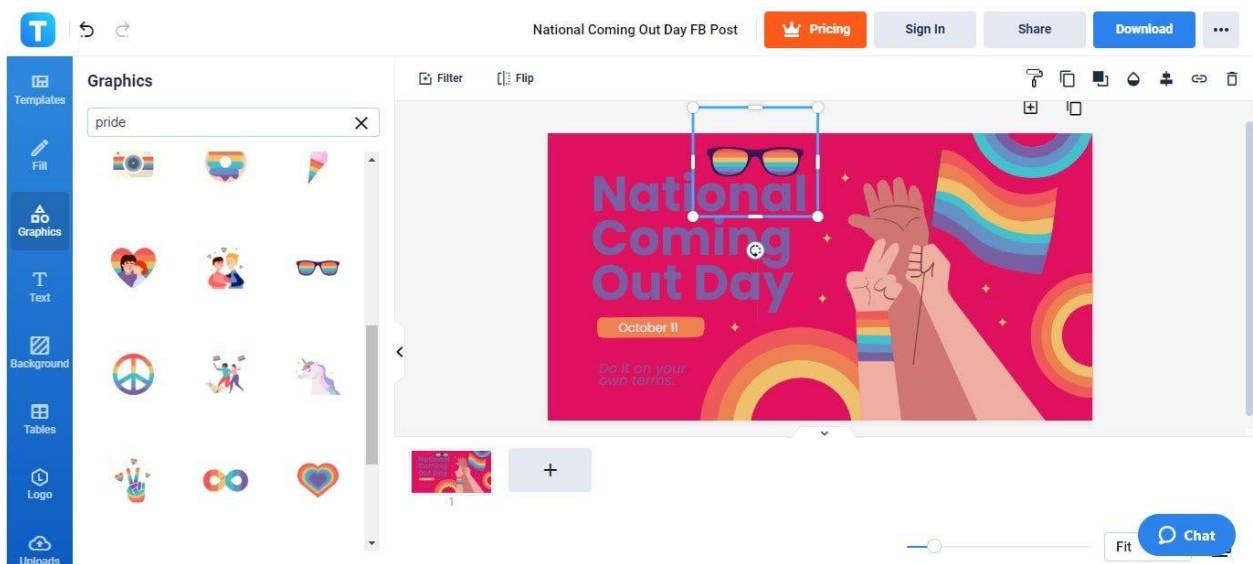
Once you have the template opened in the Editor tool, you can start by writing your unique National Coming Out Day message. Head to the Fill tab of the Editor tool and write the message on the third Fill Text box. Make it short; around less than 10 words would suffice. You can also use the existing content of the third Fill Text box if you want.

3. Enhance the background.



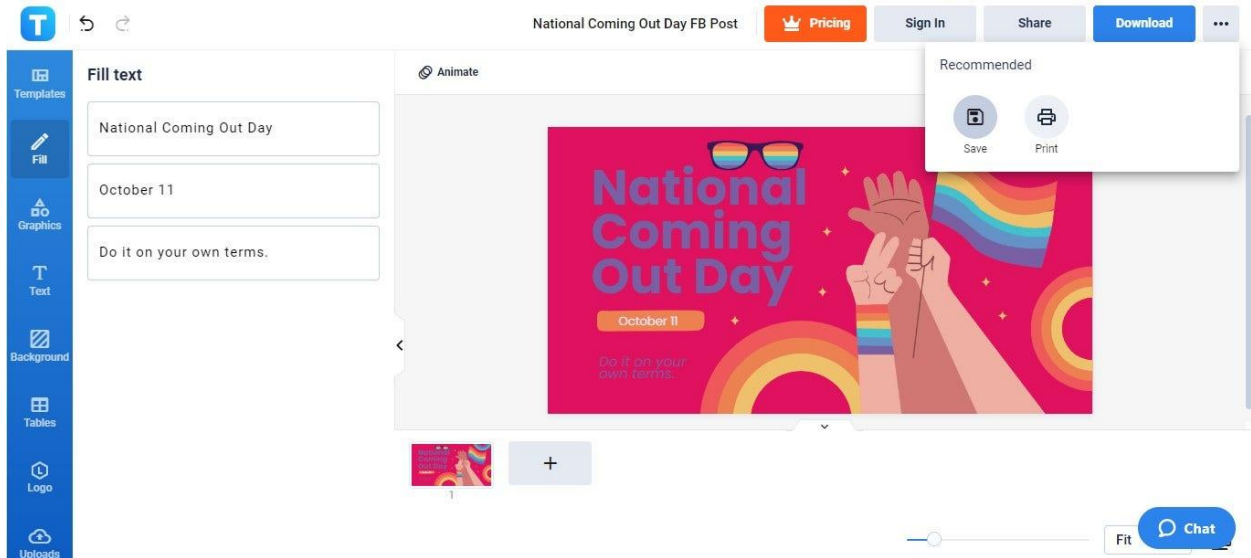
Make some enhancements to the background of the post template. By heading to the Background tab, you can apply a background photo or change the background color. The Colors section lets you choose any background color you want for your FB post.

4. Insert LGBTQ pride clip art.



Clip art showcasing LGBTQ pride is available in the Editor tool. You can add as many as you like as long as they complement the design of the post well. Go over to the Graphics tab and type "Pride" in the search box. Drag and drop your selected LGBTQ clip art into the FB post template.

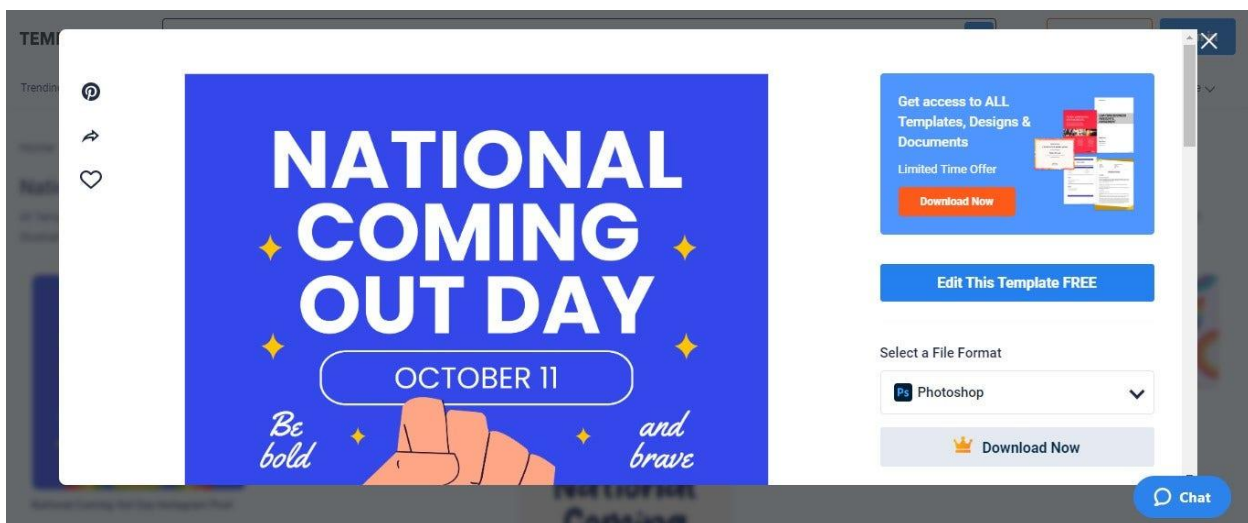
5. Save your National Coming Out Day FB post draft.



When you're finished, click the Save button to save your National Coming Out Day FB post draft. Wait until October 11 to upload it to your Facebook account and share it with your friends.

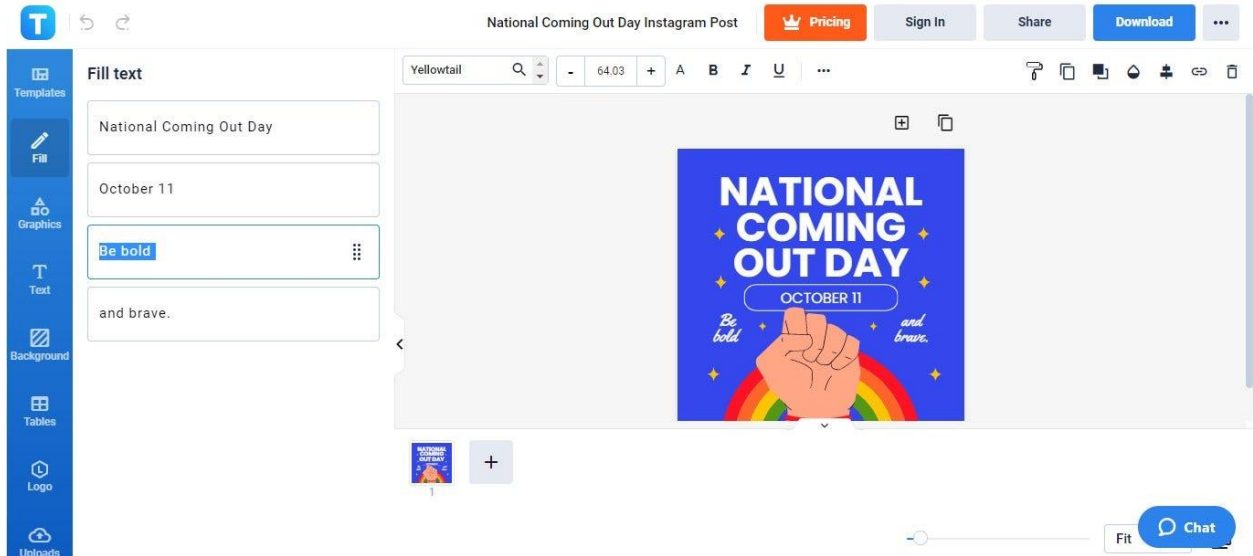
Instagram

1. Use the [National Coming Out Day Instagram Post Template](#).



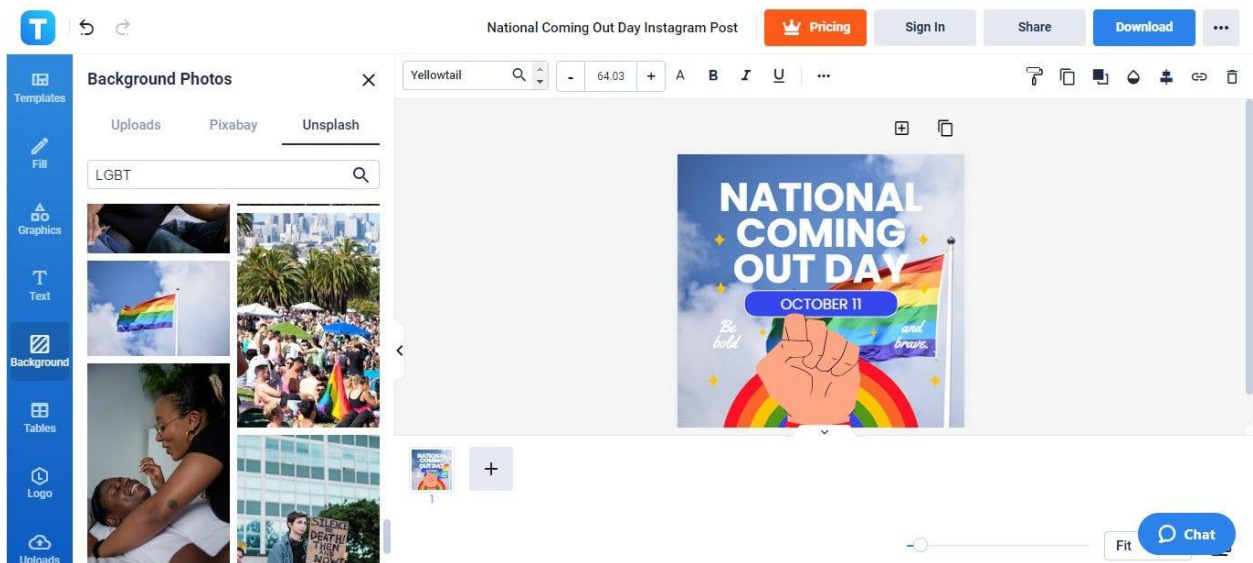

2. Write your words of inspiration.



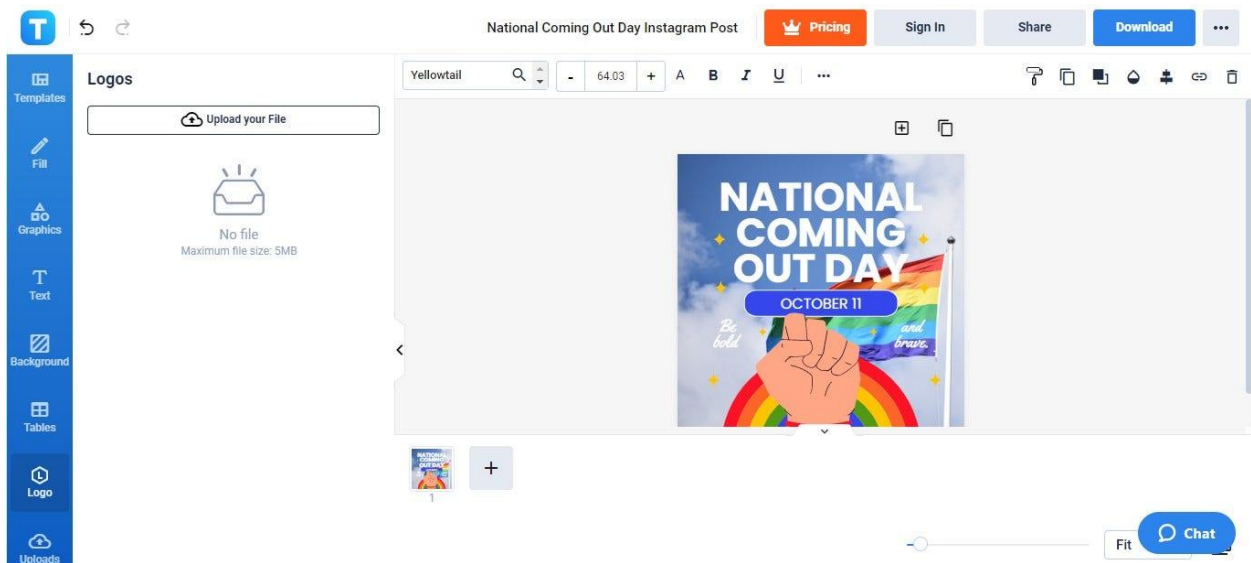
Write your inspiring Coming Out Day words in the third and fourth Fill Text boxes. To find the Fill Text boxes, simply open the Fill tab of the Editor tool. After writing your sweet words, you may change their font style. You may choose a font style on the toolbar above.

3. Use an LGBT photo as the background.



LGBT photos would be a fitting background for your Instagram post. So if you wish to use such photos, go to the Background tab, click "See All" under Photos, and simply type "LGBT" in the Unsplash search box. You'll find loads of LGBT pictures that you can use as background. Click your chosen photo and it'll immediately become the background of your Instagram post.

4. Upload and attach your company or organizational logo.



If you own or work for a company or organization that supports LGBT people, consider including its logo in the Instagram post. Let the people know that your institution is an ally of the LGBTQ community. Go over to the Logo tab of the Editor tool and select the "Upload Your File" button. Upload an image file of your official logo then drag and drop it into the Instagram post template.

5. Save your National Coming Out Day Instagram post draft.



Lastly, don't forget to save your National Coming Out Day Instagram post draft. Select the button in the upper right corner of the Editor page and select the Save button which

displays a floppy disk icon. You can upload it to Instagram on October 11. You may also upload it as your Instagram story.

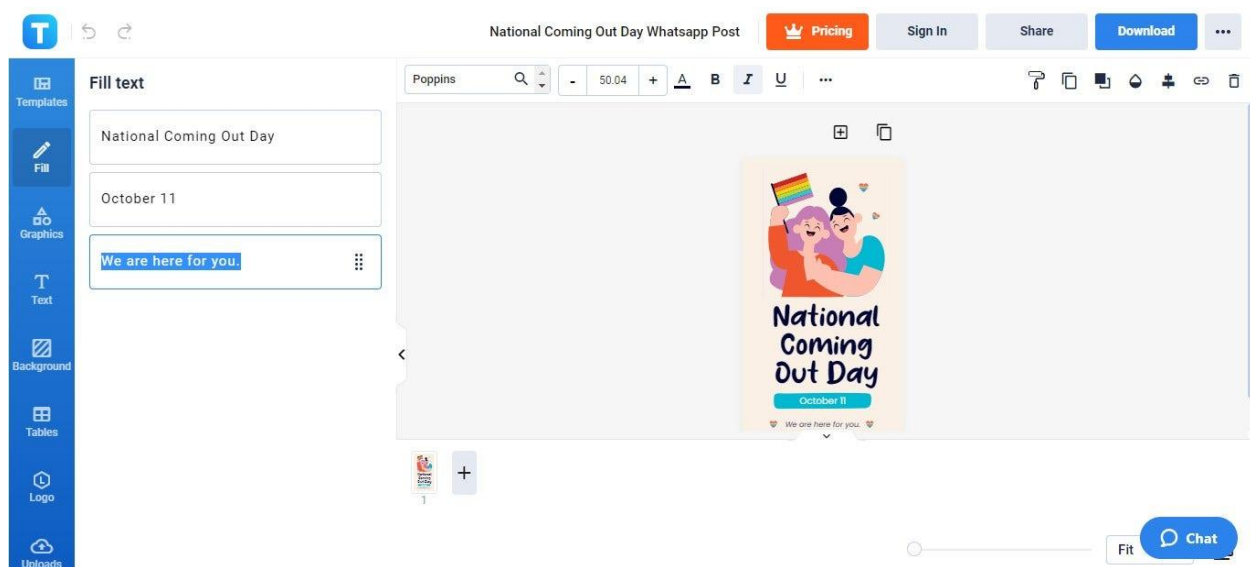
Whatsapp

1. Use the [National Coming Out Day Whatsapp Post](#) Template.



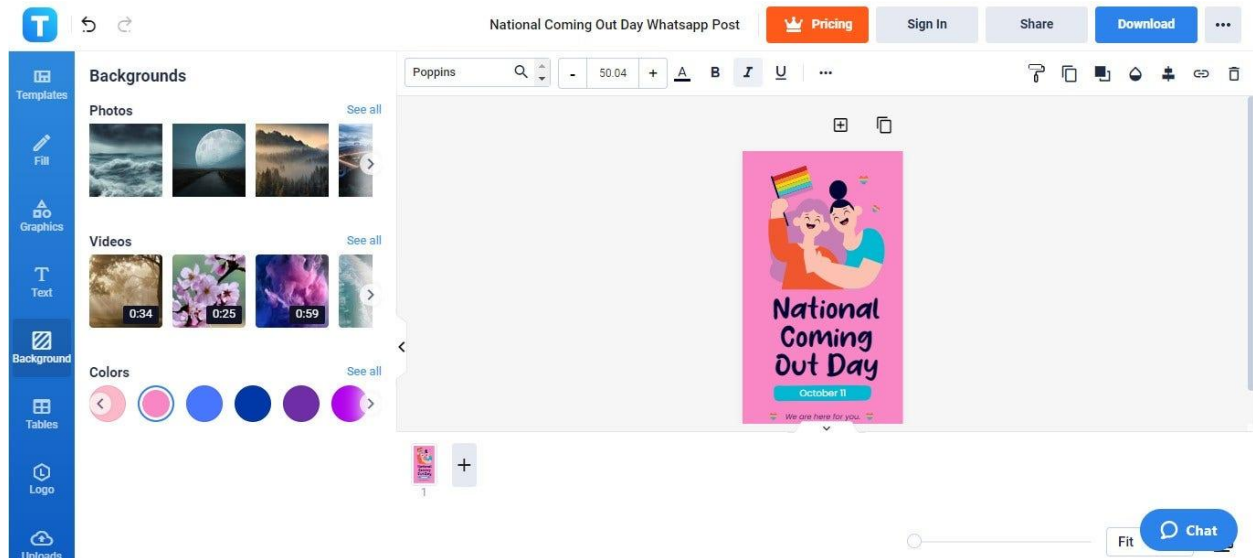

2. Write your custom Coming Out Day message in the Fill Text box.



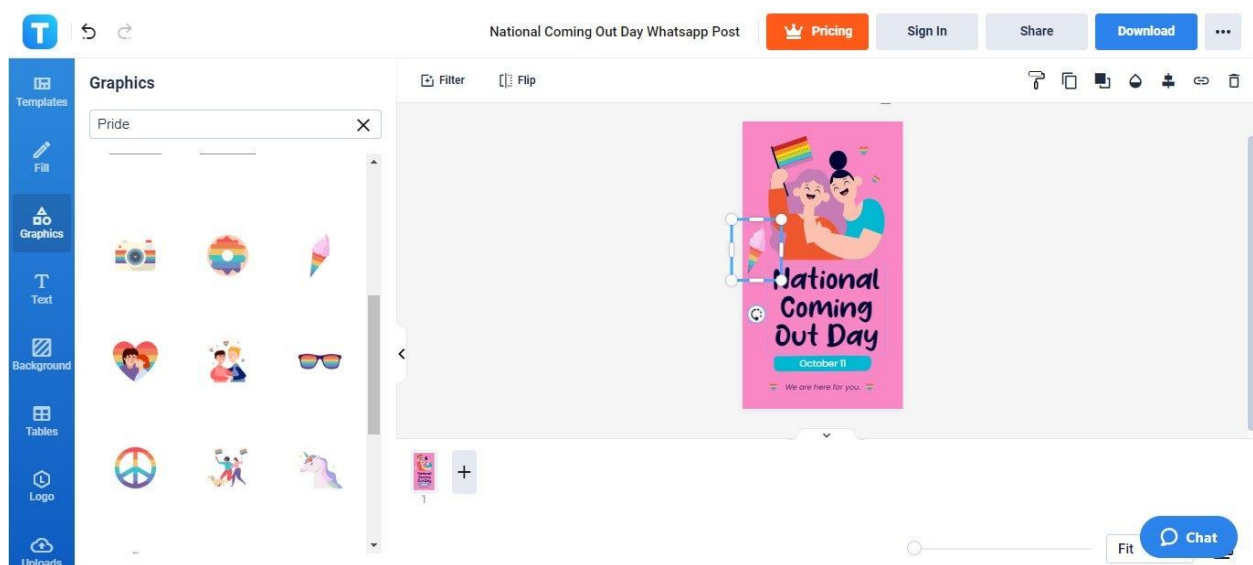

3. Modify the background.



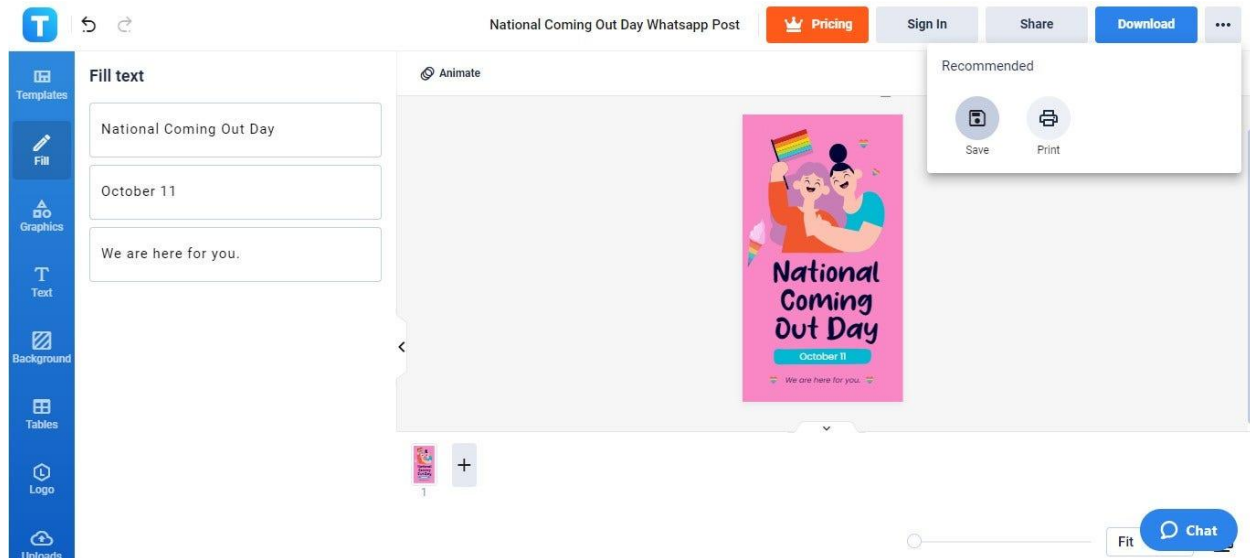

There are plenty of LGBT digital art in the Editor tool. Go to the Graphics panel and type "Pride" in the search box. Choose an LGBT digital art and add it to the post. To add it, simply click, drag, and drop it into the post template. It'll surely complement the elegance of your Whatsapp post.

5. Save your National Coming Out Day Whatsapp post draft.



When you're done, make sure to save your National Coming Out Day Whatsapp post draft. Hold on it to your post draft for now. Wait until October 11 to upload and share it on Whatsapp.

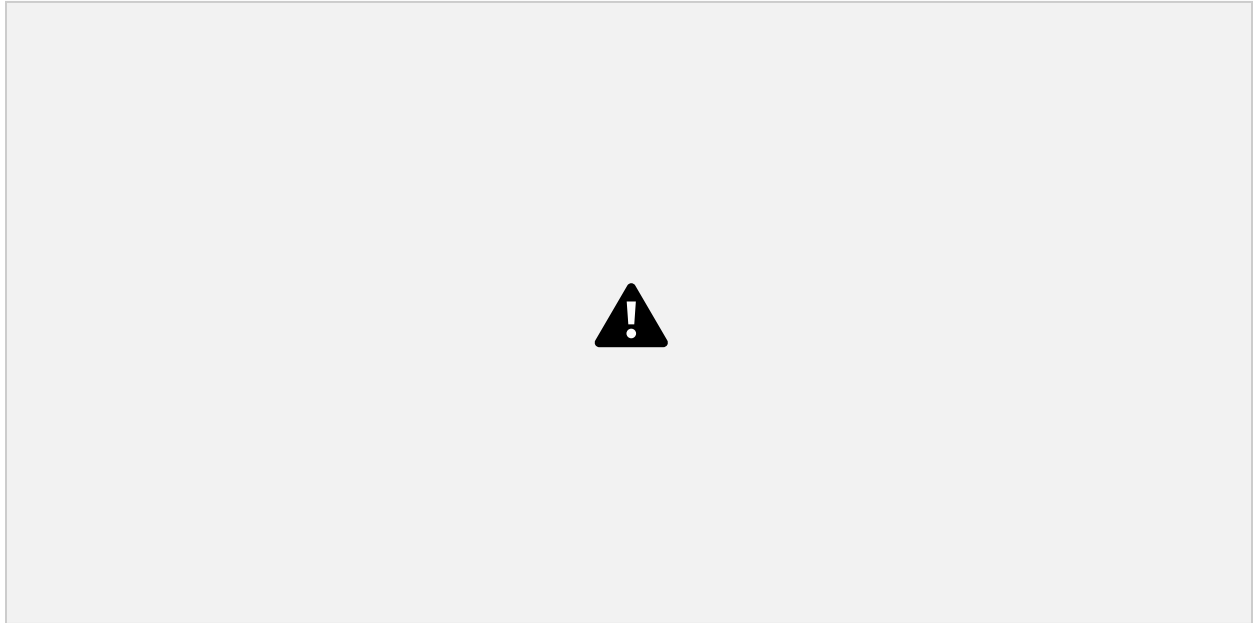
[Pride Month](#) is a month-long celebration in June honoring the rights, achievements, and freedom of LGBTQ individuals.
