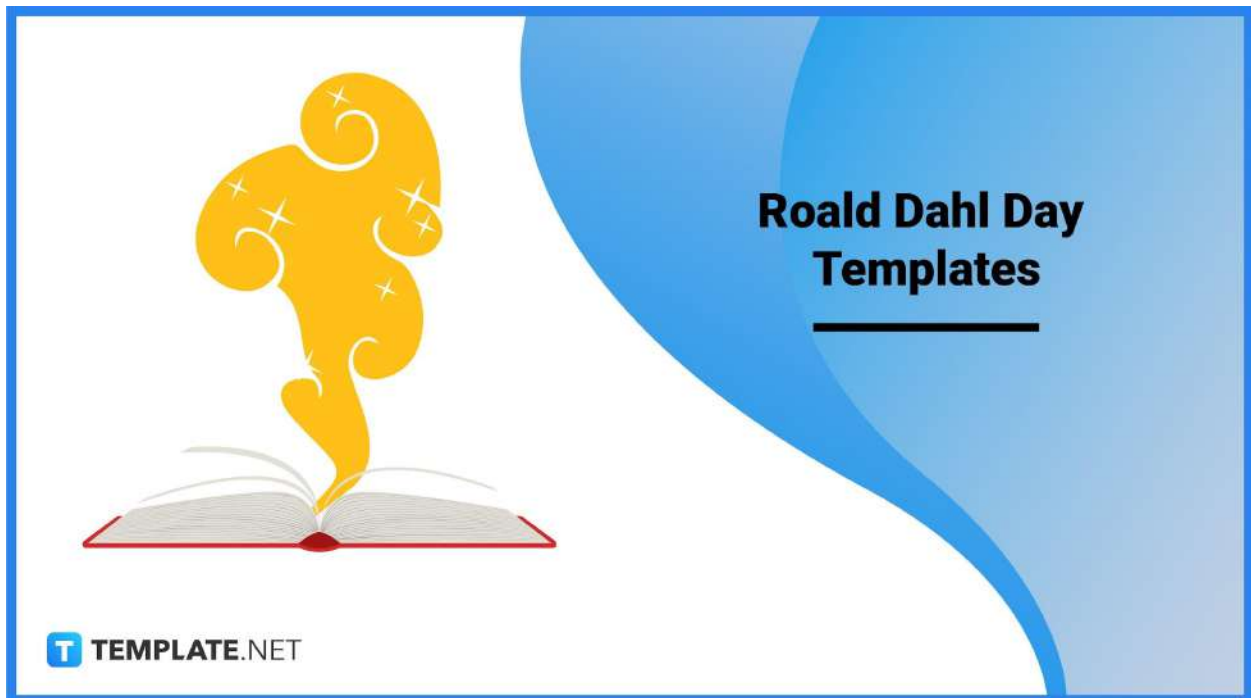

What's on Roald Dahl Day?

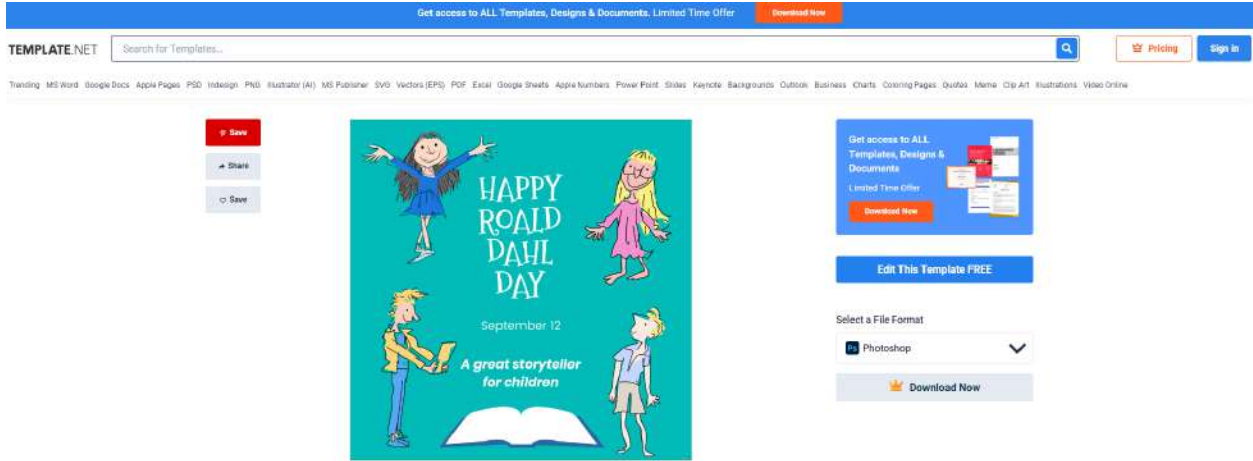

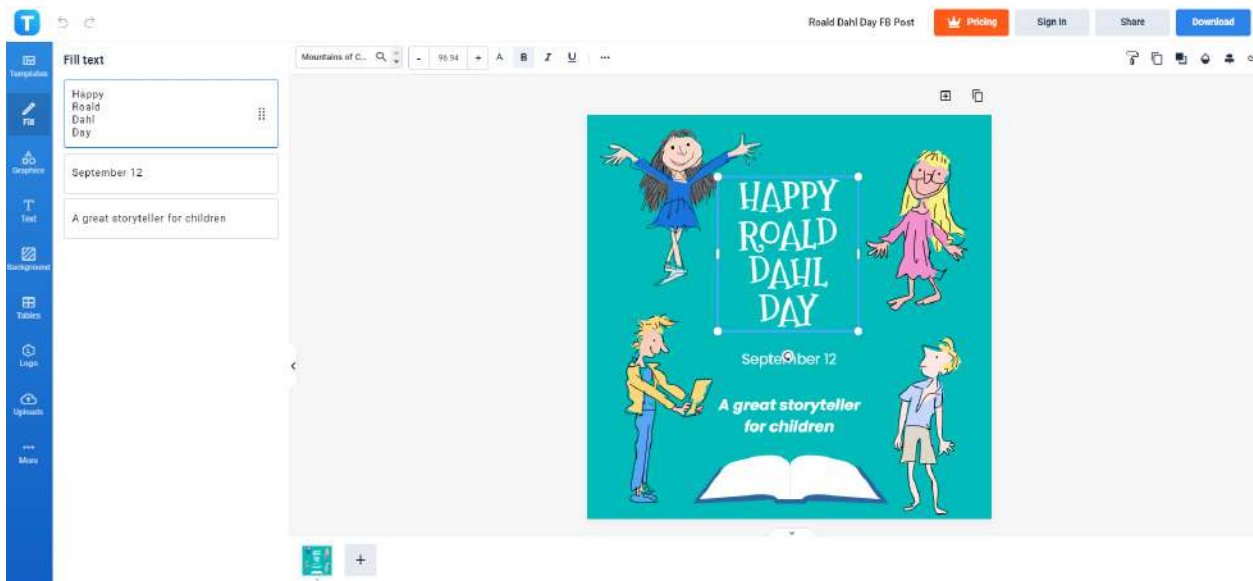
1. Choose a Roald Dahl Day Facebook Post Template

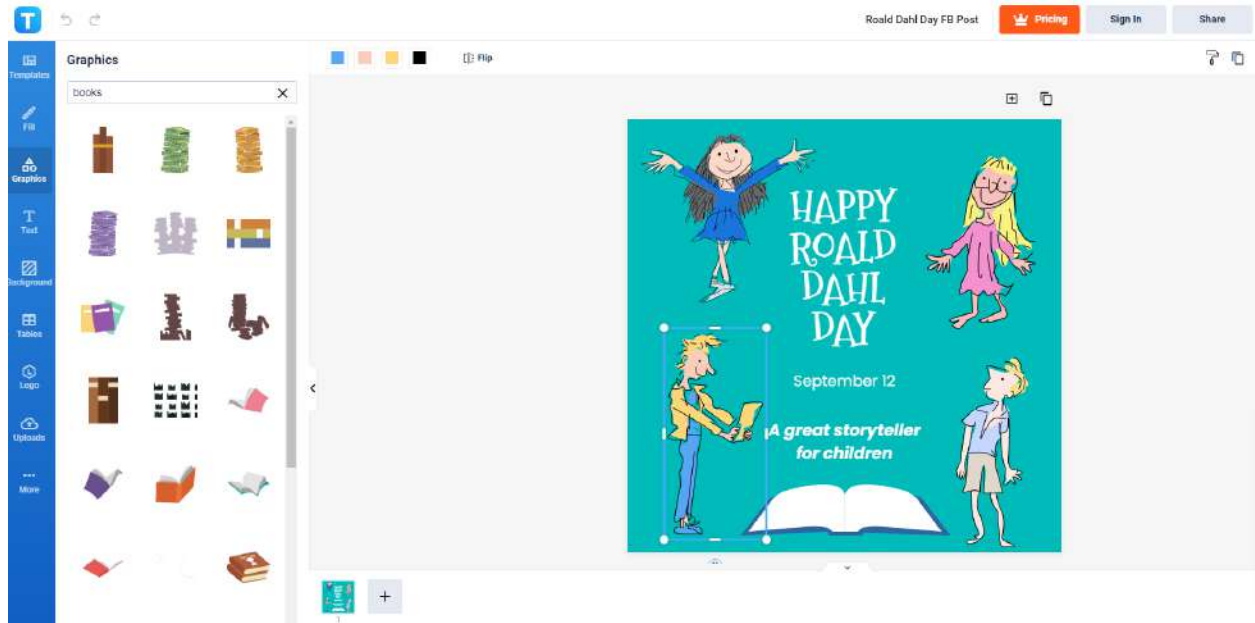
To begin, select an editable Roald Dahl Day Facebook template from the template gallery. You can use the search bar at the top of the page and simply type in what you are looking for.

2. Edit the Text Greeting



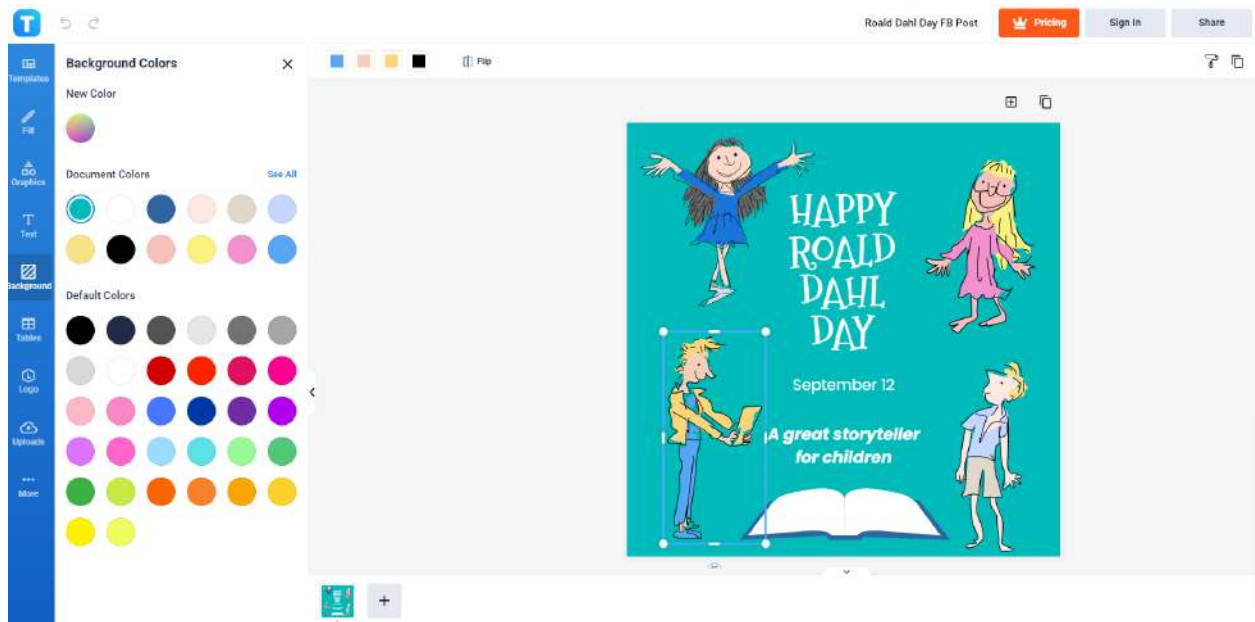

3. Add Images and Graphics



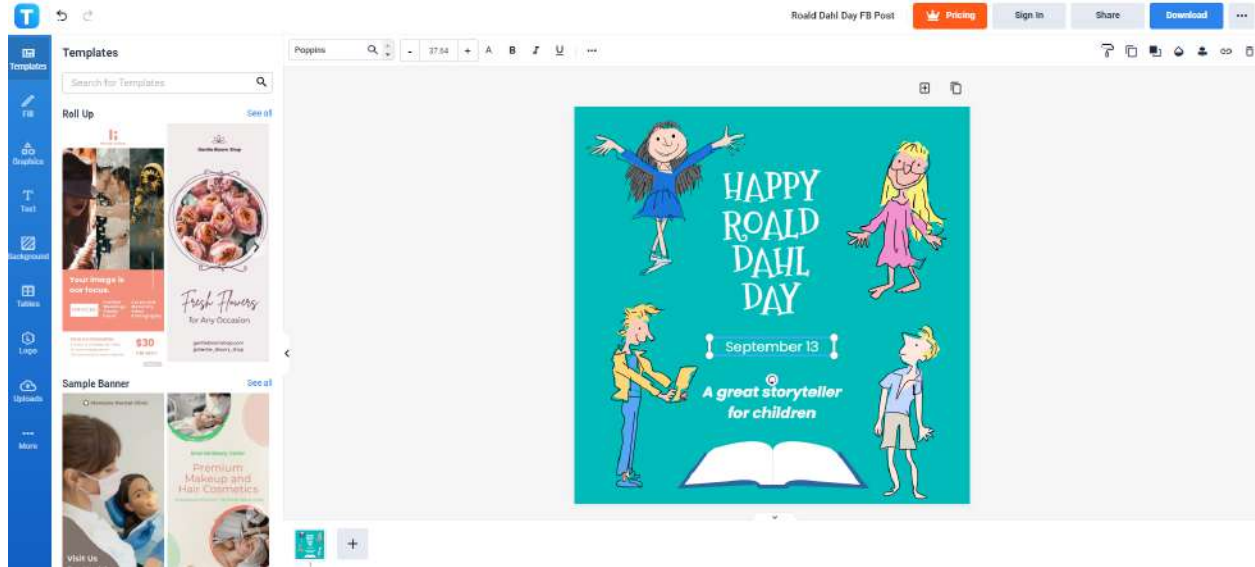

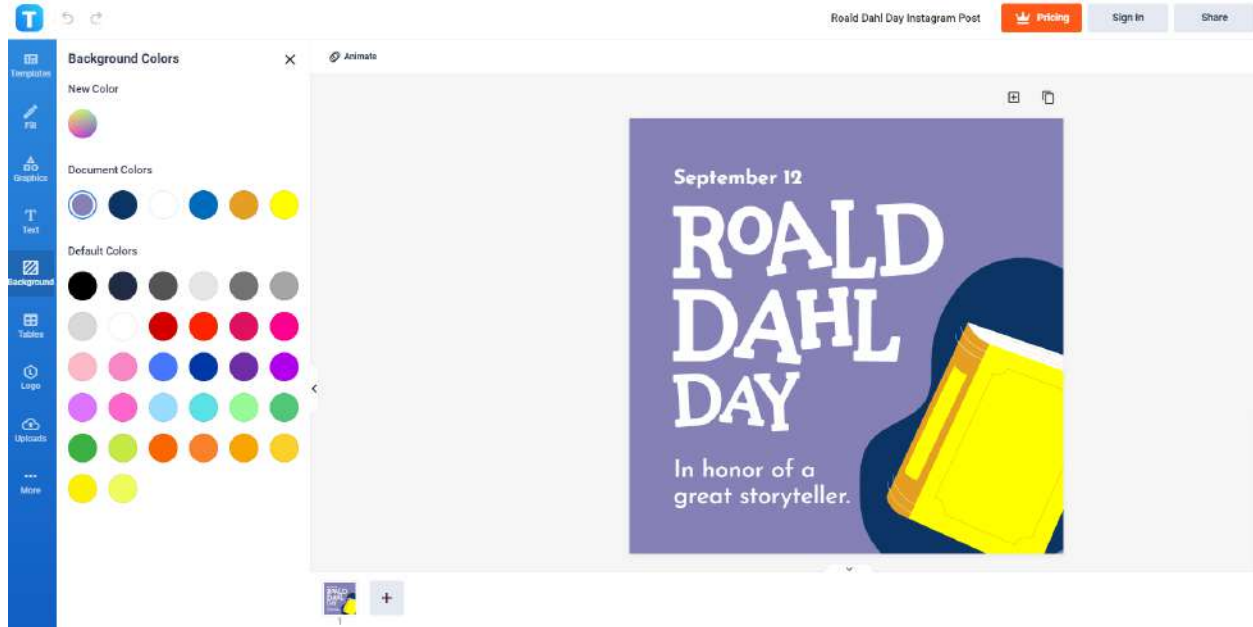
You can edit the text or message in the template by clicking the Fill tool on the sidebar menu. You can likewise modify the text size, font, and color using the different format settings found in the editor tool.

3. Add Images and Graphics



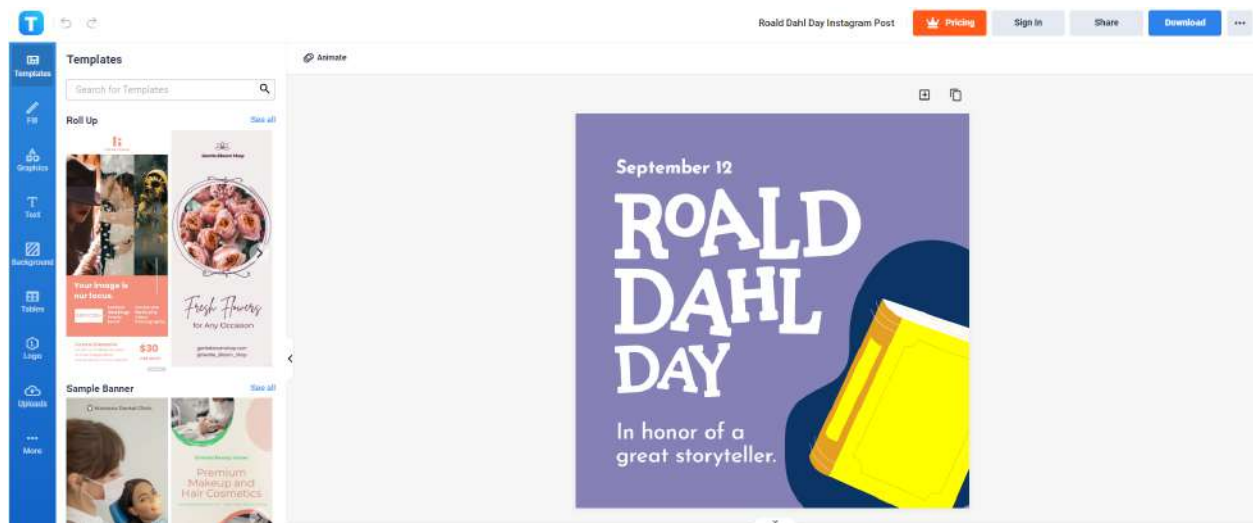

The editor tool allows you to rotate, crop, resize and customize the images according to your needs. Also, you can change the background color by simply tapping the Background button on the sidebar menu.

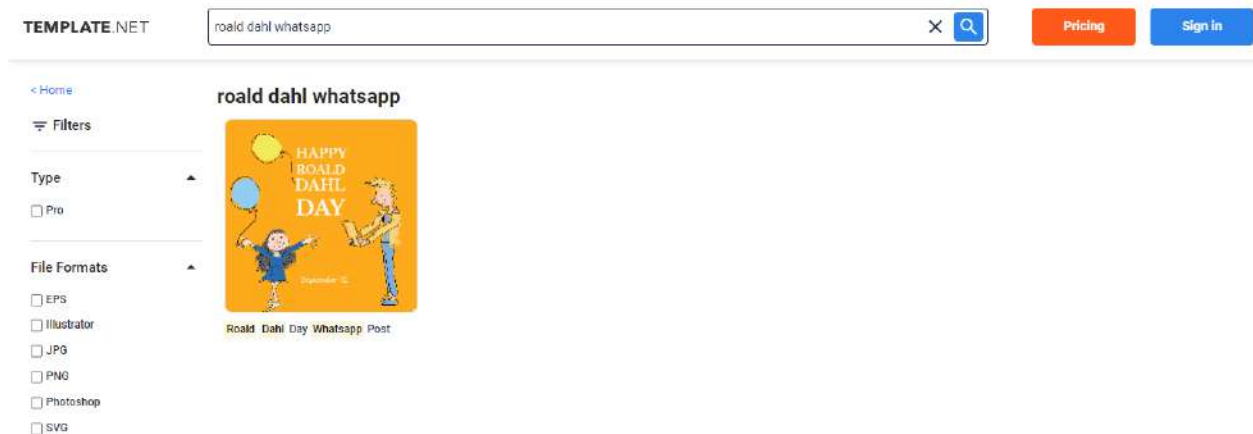
5. Download and Save the Template



When you are done editing, save and share the template by hitting the Download or Share button on the upper right corner of the screen. Note that you can also export or save the template in your preferred file format.

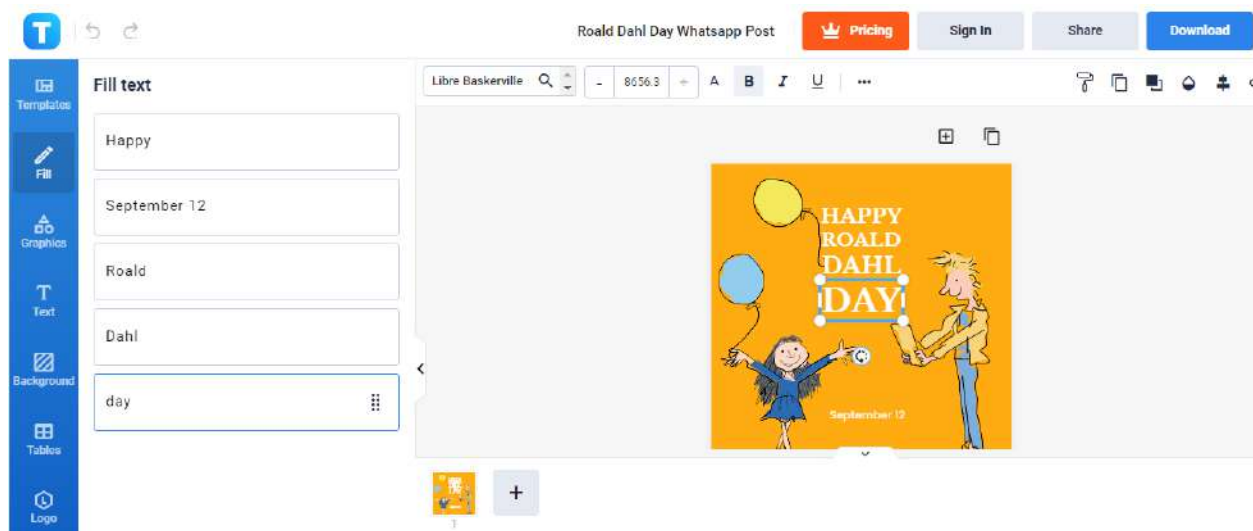

1. Choose a Roald Dahl Day WhatsApp Template



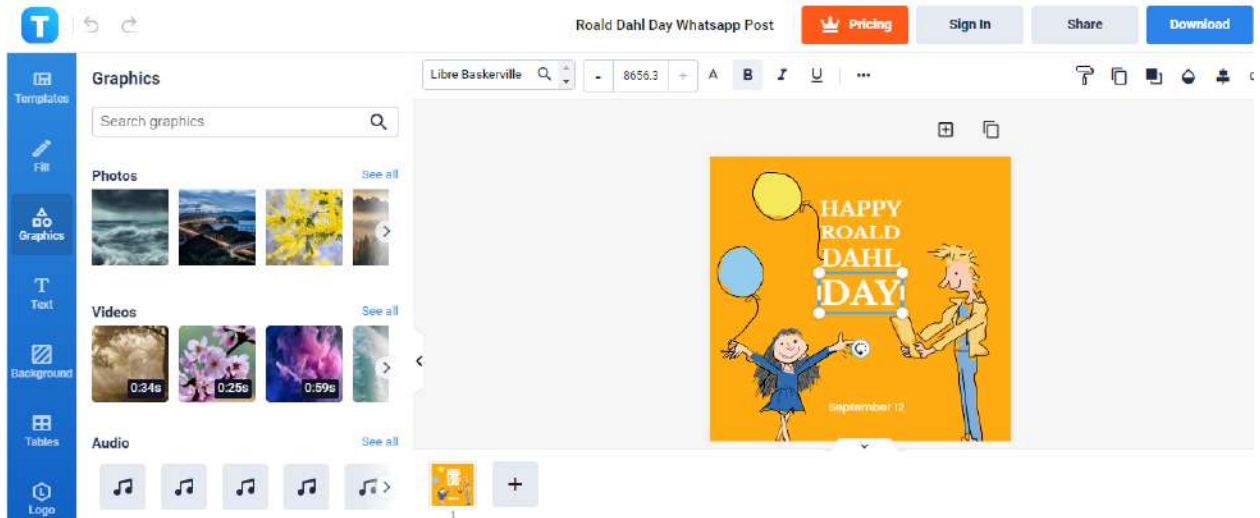

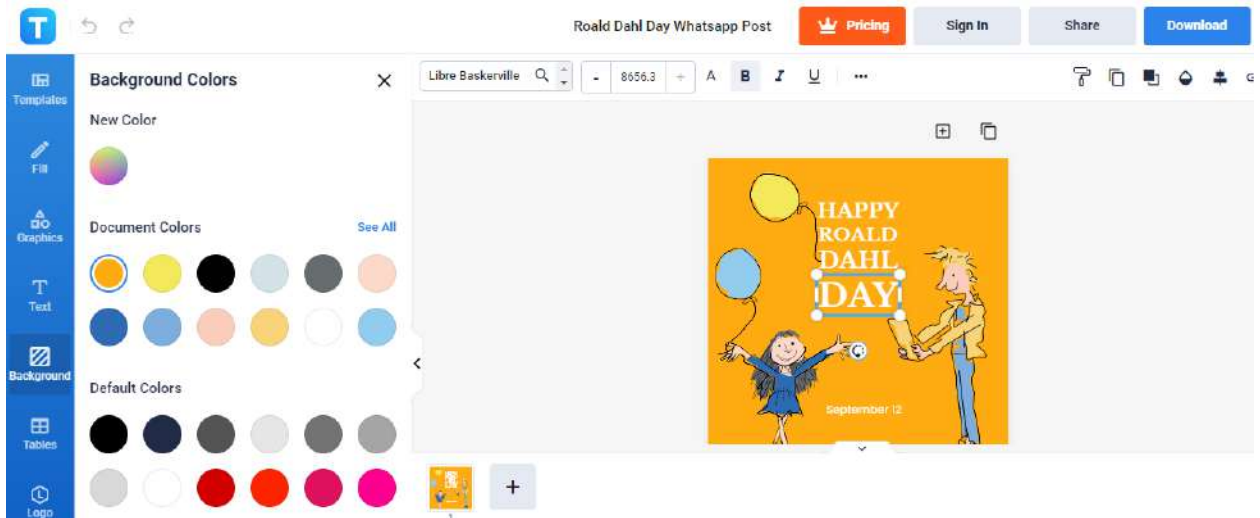

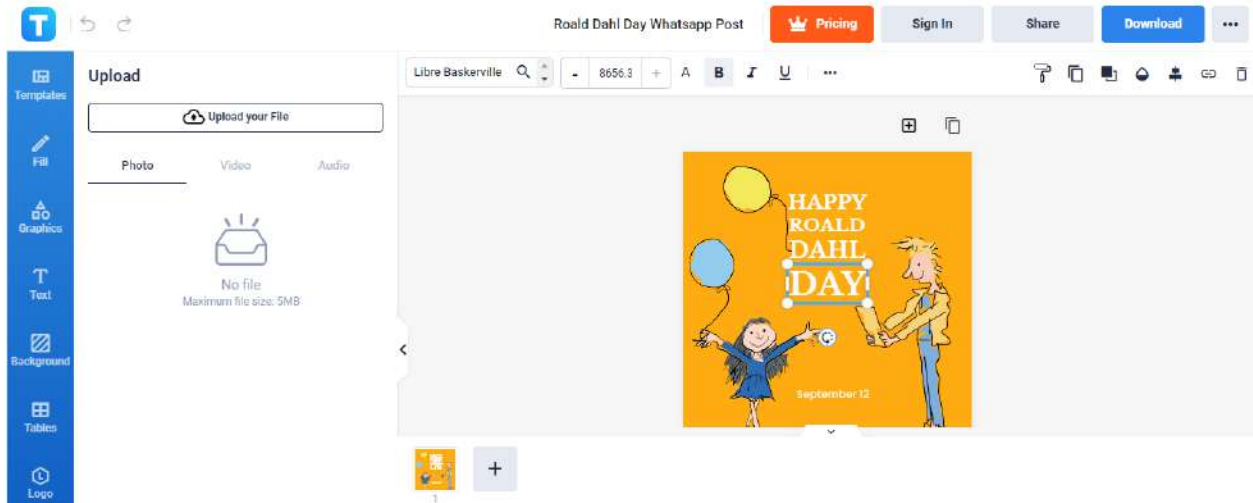

Roald Dahl Day is a day that honors the life and published works of Roald Dahl, it is celebrated each year on the anniversary of his birth.

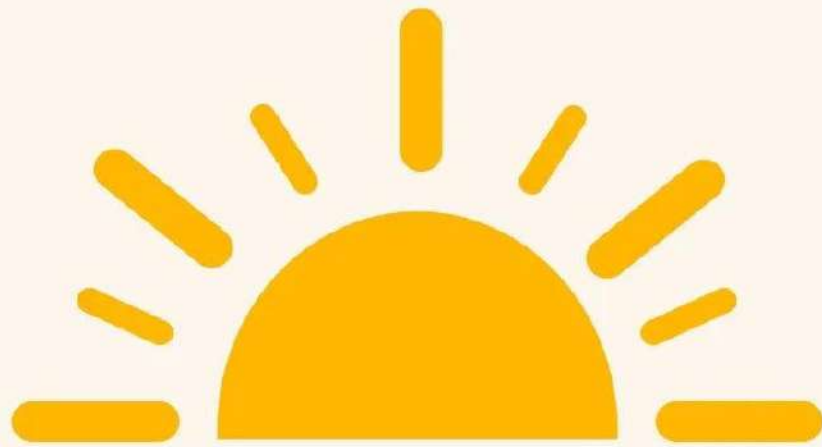

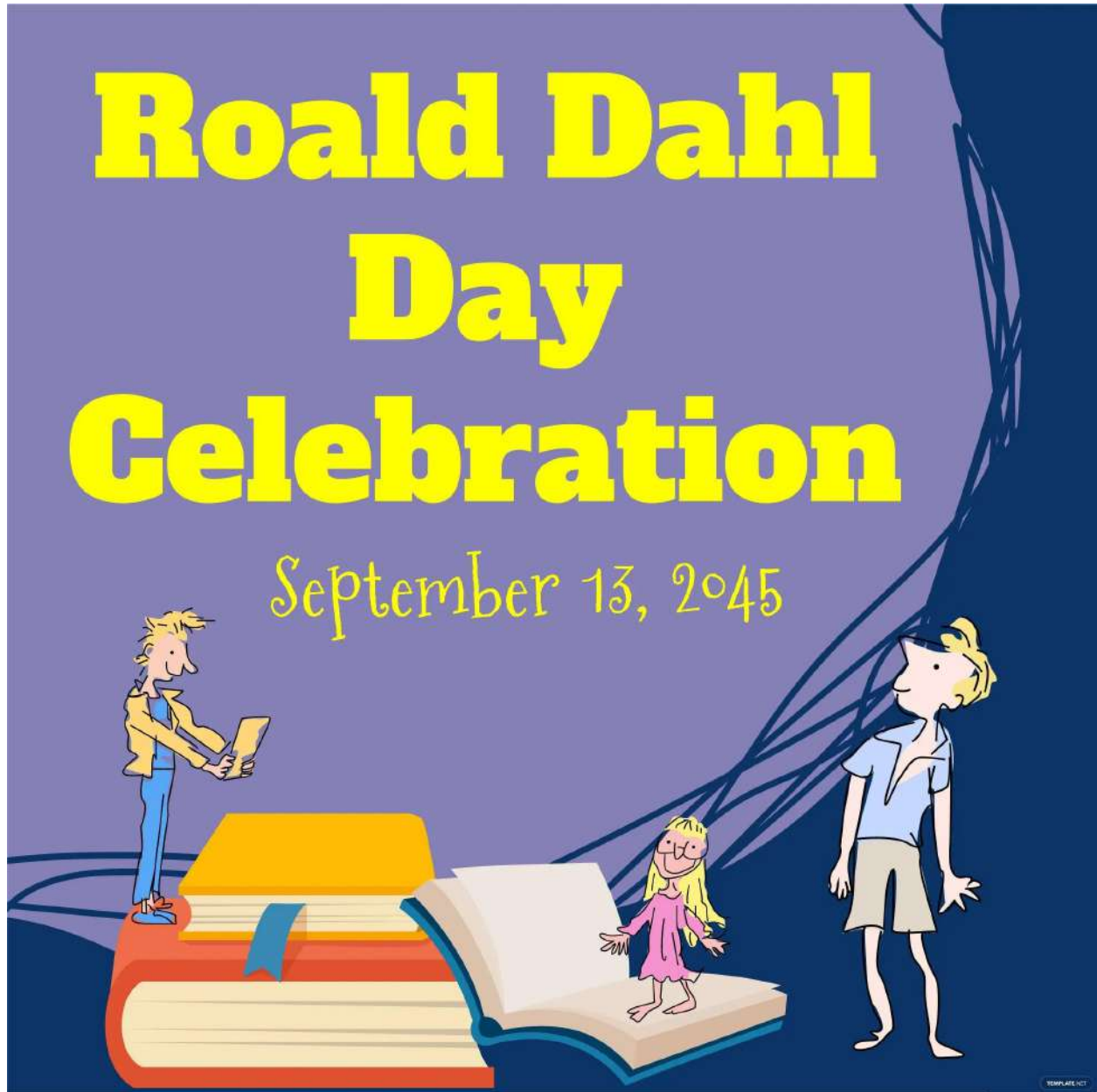
