

Black, gray, and dark blue colored tarps are known to be some of the strongest, heaviest, and most durable of all the different kinds of tarps.

What is a good quality tarpaulin?

Tarpaulins with a composition made mostly of polyethylene are generally stronger, more durable, and have a higher waterproof ability compared to other materials such as canvas tarps.

How far apart are grommets on a tarpaulin?

Grommets can be spaced anywhere between 18 to 36 inches apart from each other.

What is the use of tarpaulin in business?

Tarpaulins make excellent and effective marketing material for promoting a business, event, service, or product.

What can you do with tarpaulin?

You can use it as a waterproof cover to protect objects from the elements, and you can also design and print a tarpaulin for marketing or promotional purposes.
