World Environment Day Definition and Meaning

World Environment Day is a globally observed holiday that encourages all nations and people to care for and protect the natural environment.

It is a day dedicated to raising environmental awareness and advocating green initiatives and environmental outreach activities.

When Is World Environment Day?

World Environment Day is observed every year on June 5th. It was first established in 1973 by the United Nations and was consequently celebrated annually thereafter. Thus, its official name is the United Nations or UN World Environment Day. The holiday is also sometimes referred to as Eco Day or simply Environment Day.

World Environment Day History

World Environment Day started as a result of the first major conference on environmental issues which was convened under the United Nations General Assembly from June 5-16, 1972 in Stockholm, Sweden. The event was entitled the "Conference on the Human Environment". And on that same year on December 15th, the UN General Assembly adopted a formal resolution that appointed June 5th as World Environment Day.

World Environment Day Purpose and Importance

World Environment Day is a significant event not just for individuals and private groups, but for communities and countries everywhere. The following are just some compelling reasons on why celebrating or observing World Environment Day is important.

Raise Environmental Awareness

World Environment Day is a platform to advance the advocacy of environmental conservation. With the long list of environmental issues and problems facing the world today, there is a much greater chance for concrete action and transformative solutions when more people are educated and informed about such issues. Whether it is plastic pollution, overpopulation, or global warming, generating awareness is the first step in finding the solution to pressing environmental problems.

Stir Political Action

Another major reason for observing World Environment Day is political. It also puts pressure on governments and national leaders to take a bolder stand on urgent environmental problems such as climate change.


The first step is to choose a sample Facebook World Environment Day post from the template library. Utilize the search bar at the top of the page to search for the right template.

2. Edit the Text





Customize the images and other objects in the template according to your taste and preference. You can likewise resize photos, crop images, rotate objects and change the background colors as well.


5. Save the Template



The editor tool comes with several functions that allows you to rotate, crop, resize and customize the images according to your liking. The formatting tools can be found above the work canvas.


5. Download the Template
