When Teurff and Davis finally left their jobs at the commission, they proposed converting Texas Recycles Day to America Recycles Day, with the National Recycling Coalition adapting it as a national event.

America Recycles Day is a valuable event for many people worldwide, giving importance to the value of recycling, including the proper process of recycling waste materials, and promoting recycling as an essential skill that everyone should practice to keep the planet safe, healthy, and beautiful for future generations.

1. Select an [America Recycles Day FB Post](#) template.



Choose from a collection of graphics and document templates from Template.net that users can edit, personalize, and download using third-party software or the website's editor tool. Go through the International Internet Day landing page for templates, look for the Facebook template, then select the Edit This Template FREE button on the product page. Template.net opens a new tab to use the editor tool.

2. Write an encouraging message.



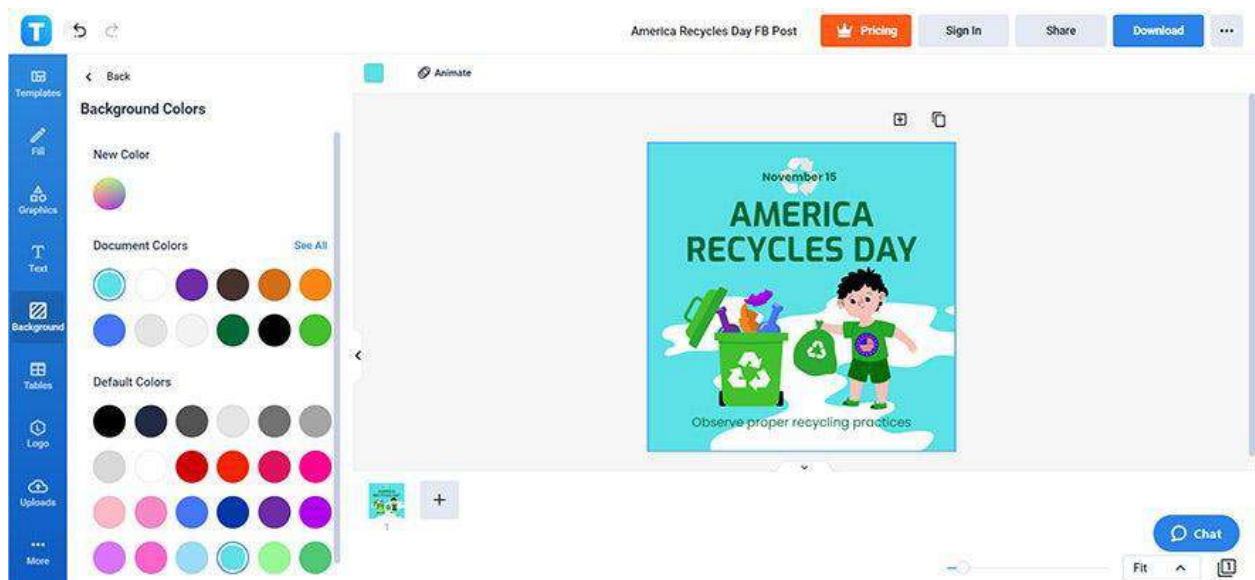
Write a message to incorporate in the post before uploading it on a Facebook page or account. Deliver encouraging notes to audiences, inserting them on the template using new or existing text boxes. Change the contents of the highlighted text box by clicking the Fill button on the editor panel to change the text.

3. Use transparent images for the template.



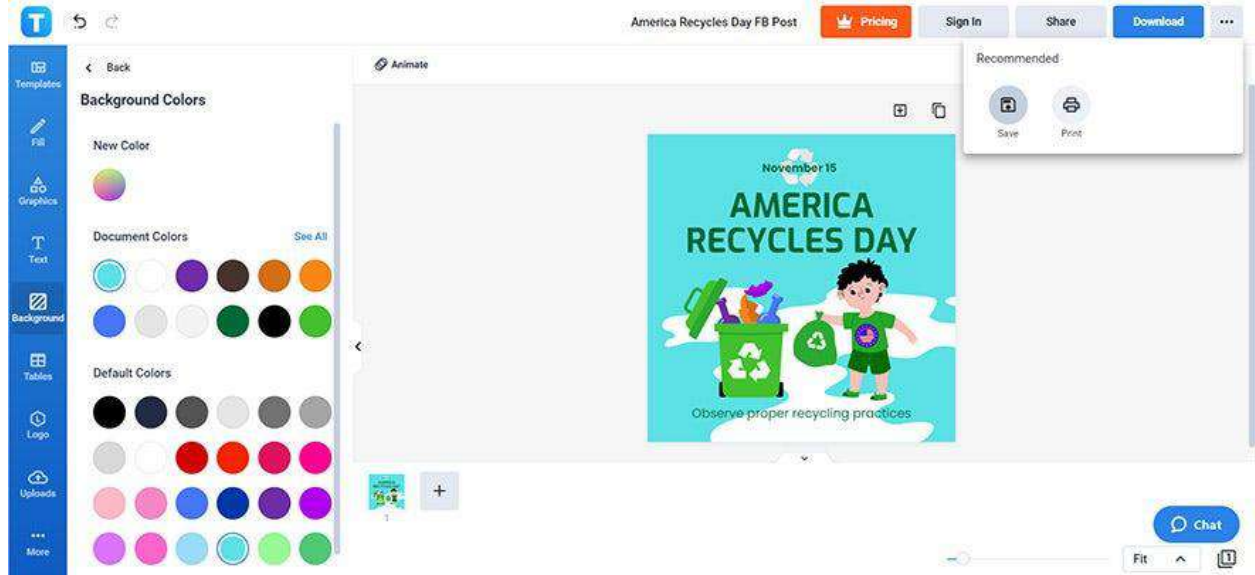
Construct a cheerful and informative post and add ClipArt symbols, vectors, and illustrations. Click on the Graphics button from the editor panel to access the website's multiple designs. Browse through logos, shapes, or stickers in SVG or PNG file format, adding them to the template.

4. Develop a fitting wallpaper.



Select the Background icon from the editor panel to set up the wallpaper. Pick Color from the options and define the coloring for the backdrop. Select between solid color backgrounds, animated stock videos, pictures, and images using Unsplash or Pixelbay websites.

5. Save the Facebook template on the device.



Store the Facebook template through the ellipsis button on the top corner of the editor window. Use the Save icon from the dropdown menu to save the final template. Log in to a registered Template.net account and save the Facebook post.

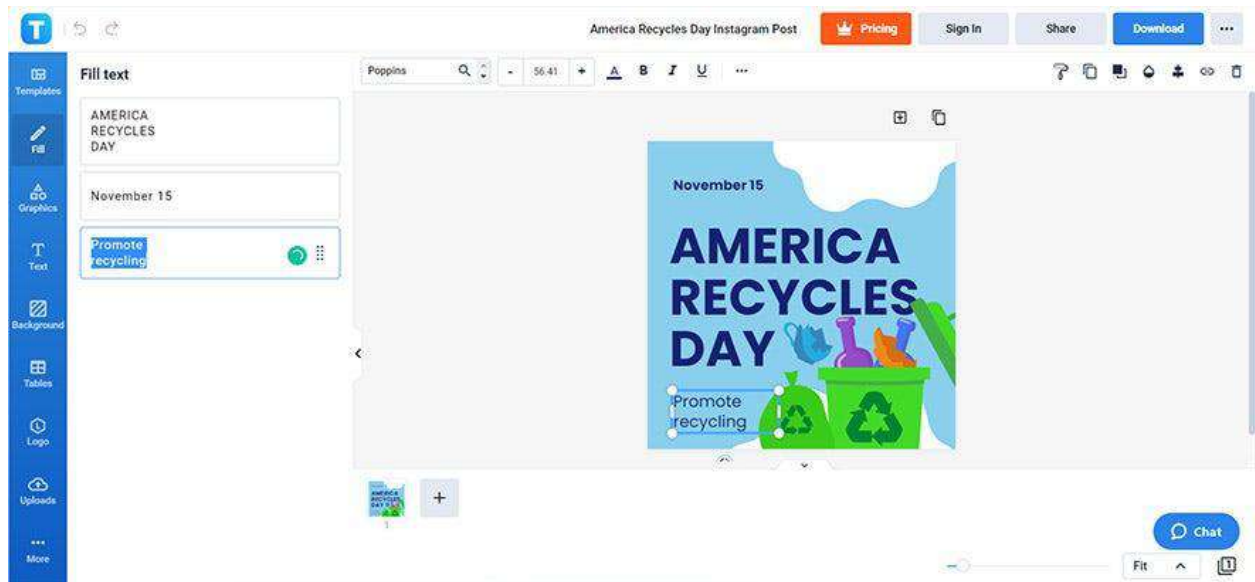
Instagram

1. Choose an [America Recycles Day Instagram Post](#) template.



Select an Instagram post template for an America Recycles Day event from the selection of graphic templates from Template.net. Access Template.net's editor tool using your device's web browser after clicking the Edit This Template FREE button on the template's page. The editor tool appears on a new tab to edit the template's content.

2. Display a pleasant message to viewers.



Individuals and organizations construct messages for the public. Incorporate greetings and quotes from poems, books, or well-known personalities on the post using new or available text boxes. Navigate the text tool by clicking the Fill button on the editor panel for options.

3. Select a background color or picture for the post.



Change the template's background to fit the layouts and theme of the event. Click the Color option from the Background button from the editor panel, choose a solid color from the selections, or navigate the color picker. Choose a color that complements the elements and patterns on the post.

4. Exhibit appropriate vectors and elements.



Include shapes, patterns, and other elements into the template to facilitate attraction to the public. Click on the Graphics icon from the editor, and browse cartoon prints, logos, and illustrations through the search bar. Select the character or component to insert into the template, adjusting the image into place.

5. Finalize the Instagram template on the device.



After the final modifications, save the Instagram template for posting. Download the graphic to the device by clicking the ellipsis button from the top section of the editor window. Click the Save icon from the menu to save the post.

WhatsApp

1. Pick an America Recycles Day Whatsapp Post template.

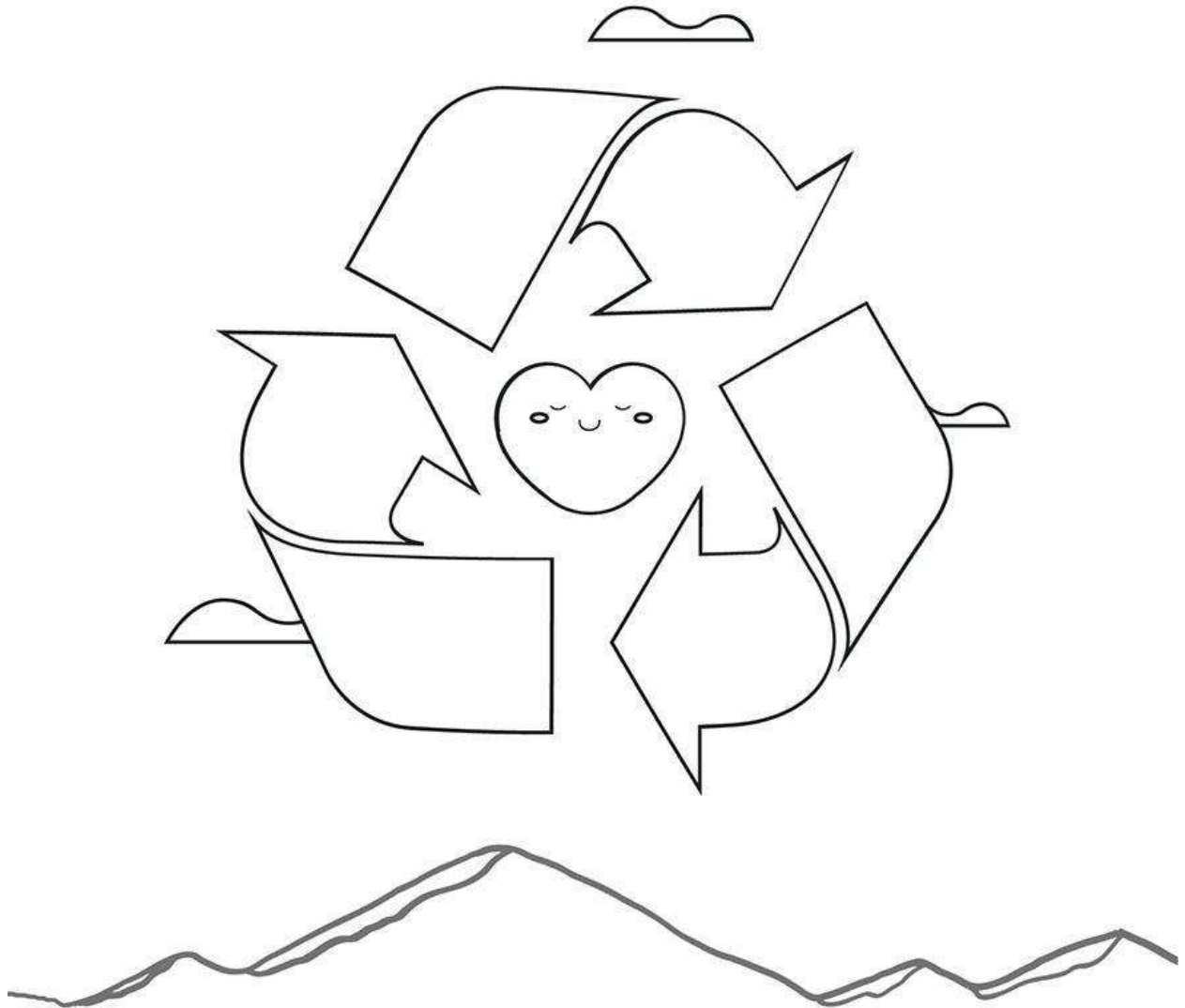

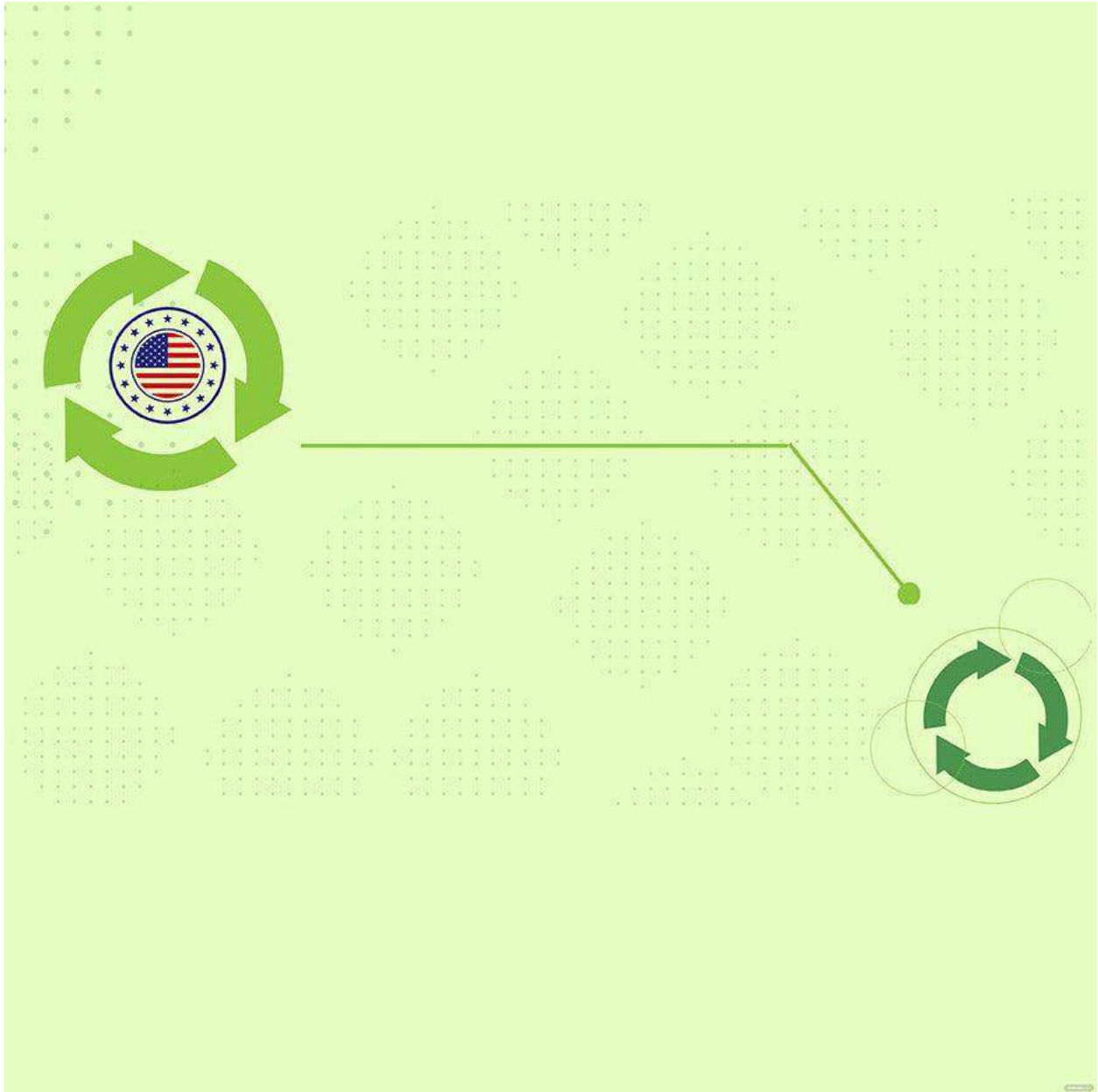
