Global Handwashing Day is observed around the world every October 15. The international celebration is observed by over 200 million participants every year.

Global Handwashing Day History

The first official Global Handwashing Day was held on the 15th of October 2008, which started as an initiative by the Global Handwashing Partnership or GHP, which was formerly known as the Public-Private Partnership for Handwashing or PPPHW. At the annual World Water Week summit in Sweden, the GHP formally established Global Handwashing Day. Founding committee members of the Global Handwashing Partnership included Colgate-Palmolive, Procter Gamble, Unilever, USAID, The London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, and UNICEF.

Global Handwashing Day Purpose and Importance

Global Handwashing Day is basically an education and information drive, and the international campaign is set on pushing for better health and hygiene with the simple act of handwashing.

At its core, Global Handwashing Day is a day of awareness. The event hopes to generate awareness about the many health benefits of regular handwashing. Many groups and organizations- both public and private- hold events and programs on October 15 that educate and inform the public about healthy handwashing habits.

What's in Global Handwashing Day?





1. Pick a Global Handwashing Day Facebook Post Template





2. Edit the Text





3. Add Images and Graphics






5. Save the Finished Template



1. Select a Global Handwashing Day Instagram Post Template




In the search bar at the top of the page, type in Global Handwashing Day and choose a template from the template gallery. After selecting a template, click the "Edit This Template for Free" button.

2. Create a Customized Message





3. Provide Additional Graphics





You can likewise rotate, crop, resize and modify the images or graphics according to dual tastes. If you want to change the background color, simply click the Background button on the sidebar menu.


5. Save and Download the Template



Once you are done editing, save or share the template by clicking the Download button located in the upper right corner of the page. You can also download or export your work in your preferred file format.



1. Choose a Global Handwashing Day WhatsApp Post Template




Using the search bar, type in Global Handwashing Day to browse the available templates. Choose a template then click on the "Edit This Template for Free" button to customize it.

2. Write a Personalized Message




You can edit the text by clicking the Fill icon located on the sidebar menu. It is best to keep your message brief, relevant, and witty; anything too long just won't work.

3. Import Graphics and Images








