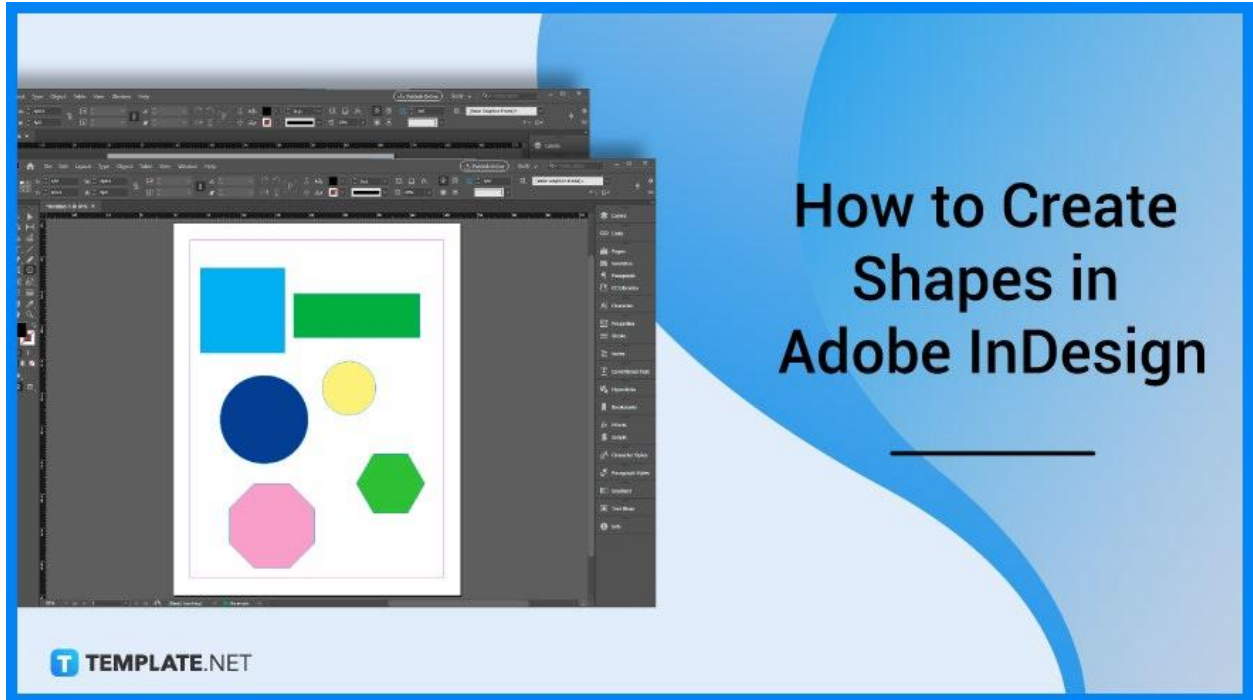


How to Create Shapes in Adobe InDesign

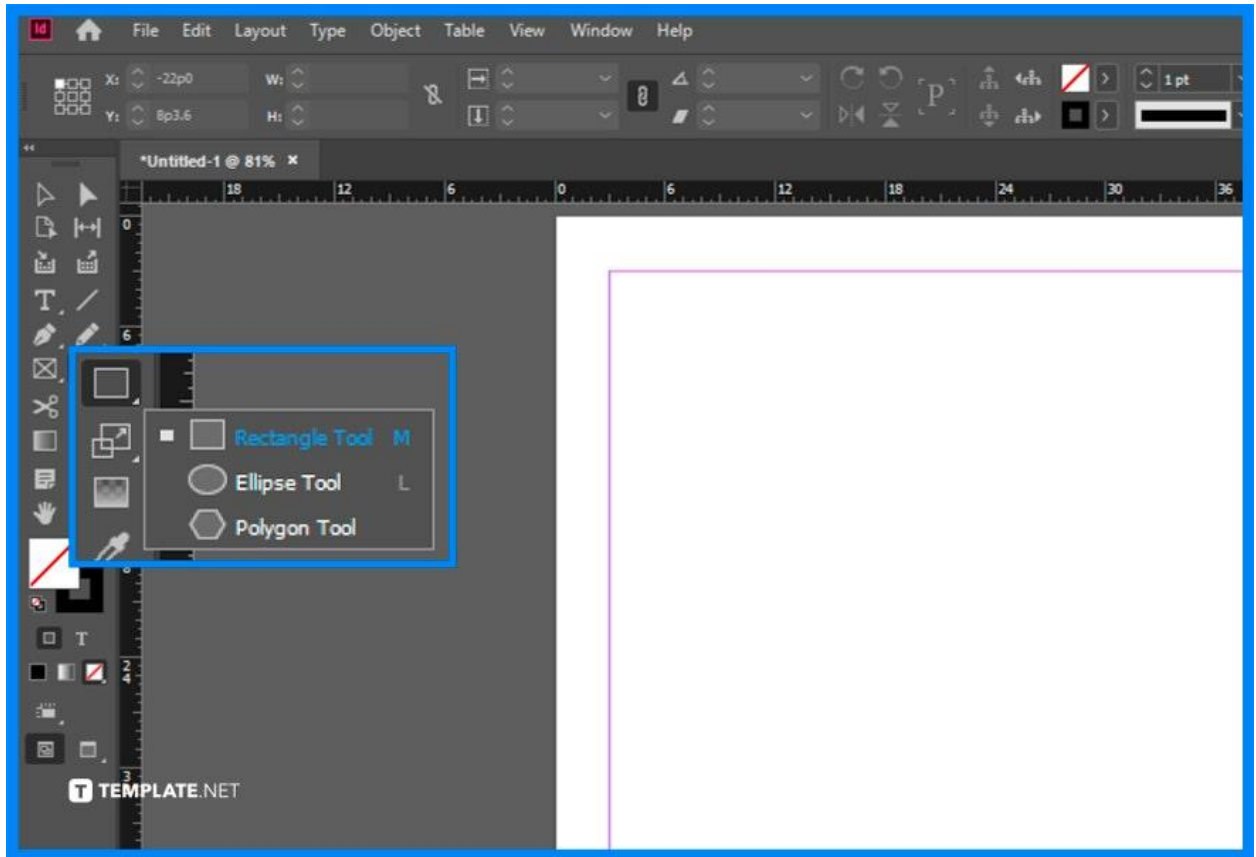


How to Create Shapes in Adobe InDesign

Adding shapes takes a few seconds. Just open your Adobe InDesign file and follow these easy steps.

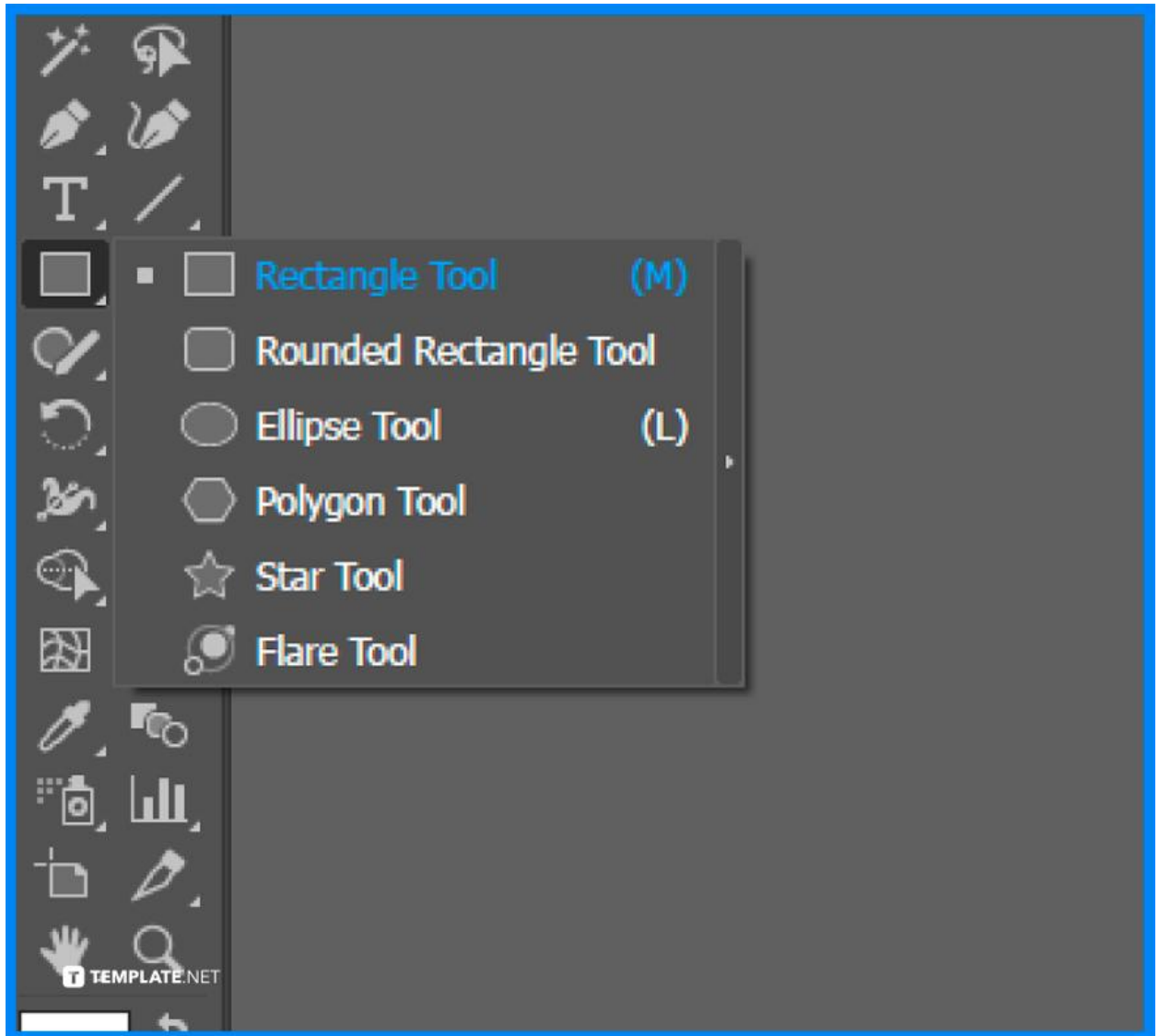
- **Step 1: Select Shapes Tool**

Move your cursor to the toolbar on the side of Adobe InDesign and click on the shapes tool. It appears like a square icon.



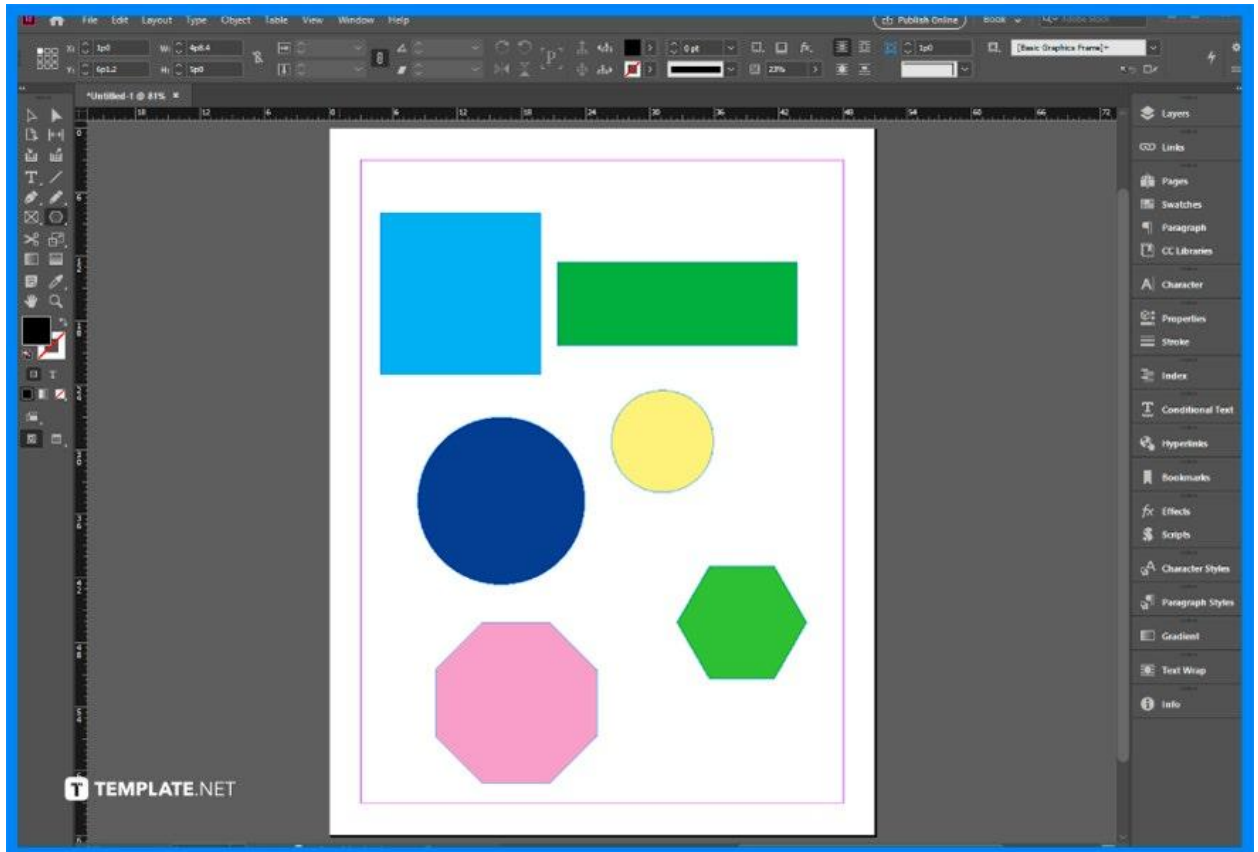
- **Step 2: Choose Shape**

You have three options to choose from in the Shape Tool, either a rectangle, a circle, or a polygon. Click whichever you prefer.



- **Step 3: Click and Drag**

Go to your page and click and drag. The shape that you choose from the Shape Tool will appear. And that is how you create shapes in InDesign.



For Polygons, instead of clicking and dragging, just click and a dialog box will open with which you can decide the sides and size of your polygon.

How do you make a perfect circle or square in Adobe InDesign?

To make a perfect circle or square, just hold the Shift key while clicking and dragging it.
