International Dot Day History

International Dot Day History goes back a couple of years ago through the introduction of the story, The Dot, by author Peter H. Reynolds written on September 15, 2003. Terry Shay, a teacher in Iowa, introduced the story to his class on September 15, 2009, coincidentally six years after the publication of the story, leading to the observance of International Dot Day yearly on September 15. Since its publication, The Dot story by Peter H. Reynolds has been translated into at least twenty languages and read throughout different educational institutions by students and adults through events worldwide.

International Dot Day Purpose, Importance

International Dot Day encourages students and individuals to get creative and inspire others to let inspiration guide them to craft beautiful and unique, and it offers a reason for individuals to perform in their unique ways without limiting themselves to expression.

Encourage Creativity

One of the main goals of celebrating International Dot Day is to celebrate people's creative prowess in various fields, including painting, drawing, and writing stories or songs. During this event, different people are encouraged to produce artwork, design, or craft purely from their imagination without feeling the need to hold themselves back on their ideas.

Foster Self-Expression

Different people express themselves diversely, with people enjoying painting and drawings while others prefer designing outfits using fabrics of different materials, both incorporating polka dot ideas. No matter the simplicity or complexity of the output, as long as the individual expresses how they feel and delivers something satisfying for them, that is what matters.

Dots are Symbolic

Coming from the story of Peter H. Reynolds, The Dot, the young protagonist, Vashti, was encouraged by her teacher to create a mark for her art project, producing a simple dot on her paper. The dot symbolizes something simple and leads to greater artwork in the future, representing nearly anything, with individuals starting their creative journeys through a simple dot on a piece of paper.

What's on International Dot Day?



Aside from reading the book, individuals can also donate art supplies to support art programs to foster creativity and encourage students to develop artwork as a project.



1. Select an International Dot Day FB Post template.





2. Develop inspirational messages to readers.





3. Add different elements and designs.






5. Save and download the final Facebook post.



1. Choose an International Dot Day Instagram Post template.





2. Dedicate a touching statement.





3. Select the most ideal color or photo background.






5. Finalize the edited Instagram post.



After final edits, save and download the Instagram template to the device by selecting the ellipsis button from the editor window. Click on the Save icon from the ellipsis menu to download the post.


