Nevada Day History

Henry Comstock built a fortune mining gold and silver after finding treasure in Nevada in 1859. Nevada was still admitted to the Union and given statehood on October 31, 1864, despite lacking the 60,000 residents needed to be a state. As a result, Nevada became the second state to join the Union during the Civil War. According to a local journalist at the time, the first commemoration of Nevada's becoming a state took place in 1873.

Nevada Day Purpose, Importance

Nevada continues to celebrate its admission with a day off and having parades, competitions, enjoyable activities, and fanfare, which makes it quite distinctive.

State Admission Commemoration

The quest of Nevada to achieve permanent statehood is extremely intriguing since, while being admitted as a state to the union in 1864, it still did not meet the qualifying requirement of a minimum number of inhabitants of 60,000 residents. It lost population even after 1880, and it took Nevada 30 years to get it back to meet the requirements for statehood, according to the US State Census Bureau. The state administration invites citizens to participate in celebrations on this day to raise awareness of the state's legacy.

Being admitted to the Union of States is a source of tremendous pride for any state. Nevada occupies a unique position in relation to other states in the USA. After West Virginia, it is the only other state to receive statehood during the Civil War. On this day, the entire community of Nevada congregates at the nation's capital to honor its rich history.

What's In Nevada Day?


